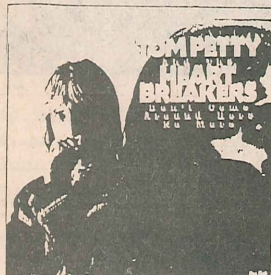

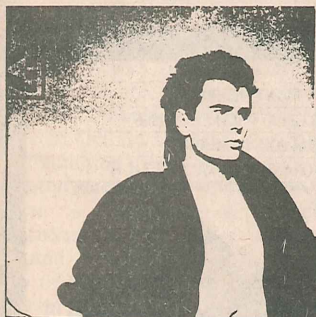

## Phil Collins Goes Casual

Atlantic recording artist Phil Collins is on release with **No Jacket Required**, his 3rd solo LP. **One More Night** has been taken as the first single. Collins, a member of Atlantic recording act Genesis since 1970, garnered solo renown in Canada with his 2 previous efforts — **Face Value** and **Hello, I Must Be Going**. In addition to his duties as drummer/vocalist with Genesis, Collins has produced several major LPs and recorded with acts such as **Brian Eno** and **Robert Plant**.

Renowned for over a decade internationally as a crack drummer and crucial element in the success of Genesis, Phil Collins has also fashioned a reputation for himself as a producer for artists ranging from John Martyn to Eric Clapton.

Collins' recent collaboration with Earth Wind & Fire's Philip Bailey produced a Top 30 LP — **Chinese Wall** — and a No. 1 single, **Easy Lover**. He played drums and sang on the LP in addition to producing it.

Collins first appeared as a member of Genesis on 1971's **Nursery Cryme**, an LP that included the now classic **The Musical Box**. Over the next 4 years, Genesis firmed their reputation as one of the most skilled and instrumentally potent progressive-rock bands of the '70s. While some critics assailed the band's veiled pretentiousness and frequently elliptic lyrics, many were won over by the textural, keyboard-dominated sound of LPs like **Selling England By The Pound** and **The Lamb Lies Down On Broadway**.

There were those who speculated that the departure of vocalist Peter Gabriel in 1975 amounted to the end for Genesis, but in the intervening decade Collins has given the lie to such considerations — taking the band from its position as an occasionally overblown pomp-rock spectacle (circa Gabriel) to the slick, tight, '80s-pop outfit that is Genesis today.

By the 1981 release of his debut solo LP, **Face Value**, Collins had recorded with Brand X — something of a recreational project — and done session work with composer/producer Brian Eno and British rock legends Thin Lizzy.

**Face Value**, an LP that sold in excess of 400,000 copies in Canada yielded 2 hit singles — **I Missed Again** and **In The Air Tonight**. **I Missed Again**, a Top 10 single, was as brassy (courtesy the Phoenix Horns) and uptempo as **In The Air Tonight** was ominous and moody; the latter featured a by-now-famous imprimatur — Collins' booming drum fills surrounding a frequently syncopated backbeat. **Face Value** went to No. 1 in May of 1981.

**Hello, I Must Be Going** — the second Collins solo LP — sold less than **Face Value**, but sustained Collins' profile as a solo writer and performer of substance. The LP, released in 1982, provided 3 singles — **You Can't Hurry**

**Love**, popularized by The Supremes, **I Don't Care Anymore**, and **I Cannot Believe It's True**.

1982 also witnessed the first Collins production projects — John Martyn's **Glorious Fool** and Frida's **Something's Going On**.

Collins accepted Robert Plant's offer to join his debut tour of North America in 1983. Critics subsequently noted Collins as instrumental in the success of Plant's shows.



Collins was busy behind the board once again in 1984, producing LPs for Adam Ant (**Strip**) and Bailey. 1984 was also noteworthy for the No. 1 status accorded **Against All Odds** (**Take A Look At Me Now**), a Collins vocal from the film **Against All Odds**.

Eric Clapton's new LP, **Behind The Sun**, lists Collins as one of the record's producers. He should hit North America soon to tour behind **No Jacket Required**, however no Canadian dates have been firmed as of yet. The new LP shipped over platinum in Canada, and presumably will replicate Collins' previous successes at retail and radio given his high profile at present. **No Jacket Required** was produced by Collins and Hugh Padgham. —KCW



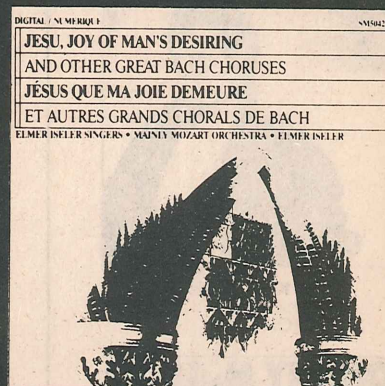
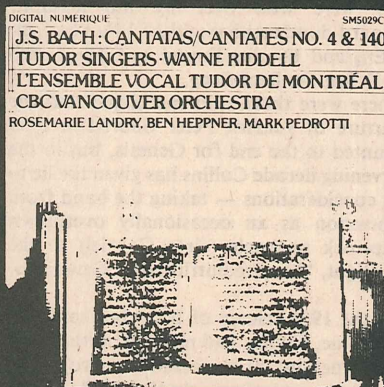
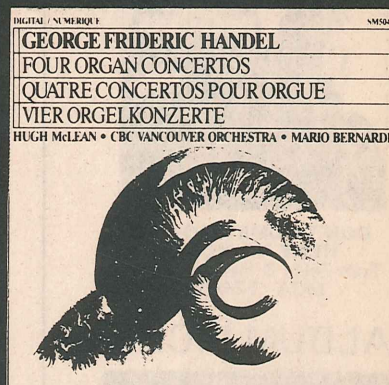
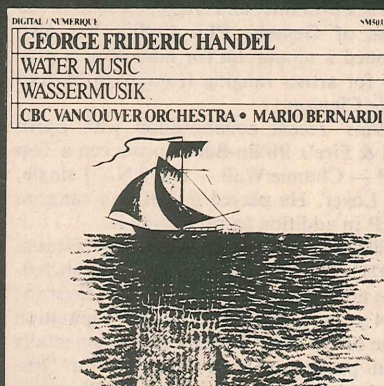

## Special Frankie single issued by Island

Island Records has issued a new and special single from Frankie Goes To Hollywood, titled *Welcome To The Pleasuredome*, the fourth single taken from their double LP.

A 7" single, in addition to containing the re-mixed edited version of *Pleasuredome*, will contain two new songs, not found on the album: *Happy Hi*, and a cover version of the T-Rex '70s classic, *Bang A Gong*, titled *Get It On*.

The 12" single will contain the extended re-mixed version of *Pleasuredome*, *Get It On*, *Happy Hi*, plus a live version of *Relax* as a bonus. A video is also expected of *Pleasuredome*.

The double album, their first, is now well over the platinum mark in Canada.

Island assembled a special 3-pak cassette package for key radio stations in Canada. Entitled *The Frankie Goes To Hollywood Pleasure-Pak*, the package contains the *Welcome To The Pleasuredome* LP recording, along with two mini-cassettes, one containing the 3 different versions of *Relax*, the

long version, and edited and instrumental. The other cassette contains the two different versions of *Two Tribes*, plus Frankie's cover of the Edwin Starr classic, *War*. All 3 cassettes feature the new improved sound quality.

Canadian tour dates are being pencilled in for May.

## Agency expands roster

The Agency, Toronto's largest booking agency, has announced the signing of the following acts for exclusive agency representation: *Triumph*, *Platinum Blonde*, *M+M*, *The Parachute Club*, *David Wilcox*, *Strange Advance*, *Gowan*, *Luba*, *Honeymoon Suite*, *B.T.O.*, *Michael Damian*, *Jack Green*, and *Helix*.

Vancouver-based S.L. Feldman and Associates has exclusive booking rights to the entire The Agency roster, which will now include the artists listed above.

## Campus media session for LaMarche LP

A&M Records held a "campus media only" reception Feb. 19 at their Toronto offices in order to premiere the new LP from Jim LaMarche, *Searching For The Sunrise*. The video for the LP's first single, *Innocent Little Boys Cry*, was also premiered. The LP ships to radio Mar. 11.

Thirty-one student reps attended, from Toronto-area colleges such as *Seneca*, *Humber*, and *Scarborough (UofT)*, as well as from centres outside Toronto — *University of Guelph*, *Western (London)*, and *University of Waterloo*. A&M officials expressed regret that nobody representing *Ryerson Polytechnical Institute* in Toronto attended the session. Toronto retail representation came from *Record Peddler*, *Star Records*, and *A&A's* downtown location.

LaMarche's video for *Innocent Little Boys Cry*, filmed last November in *Woodstock, Ont.*, was directed by *Patricia Sims* and produced by *Jamie Boyd* — noted for his critically acclaimed documentary, *Falasha: Exile of the Black Jews*.

The video features LaMarche's wife, as well as segments from the Yugoslavian film *Cruel Diagonals*.

## Local musicians aid drought relief

A benefit concert featuring *The Uncle Fatback Band* will be held Mar. 24 at *Raven's* in *Mississauga*, just west of *Toronto*. The intent is to raise money to support *The Canadian Save The Children Fund's* programs in drought stricken countries in *Africa*. The lineup of guest artists firmed at press time is: *Liberty Silver*, *Tony Flaim*, *Jo-Ann Brooks & Jeff Jones*, *Smokey Burke*, *Kenny Neal*, *Liz Tilden*, *Eugene Smith*, *Diane Brooks*, *B.J. Reed*, *Heather Katz*, *Danny Middlebrook*, *Danny "B"*, and *Nancy Simmons*.

## Cook & Tyson team for Porky's III soundtrack

Toronto songwriters *B.J. Cook* and *David Tyson* will have their composition, *Has Heaven Had A Change Of Heart*, included in the original soundtrack from *Porky's Revenge*, the third sequel to the film series following *Porky's I* and *II*. The track was produced by *Tyson* at *ZaZa Sound* in *Toronto*. *Cook* is well known in *Canadian music* circles as both a songwriter and background vocalist for session work. *Tyson*, also a recognized songwriter has written material for several name *Canadian acts* and has also produced sessions. These include *The Arrows*, and most recently *Belinda Metz*. He has also co-wrote with *Eddy Schwartz*. The *Cook/Tyson* composition is represented by *ATV Music*.

The soundtrack, which features guitarist *Dave Edmunds* and his friends, has been scheduled for a late *March* release by *CBS*. *Edmunds' friends* include *Robert Plant* and *Phil Collins*, under the guise of *The Crawling Kingsnakes*, as well as *Carl Perkins*, *Jeff Beck*, *The Stray Cats*, *Willie Nelson*, *George Harrison*, and *The Fabulous Thunderbirds*.

Ex-Beatle *George Harrison* performs his version of a previously-unreleased *Bob Dylan* composition, *I Don't Want To Do It*. The *Fabulous Thunderbirds* cover the *Lloyd Price* classic *Stagger Lee*, and *Willie Nelson* performs *Elvis Presley's Love Me Tender*.

*Kornelsen's* new position will make him responsible for the activities of the *Capitol promotion team* across *Canada*, as well as the *Press and Publicity* functions.

## WHAM tops MuchMusic video survey

*WHAM*, on release with the second single taken from their *Make It Big LP*, have the top spot on the *MuchMusic video survey* for the week ending *Feb. 22*.

Rounding out the *Top 5* on the chart are *Hall & Oates* at *No. 2* with *Method Of Modern Love*, *Billy Ocean* at *No. 3* with *Loverboy*, *Foreigner* at *No. 4* with *I Want To Know What Love Is*, and *Don Henley* at *No. 5* with *The Boys Of Summer*.

## MUSEXPO/VIDEXPO dates set for U.K.

*MUSEXPO '85*, the 10th *International Record and Music Industry Market*, and *VIDEXPO '85*, the 4th *International Video Market and Conference*, will be held concurrently from *Oct. 16* to *Oct. 18* at the *Kensington Exhibition Centre* in *London*.

The announcement was made by *Roddy S. Shashoua* — *Chairman of International Music Industries Ltd. (USA)* and *International Trade and Exhibitions Ltd. (U.K.)* and founder of *MUSEXPO* and *VIDEXPO*.

This represents the first time that the event will be held outside *North America*, following *MUSEXPO Headquarters' move* to *London* in 1984.

Over 3,000 representatives of 1,000 firms in 45 countries are expected to attend the event. These will include major and indie record labels, music publishers, record producers, video production companies, and cassette manufacturers.

In conjunction with *MUSEXPO's 10th Anniversary* in 1985, 2 additional events will be held — open to both *MUSEXPO* and *VIDEXPO* participants. These will be the 1st *International Music Video Festival*, and the 1st *International New Music Seminar*.

## David Foster shines at Grammys

Up until just this year, not too many knew who David Foster was, a sad commentary for the Canadian recording industry. This year, Foster, who was born in Victoria, B.C. and now lives in Vancouver, picked up 2 Grammys: as Producer of The Year, for producing Chicago, which he tied with Lionel Richie, and for best instrumental arrangement, accompanying vocals for Chicago's Hard Habit To Break. Did you know that Foster won a Grammy several years ago for Earth, Wind & Fire's hit, After The Love Is Gone. This song, by the way was written about his breakup with his first wife B.J. Cook, who now lives in Toronto, and is perhaps Foster's biggest booster.

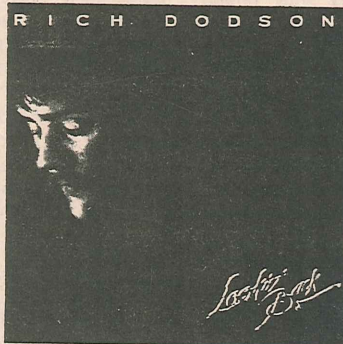

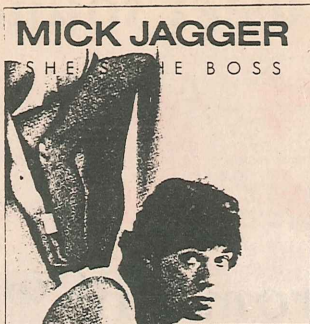


## THE FIRM - Rock

The Firm - Atlantic - 78-12391-Q  
This collaboration between guitar hero Jimmy Page and vocalist Paul Rodgers while having a few soft spots, generally reaffirms the reputations of both as formative rock influences of the '60s and '70s. With the assistance of Chris Slade (drums), and Tony Franklin (bass, synthesizer), the duo have assembled 8 original tracks and the Mann/Weil/Spector classic You've Lost That Lovin' Feeling. Radioactive, currently shooting up playlists, has been taken as the first single, but there are others to note here: Closer, with its Zeppelinesque guitar riff and clipped horn bursts, and Rodgers' Money Can't Buy - very reminiscent of his better work with Bad Company.

Overall, a tentative but sincere debut that presumably signals the active return of both the band's principals to a business bereft of them for far too long.

Produced by Page and Rodgers at The Sol Studios, Berkshire, England. Terrific jacket art work, but word of mouth will sell this one.

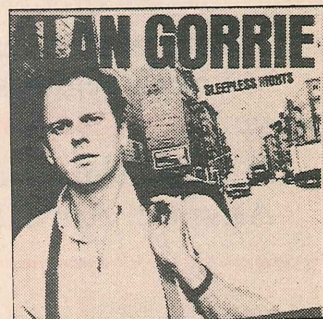

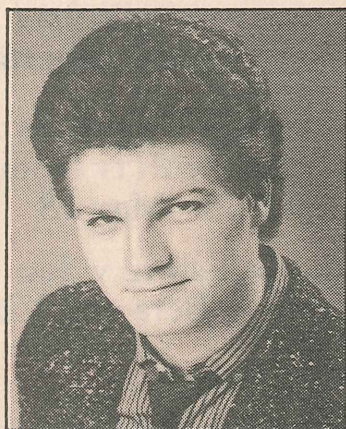

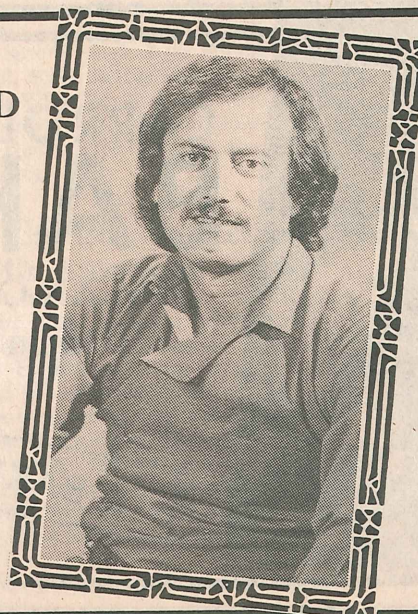

## Dahlquist as Mame in Toronto Production

Patricia Dahlquist, a 1975 Juno winner as Best New Female Artist of The Year, stars as the "rich and outrageous socialite Mame", in the Canadian production of the highly-acclaimed Broadway musical.

Three youngsters take turn playing Patrick as a boy. Patrick, as a young man, is handled well by Brian Hill, who shows great promise as a singer and dancer. Pam Hyatt is an excellent Vera Charles and Peggy Mahon steals the show in the Agnes Gooch part, which is designed to steal the show.

Dahlquist started out in the business as a lounge singer and got her first break as a vocalist with Hagood Hardy & The Montage. She became one of the "fresh, new talents",

in the recording business, releasing several singles and albums that established her on an international level. She also toured with

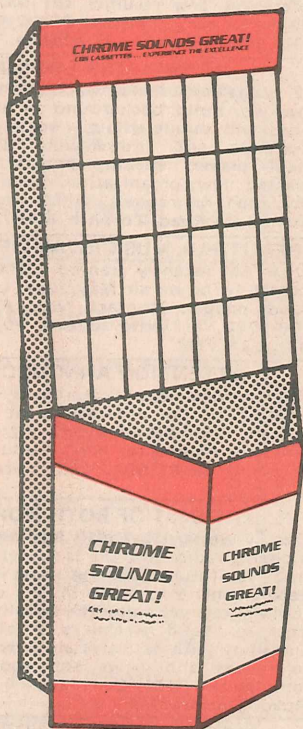

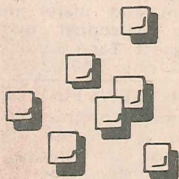

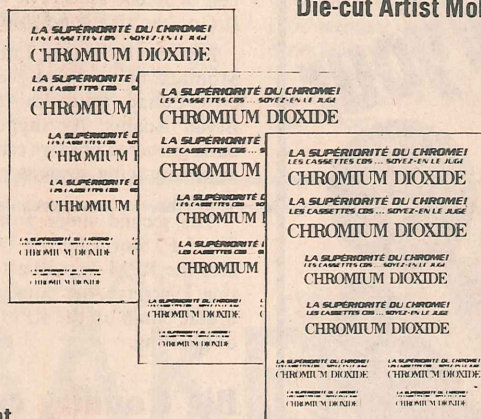
