

RECKLESS FIRMS BRYAN ADAMS' STATUS

With the release of his fourth LP, *Reckless*, A&M recording artist Bryan Adams has clearly established himself as one of Canada's finest writers and performers. Adams' writing collaboration with drummer Jim Vallance has resulted in a slew of successful releases for other artists: 38 Special, Loverboy, Kiss, and Bob Welch, to name a few - and four records combining a keen sense of pop dynamics with a memorably gritty vocal style.

The *Reckless* album - released simultaneously as an album, chrome cassette, CD, and 30 minute home-video package, shipped platinum in Canada, and features a duet, *It's Only Love*, with Tina Turner. *Run To You*, taken as the album's first single, has bulletted its way up the RPM 100 singles chart, moving to No. 30 this week.

Born of British parents in Kingston, Ontario, in 1959, Adams lived with his family in England, Portugal, and Israel. The family settled in Vancouver when Adams was 15.

An important juncture in Adams' career was his chance meeting with drummer Jim Vallance in 1977. Collaborating soon after as songwriters, the duo cranked out material for Canadian acts - Prism, BTO, and Loverboy - as well as Ian Lloyd, 38 Special, Bob Welch, and Kiss. Adams had been gigging with a variety of bands on the local club circuit since the age of 16.

Two years later, an Adams/Vallance demo tape fell into A&M's hands, with the label subsequently signing Adams, and remixing *Let Me Take You Dancing*. The single experienced extensive club play throughout 1979.

The following year, Adams released his self-titled debut LP, and toured behind the release over the course of four months.

1981 witnessed the release of a follow-up LP, *You Want It You Got It*. The second album was produced by Adams and Bob Clearmountain - the inception of a production partnership that continues to this day. The LP also signalled the beginning of more touring for the 22 year old singer - supporting acts such as The Kinks, Loverboy, and Foreigner in the U.S.

The release of *Cuts Like A Knife* - Adams' third LP - in 1983 essentially marks the beginning of an international career as singer, writer, and live act of considerable import for Adams.

The album sold 300,000 units in Canada, and 1.5 million in the U.S. - putting Adams solidly into the platinum ranks. The breadth of the material - from the uptempo balladry of *This Time*, to the flat-out raunch of *Take Me Back* - displayed an emerging feel for both ends of the rock and roll spectrum.

By the end of 1983, Adams had toured Europe and Japan, and seen *This Time* - *Cuts Like A Knife*'s third single - go Top 30 in the U.S. The same year witnessed several awards for the still-young singer - NARM's Best Selling New Artist, The Album Network's No. 2 Male AOR Artist, and Radio and Records' No. 3 Most Played AOR album. Canadian industry recognition came in the form of a Juno Award for Top Male

Vocalist.

Out of the box, A&M shipped over 115,000 units of *Reckless*. Canadian sales currently stand at just shy of 150,000. In the U.S., it is expected that one million records will have been shipped by Christmas.

Plans are underway for a major Canadian tour sometime in January, with tours of Europe and Japan to follow. Adams will



guest on MTV's New Year's Eve Party Spectacular later this year.

A killer record, a rising single, and a burgeoning international career - not bad at all for the blonde kid from Vancouver.

Reckless was produced by Adams and Bob Clearmountain, and engineered by Clearmountain. The tracks are *One Night Love Affair*, *She's Only Happy When She's Dancin'*, *Run To You*, *Heaven*, *Somebody*, *Summer Of '69*, *Kids Wanna Rock*, *It's Only Love*, *Love Gone*, and *Ain't Gonna Cry*.



Debut Honeymoon Suite LP surpasses gold plateau

WEA Music Canada has confirmed that the debut self-titled Honeymoon Suite LP has exceeded the gold mark in Canada. A new single, Burning In Love, the second from the album and the follow-up to New Girl Now, has been released and is already making gains up the RPM 100 singles chart. A Video on Burning, produced by Juno nominee Rob Quartly, is now available. The band, nominated for a Juno in the Most Promising Category, will be performing at the nationally-televised awards show.

The Niagara Falls group have just come off a support tour with Jethro Tull and is now into three weeks of Ontario dates running from Nov. 29 to Dec. 22. They are also scheduled for a Northeastern U.S. tour opening for Bryan Adams during December and January, to be followed by

Heavy advertiser interest in MuchMusic Network

Somewhat contrary to expectations, the MuchMusic Network has attracted several prominent advertisers - many whose parents advertise on the American video channel, MTV. These include Pepsi-Cola, Coca-Cola, General Foods, Nabisco Brands, and H.J. Heinz. Coca-Cola is the largest account in a deal reportedly worth in excess of \$3 million.

"The advertising industry has always been perceived to be very conservative," MuchMusic Vice President and General Manager Dennis Fitz-Gerald recently told the *Globe and Mail's* Peggy McCallum (Report On Business - Nov. 14/84).

"But in view of the success of MTV in the United States as a marketing tool," he continued, "many of the companies have sprung forward and come on board. It's gone exceptionally better and faster than we had planned."

According to Fitz-Gerald MuchMusic "could be close" to turning a profit this year, which flies in the face of estimates at the outset which predicted a loss situation for the first three years of operation.

MuchMusic currently emphasizes rock music, "because it is the supply side", says Fitz-Gerald, "But we're not just dedicated to rock. We'll constantly be refining."

A European tour is also in the works. Their album has been doing well in Germany and has just been released in Japan and Australia.

Hawkins to hospital to undergo tests

Ronnie Hawkins, who opened at the Imperial Room of Toronto's Royal York (Nov. 19), was admitted to hospital the next day where he has been placed in intensive care. The evening of his performance he had been complaining about chest pains. When he was admitted to the hospital, it was discovered he had an irregular heart beat.

There is no word on his condition at press time, although he is still listed in critical condition.

WHAM making it big right across board

With the obvious success of WHAM's single, Wake Me Up Before You Go Go, CBS is gearing for "phenomenal sales" for the band's album, Make It Big.

Released as both a 7" and 12" the WHAM single has already surpassed the gold mark in Canada.

Art Graham of CBS Records Canada, noted that the band's first album, which contained the single Young Guns, did well in the Quebec market, and introduced the band to the rest of the country.

"Now, the second album has gone right across the board," he said. "We had advance orders on the LP, in excess of 30,000. With acts like Tina Turner, radio's not as concerned about the dance image and WHAM is a perfect example. The record is number one. I expect the LP to do a quarter million."

CBS is supporting the WHAM LP with T-shirts, bilingual header cards and posters. A tour is expected for early next year. Careless Whisper, which was a solo track by the group's George Michaels, and released in England, has been released as the band's next single in Canada.

CBS has also tied in the WHAM promotion through the Toronto-based rock video supplier, Network Video. The company, which has club memberships across the country, makes video compilations for the clubs as well as specials concentrating on single acts.

Allicock moves to Numbers position

Chris Allicock, formerly of WEA Music and most recently with Sold Gold Records, has joined forces with Maggie Hues in operating Numbers, an independent promotion company.

The company recently landed promotion for the two Smokey Robinson dates slated for Toronto's Harbour Castle Hilton (Nov. 29 and 30).

Ono exclusive marks CBC Lennon series

CBC Stereo's Night Lines (Stereo 96) will broadcast the Andy Peebles interview with Yoko Ono and the late John Lennon - conducted a scant 48 hours prior to the former Beatle's death in December of 1980.

The interview will be aired in ten parts, and will be heard just after midnight on Fridays and Saturdays beginning Nov. 30 and concluding Dec. 30. The broadcast schedule coincides with the fourth anniversary of Lennon's death.

To mark the CBC broadcast, Yoko Ono has given the CBC an exclusive interview. Her Voice Over is featured in the December issue of Radio Guide - a page-long piece in which she talks about motherhood and the art of communication.

CHUM makes bid for Maisonneuve properties

CHUM Ltd. of Toronto has taken a 120-day option to buy the assets of three companies who among them control four radio stations - two in Ontario, and two in Quebec.

The stations in question are Montreal's CKGM and CHOM-FM, as well as Windsor's CKWW and CJOM-FM.

CHUM will have representatives at the stations, able to assist staff and management during the option period.

Until CRTC approval is given for the change in ownership, management responsibility will remain with Geoff Stirling - President of the controlling companies, Maisonneuve Broadcasting, and Radiodiffusion Maisonneuve, both of Montreal, and Radio Windsor Canadian Ltd., of Windsor.

RCA and Arista sign distribution deal

RCA and Arista have announced an agreement whereby RCA will market and distribute Arista and Ariola product in Canada. The announcement was made jointly by Don Kollar, General Manager of RCA Canada's Record Division and Arista Vice President of International Operations, Rick Blaskey. The new agreement commences Jan. 1st. 1985, when a similar arrangement between Arista and PolyGram expires.



Diamond status for Richie's 2nd album

Quality Records President George Struth has announced confirmation from CRIA of diamond certification for Lionel Richie's second album, *Can't Slow Down*.

Said Struth: "It's been an exciting week. We have, this week, applied to CRIA for gold or platinum certification for no less than six titles."

Those applications are for: Lionel Richie/Lionel Richie (quadruple platinum LP), Billy Ocean/Suddenly (gold LP), Stevie Wonder/I Just Called (Double platinum single), Billy Ocean/Caribbean Queen (gold single), Lionel Richie/Hello (platinum single), Lionel Richie/Stuck On You (gold single).

"The sales of the Stevie Wonder single have now exceeded $\frac{1}{4}$ million units," continues Struth, "surpassing Lionel Richie's *Endless Love* (225,000 units), and the Stars On 45 single (200,000) as Quality's all-time best selling single."

Remixed Hart single beginning to catch

It Ain't Enough, the second single from Aquarius recording artist Cory Hart's debut LP *First Offense*, has been remixed, with the new version featuring guitar tracks by Michael Hehir. The production was supervised by Hart and producer Phil Chapman.

According to Capitol Records - distributors of Aquarius product in Canada - the label felt that the new version of the single would be more appropriate for CHR play, especially in the crucial American market. The video for the track was also redone.

It Ain't Enough has cracked the Top 30 in the U.S. and is Top 5 in some markets. The single's success follows action on the LP's first single, *Sunglasses At Night* - the latter peaking last summer after breaking the Top 10 in the U.S. *It Ain't Enough*, in its remixed form, has entered the RPM 100, first week at No. 88.

Hart recently commenced a promo tour of Australia and Japan, and will return to this continent shortly for the resumption of his U.S. tour with Rick Springfield.

Hart has been nominated in four categories for this year's Juno Awards: Composer, Single, Male Vocalist, and Best Video.

Export Jazz ensemble created by Inner Music

Montreal-based Inner Music has announced the creation of a new jazz ensemble, Export. The group comprises Charles Ellison (trumpet), Pete Magadini (percussion), Steve Holt (piano), and Fred Hamilton (bass).

The ensemble's 4 members possess impressive credentials - Ellison, active as a performer, composer, and educator, has worked with Cannonball Adderley; Magadini is noted as the author of *Polyrhythms*, a book popular as a text for percussionists; Steve Holt - whose current LP is a Juno nominee - has worked with Larry Coryell and James Moody; and Fred Hamilton, currently on staff at Concordia University, has worked with Barney Kessel, Charlie Byrd, and Mose Allison.

Export is something of a unique group in that the members are prominent as composers, not just performers. The group's debut engagement was at Montreal's L'Air Du Temps (Oct. 18-20).

There is no news at press time as to recording plans for Export.

Capitol's Bruce Murray plays Western dates

Capitol recording artist Bruce Murray, presently on release with his Two Hearts LP, is currently touring Western Canada, for the first time in several years. He is featured as part of the Anne Murray show which recently played to SRO houses at New York's Radio City Music Hall.

The Western tour kicked off in Vancouver (Nov. 15, 16), followed by Lethbridge (18), Calgary (19), Saskatoon (20, 21), Edmonton (22), Regina (23, 24), Winnipeg (26), and Brandon (27).

MIDEM '85 to feature radio program market

The creation of an international market for radio at MIDEM '85 may have seemed premature to some, but the event was apparently well attended by radio stations from France and abroad, and proved the existence of a market for radio programs.

In January 1985, the MIP-RADIO '85 will further confirm this interest. Buying, selling, and exchanging radio programs will be the order of the day for the participants - whether they are public or independent radio stations.

MIDEM lends itself to this type of venture, as it brings together record producers from international and independent companies, and program directors from the world's leading radio stations.

Language is being touted as "no longer a barrier", as many radio stations in Europe already broadcast programs in foreign languages.

MIP-RADIO will be held at the Palais des Festivals in Cannes, France, from January 28th through February 1st.

Ex-Beat members ignite General Public

England's General Public - led by ex-English Beat members Dave Wakeling (vocals, guitar) and Ranking Roger (vocals) - are on release with their debut I.R.S. LP, distributed in Canada by A&M. The album, titled *All The Rage*, is moving up the RPM 100 after 7 weeks of charting.

The other members of the group are arranger/keyboardist Mickey Billingham, drummer Stoker, and bassist Horace Panter. Former Clash guitarist Mick Jones performed on all the album's tracks but won't perform with General Public on any tours.

Sony Video to release Bowie & Duran Duran

Sony Video of New York has announced the release of a David Bowie first - a made for video mini-movie entitled *Jazzin' For Blue Jean*. The piece, in which the British singer plays 2 characters, was conceived by Bowie, directed by Julian Temple and written by Terry Johnson, and runs 20 minutes. The mini-movie is timely in that it coincides with the success Bowie is currently experiencing with *Tonight*, his latest EMI America LP release.

Sony has also announced that it will release a Video 45 by Duran Duran, titled *Dancing On The Valentine*. The Video will include *The Reflex*, as well as *New Moon On Monday*, and *Union Of The Snake*. The version of *New Moon* is a re-edit never seen previously on TV. The Video is 15 minutes in length.

Sony 45's and the Bowie mini-movie are available only in the U.S.

Quality pacts deal with British label

A licensing deal has been signed between Quality Records and the British-based Survival label. The latter has a roster, described by Quality as having been "well received by the British press, radio and TV."

Under the agreement, Quality will promote and distribute the label's product in Canada, which includes *Tik & Tok*, *Richard Bone*, *Thirteen At Midnight*, *Play*, and *Eddy & Sunshine*.

"We felt that this acceptance by the British press was a good sign," said Larry Macrae, A&R Manager for Quality Records. "Frankie Goes To Hollywood and Bronski Beat are breaking new ground in Canada, and we believe that groups like *Tik & Tok* and *Eddy & Sunshine* were of a similar nature. They are controversial and highly-visible acts."

Macrae added that this was the first of several announcements this year that would see Quality expand its involvement with British acts and labels.

Quality plans to introduce the label to both the media and retail with a low-list compilation album with material from each act on the roster. This will be followed by new releases from *Tik & Tok*, *Richard Bone*, and *Thirteen At Midnight* in both 12" and 7" formats.

Roger concludes, "We were happy with how the Beat did over here. You can tell your readers we're back and we're looking forward to touring."

General Public will be playing three Canadian dates, beginning at Toronto's Concert Hall (Nov. 30), and followed by Ottawa's Carlton University (Dec. 1), and Le Spectrum in Montreal (2).

Alert's Tom Berry has confirmed the label has signed the Toronto-based, six-piece rock group Sylum, a band that has recently been opening for Kim Mitchell's dates.

The popular Boy George and Culture Club breezed into the Gardens with a fast-paced package of entertainment that kept the capacity house fired up for the full time they were on stage. Although it has been reported that George has been unhappy with ticket sales, he treated this audience with all the finesse and excitement one would expect from our fashionable friend, in spite of the viciousness of the Toronto press. The large-screen video above the stage, showing the Club's every move, kept the Gardens in an uproar throughout the evening. Surprising was the age demographics - from toddlers to those in their forties. In some cases it looked like a family outing. Dedicated fans added a colourful twist, dressed up in Boy George's unique attire. The sound system was better than usual and the material, all familiar, ranged from Do You Really Want To Hurt Me, through to their current hit, The War Song. Much emphasis was placed on Boy George's "favourite", Mystery Man, which is a very promising Top 10 item. Opening for Culture Club was Tokyo, a Toronto-based band, that did an excellent job of keeping the fans entertained, particularly with their outing of The Red Line "a song that was written for the boy back home in Scotland," noted the group's lead singer.

RONNIE HAWKINS

Imperial Room/RHY - Toronto - Nov. 19/84

At the risk of upstaging Eddie Shack, Paul Ristead, and Tony (whoever), Ronnie Hawkins was obviously reaching. His bib and tucker (well-tailored tuxedo) was not comfortable, and the room appeared to be intimidating to the "romper", who is used to letting it all hang out. To his fans however, and the room was packed with them, The Hawk was still their idol. He launched into his nostalgia hook - Chuck Berry's Roll Over Beethoven, with Memphis blues and rockabilly influences that covered his early years in the business. One of his early buddies, Bo Diddley, joined Hawkins on stage and the sight of the two legends was rather awesome. Diddley shuffled and kicked with a few of his known numbers, including Bo Diddley Put The Rock In Rock 'N Roll. Patti Jannetta, fresh from her triumph at the SOPOT Festival in Poland, was brought on stage by Hawkins who described her as "hotter than the left cheek of Satan's ass", and she did conjure up visions of an act that was "fired up". She joined Diddley in a duet of Make Up Your Mind Tonight, which the both of them wrote. The back-up was exceptional: guitarist Bill Dillon, bassist Bob Boucher, Robin Hawkins (Ronnie's youngest son) on rhythm guitar, drummer Dave Lewis, and Larry Gowan on keyboards. The latter turned in a mesmerizing set that was the focal point of the entire evening. If this is the type of material he has on his new CBS album, the big break is close for Gowan.

Hamilton-based musician Chris O'Brien has just been added to the Area Code 705 band, the support group for Harold MacIntyre. Chris, who doubles on guitar and fiddle, replaces Harold Pilgrim, a member of the group for the past four years. He has moved to B.C.

Single change for Eastman

There has been a change in plans for the release of Eddie Eastman's next single. It had been originally decided to release *Take A Chance With Me*, but last minute changes has resulted in *Dreaming All Over Again*, co-written by Eastman and Gilles Godard, being scheduled for release in both Canada and the U.S. The single will be released on the Artisan label, which is based in Nashville.

Another Felix for Jerry and Jo'Anne

Jerry and Jo'Anne continue their popularity climb in Quebec province and just recently took honours at the ADISQ awards show where they won a Felix Award, their second in a row. The husband and wife team also shared the bill with Johnny Cash at a Montreal country festival which drew an audience of over 14,000, 90% of whom were French-speaking. Recording plans for the Sherbrooke-based Jerry and Jo'Anne should see the release of a single the early part of next year.

Golden readying album

Bruce Golden of Vankleek Hill, Ontario, is currently putting together material for his debut album expected to be released the spring of next year. He is presently on release with his *Snocan* single, *Midnight Ride*, penned by Bobby Lalonde and produced by Terry Carisse.

Denver to Russia and China

John Denver is following George Hamilton IV's lead and will be going behind the iron curtain . . . but he will also be taking a trip behind the bamboo curtain. He is scheduled to play three or four dates in Union Halls and Universities in the U.S.S.R. from Nov. 21 through Dec. 2. The dates were arranged as part of a U.S./U.S.S.R. cultural exchange. Denver will also be going to Peking, China (Feb. 21) for one concert. There will be a live broadcast of this concert via satellite to 60 countries. More information to follow in December.

Nashville Express nod to Winters

Noel Cannon, host of The Nashville Express (BBC Radio Scotland), has been giving heavy exposure to album tracks by Golden Eagle recording artist John Winters. After playing, *Someone Has Taken Your Place*, Noel says, "by the end of the spin, even the usually laid back audio staff were paying attention. If a singer can impress them,

they have something extra special going for them." John is currently making gains up the RPM Country 60 with his latest release, *Living With A Ghost*. Released in South Africa as singles are *Should You Ever Think Of Cheating*, *I Can't Take Care Of Mama*, *I Got Over You*, and *The Parting of The Ways*, all from John's first album. Ellis Family Band o

Ellis Family Band on tour

The Ellis Family Band, currently on release with their *Shotgun* single, *You're A Real Heartbreaker*, are currently touring the Maritimes, playing the Palamino Club in Chatham, New Brunswick (Nov. 7-11), the Country Corral, Fredericton (14-18), and J.R.'s Place in Charlottetown (19-24). The group also gained a large following through their tour of Ontario which took them to Durango's in Weston, Hamilton's Dallas, the Rodeo Roadhouse in Kingston, Busters in Newcastle, the Hotel Brampton, and the Stampede Corral in Kitchener. They also taped an Opry North show in Baldwin.

Juice at Lulu's

Juice Newton's recent show at Lulu's in Kitchener, Ontario, was given a hefty boost through CFTJ Radio Cambridge. The station's Assistant Program Director Dan Murphy and Music Director Kevin Kelly were on hand for the big night and were able to spend a bit of time with the popular RCA recording artist, currently moving up the RPM Country 60 with *Restless Heart*.

Mercey Brothers big on anthems

The word has spread . . . the Mercey Bros know how to attract the attention of large crowds by singing the national anthem. In fact, the MBS group are becoming in demand by professional sports teams to sing the national anthems at home games. They did the honours three times at Toronto Blue Jays games . . . and the Jays won all three games . . . and the Edmonton Oilers won their hockey game with the Mercey's waved the flag at an Edmonton home game. They've also made winners out of both Calgary and recently Edmonton of the CFL, after singing the anthem at their respective home games. Back to the business of country, Penny Perkins of MBS Promotions, reports the Mercey's will be taping Ronnie Prophet's *Rocky Mountain Inn*, which will be aired Nov. 19 next year. Also coming up (Nov. 16) the popular group will be doing a show for the inmates at the Edmonton Macimum Institute and later answering questions about the music industry.

J.K. Gulley promo'ing new single

John Ken Gulley is monitoring the action on his new single, *Stay Lady Stay*, a Gulley original released on the Nashville-based Prophet label. The single was produced by Joe Bob Barnhill at the Waxworks. J.K. is already known in the country music community as a songwriter, having written material for Mary Bailey and Cindy Hurt (*Talk To Me Loneliness*, both of which went Top 20 in Canada and Top 30 in the U.S. for both artists respectively), Jessie Burns (*All From Loving You* and *Last Chance For Paradise*), and Ronnie Prophet

(*Smooth Operator*). J.K. has been involved with producing groups as well (Dusty Road), and was Musical Director of Global TV's *Easy Country* as well as a featured artist on Ronnie Prophet's *Grand Ole Country* (CTV Network). He has been working in Nashville as a studio guitarist and lead guitarist for name acts including Freddie Hart, Billie Jo Spears, Dick Damron, Jessie Burns, and the late Marty Robbins, to name just a few. Programmer reaction to the single has been encouraging for J.K. Writes Lanny Lee Hagen of CFCW Camrose "Great song. Extra copy please." Greg Morgan, Music Director at CJNS Meadow Lake, says, "Good vocal arrangement," and Bill McNeil, Music Director at CKPE-FM Sydney, Nova Scotia, writes, "Good song. Not only is John a fine writer but he sings a pretty good song too. We'll give this one lots of attention."

The first Christmas card

The first Christmas card of the year to arrive at RPM was from Ronnie Prophet, a very thoughtful artist who always takes time out of his busy schedule to stay in touch.

Julie Gibb turns 13

Julie Gibb, who released her first record at the age of 12, has just turned 13 and her single, *Lady, Lady*, released on the 16th Avenue label, is beginning to take shape. The single, written by Stewart Harris, was produced in Nashville by Stan Campbell. Unfortunately, the single carries only one-part *Cancon* - it's a good production and the vocal projection by this youngster from Oak Ridges, Ontario is refreshing.

Majcan LP release on Bel Air

Latest from the Bel Air camp is a unique and exceptionally-well produced album by August Majcan, an accordianist extraordinaire from Bonavista, Newfoundland. . The *Truth About The Rubber Boot*, a traditional outing with words by Glenn Brown, has been taken as the first single. The album, which is titled *A Breath Of Newfoundland*, was produced by Brown at Brampton's Orchard Studios. Musicians on the session were bassist Andrew Affleck, drummer Jamie Purdy, steelman Mickey Andrews, Wendell (Melvin) Ferguson on rhythm and lead, and Cyril Way on vocals.

Eyeline/Panther push on Aylward

Sean Eyre of Eyeline Productions and Brian Edwards from the Panther label in Peterborough, dropped by the RPM offices with the latest on their artist Joe Aylward. Joe is currently on release with his single, *All Aboard*, which is also the title of his album. Joe recently taped the Tommy Hunter show and played the Country Gold club in Toronto, which was a taping for Opry North, in which he shared the bill with Tim Taylor and Anita Perris. He will be playing a CKLY-sponsored country concert at Lindsay's Academy Theatre (Dec. 1) and is set for a date at the Oshawa Corral the first week in January. Also coming up during the summer months is a tour with Wilf Carter and Kitty Wells which will play dates in Oshawa, Marmora, and Sudbury, just a few of the dates firmed at press time.

New single from Lou Natale

The latest from Dee Communications is a Lou Natale single, *Where Would I Be Without You*, a Natale penning, produced by himself and Barry Kaplan. The flip is an instrumental of the plug side. This is Lou's sixth single release for Dee Communications.

MRB on the road with winter tour

The Vancouver-based Midnite Rodeo Band (MRB) are currently on the road with their winter tour. They have already played Grande Prairie and Lethbridge in Alberta and will be playing Saskatoon's Texas T (Nov. 12-17), followed by Edmonton's Cook County (19-24), the Brooks Hotel (Nov. 26 through Dec. 1), Calgary's Cross Country (3-8), the Silver Buckle in Medicine Hat (10-15), and back to Vancouver for recording from Dec. 17 through 29. MRB tours are booked by Bill Maxim of Edmonton's Magnum Music. The group is managed by Richard Watt of Double R Promotions in Vancouver. MRB are currently moving up the RPM Country 60 with their RCA single release, *Never Got Over Loving You*, which was taken from their MRB2 album.

Cancon scoring higher on RPM Country 60

Cancon recordings are showing a much greater acceptance with country programmers, resulting in more chart numbers and believable playlistings. These chart numbers have been reflected on the RPM Country 60 which this week lists four Cancon singles in the Top 10: *Nobody Loves Me Like You Do* by Anne Murray and Dave Loggins, which was No. 1 on the Nov. 24 chart (No. 4 this week), *If This Is Love*, the duet by Ronnie Prophet and Glory-Anne Carriere (No. 6), the duet of Gilles Godard and Kelita Haverland, *Nothing Good About Goodbye* (No. 7), and *Love At Last Sight* by the Mercey Brothers (No. 8).

The Godard/Haverland single is also making gains up the RPM A/C chart.

There has also been an increase in productions by country acts, some of whom are now enjoying solid national distribution, as in the case of the Savannah label, distributed by Quality. Terry Carisse (*Two Broken Hearts*) and Terry Sumson (*That's When You Know It's Over*) are climbing the RPM Country 60, a rare occasion for one independent label to have two strong chart items.

Country programmer thinking has also changed, many of whom are now integrating Cancon with foreign artists on their charts and intro'ing and extro'ing Cancon with an obvious note of enthusiasm that has been lacking in the past. Noted one programmer: "Canadian countent recordings are much better today than even a couple of years ago. There has been an improvement in their song material and the attitude of the artists and groups has become much more professional. Now, when I go through my pile of releases, I find myself looking for the MAPL logo first, rather than look for the names of the big country acts."


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
