NEW LP SIGNALS CHANGE FOR TRADE

True North recording act Rough Trade - featuring founding members Carole Pope and Kevan Staples - are on release with *O Tempora! O Mores!*, an album produced by Terry Brown at Toronto's Slime Pit. The record's 10 tracks sport Pope's trademark vocal stylings and Staples' perennially steady guitar work. *Sexual Outlaw* has been taken as the first single. After 3 weeks of charting, the album is making impressive gains up the RPM 100.

Rough Trade was actually put together in 1968 when Pope and Staples met at an audition - but it wasn't until 1974 when the duo did their first date as Rough Trade at Toronto's Roxy Theatre, when the story begins in earnest.

The band rapidly became a club favourite, with Pope generating a vamped up R&B vocal, while Staples laid down chunky guitar chords and acted as the band's cheerleader. Something of a breakthrough for Rough Trade was the 1976 release of a direct-to-disc LP - the first in Canada, which was produced by Jack Richardson. The band was support for England's Roxy Music at Toronto's Massey Hall that same year.

The next few years, prior to signing with Toronto-based True North Records, witnessed several significant events - opening for San Francisco's Tubes, a TV/radio simulcast, and a support slot on Tim Curry dates in Ottawa and Toronto.

In addition to the new LP, the band's output for the True North label includes *Avoid Freud* (1980), *For Those Who Think Young* (1981), and *Shaking The Foundations* (1982). The band also released an EP in 1982, titled *I Want To Live*. That same year Pope won a U-Know Award as Best Female Vocalist.

In the course of recent interviews with RPM, Pope and Staples talked about the new record.

Asked if she would agree that *O Tempora! O Mores!* contains some of her best vocals ever, Pope replied: "Yes, I would agree. I was more inspired . . . I liked the music better, it's more exciting and it's easy for me to sing rock and roll."

Pope says that neither she nor Staples have ever consciously established a process for writing songs. "There's no process really," she explains. "We've gone through all kinds of experimental things, and I think it takes a long time to learn how to write good songs; I admire someone who can write a really good song with a really good hook."

Staples jumps in with, "There's no certain method to our process. It's been the same for as long as we've known each other, although a certain discipline is involved."

Regarding *Sexual Outlaw* - the first single from *O Tempora! O Mores!* - Pope is adamant, "Sexual Outlaw is not as 'different' as the other material," she points out. "It sounds like Rough Trade."

In 1983, Rough Trade were support on several Canadian dates for the David Bowie Serious Moonlight Tour.

"We don't usually open for anyone," Pope explains, "But if there was anyone we would open for it would be David Bowie. He came and saw us, he like us, and his band liked our band."



Has the band abandoned for good the "fixed format" that they once had? "We went with different musicians," says Pope, "because not everybody could play every feel; the record is basically funk on one side, and rock on the other."

Tours of Quebec and the Maritimes are pencilled in for Rough Trade, with a Toronto date (Dec. 8) confirmed at press time for Massey Hall.

Kevan Staples is obviously pleased with the new album.

"I'm really happy," he insists. "By this point in the process, I'm usually tired of listening to the material. Not as much on this one though, it went really well. It represents Rough Trade." - KCW

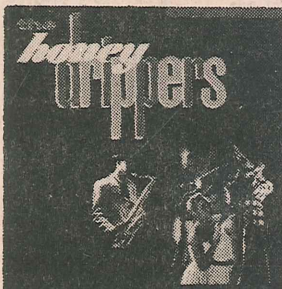

Wood resigns from CHUM to launch own station

CHUM General Manager J. Robert Wood has tendered his resignation from the powerful broadcast group to take effect Dec. 31. He leaves his long-term association with CHUM to put together his own FM station in the Toronto area. Joining CHUM Toronto's AM operation in 1968 as assistant to the program director, he moved quickly through the ranks, steering the station to success after success in the ratings war.

In the mid-70's Wood was appointed National Program Director for the group, and in 1980 became CHUM General Manager.

Wood had long been contemplating his own operation and when the CRTC lifted the moratorium on new stations, he decided to make his move.

"It was something I've always wanted to do," he said. "I think just about every broadcaster at one time has an ambition to have his own station. The CRTC lifted the freeze for applications and it was the last frequency available on FM. It seemed like the time had come. I'm very fortunate to have this opportunity."

If things go as expected, Wood hopes to have the station make its on-air debut at

97.3 on the FM band, the beginning of 1986.

Wood stressed that he would not be the sole owner of the new station. The names of his partners in the venture will not be revealed at this time.

"The type of format the station we will have, has not yet been determined," Wood continues. "We have a couple of formats in mind. The choice will be determined by research and other material."

Despite the selection of music styles available to listeners in Southern Ontario, Wood is confident there is still room for another. "It would be safe to say there are voids in the spectrum of music offered not yet filled here," he continues, concluding with, "For instance, there's not a country and western station on FM in Toronto."

A decision by the CRTC, on who the successful applicant will be, is expected to be made within three weeks.

Virgin sets date for Eurythmics release

The 2nd week of November has been pencilled in by Virgin Records Canada for the release of the soundtrack of the modern-day adaptation of George Orwell's 1984, with music recorded by Eurythmics.

The LP will be preceded by the single, Sex Crime, issued both as a 7" and 12" single. The film, starring the late Richard Burton in his last role, is expected to open across Canada the end of November.

The soundtrack was produced by Dave Stewart of the Eurythmics, and produced at their Church Studios in England. The music was specially produced to accompany the various movie scenes.

In addition to the music for the motion picture, the album also includes 3 additional tracks not in the film, but are expected to be released as singles. Sex Crime is the first. Videos are expected to follow.

Hall & Oates featured on RCA video release

October videocassettes from RCA include entries from Hall & Oates, Kool And The Gang, Golden Earring, and a variety of artists in a compilation.

Hall & Oates Video Collection - 7 Big Ones features Say It Isn't So, Maneater, Private Eyes, I Can't Go For That, Family Man, Adult Education, and One On One.

Kool And The Gang's Kool And The Gang - Tonight features Celebration, Tonight, Joanna, and Ladies Night.

Live From The Twilight Zone is the release from Holland's Golden Earring. The set includes Mission Impossible, When The Lady Smiles, and the title track.

Hot Rock Videos is a compilation of several acts, including Eurythmics (Sweet Dreams), The Kinks (Come Dancing), The Alan Parsons Project (Don't Answer Me), Jefferson Starship (No Way Out), Rick Springfield (I've Done Everything For You), Lou Reed (I Love You, Suzanne), and Icicle Works (Whisper To A Scream).

A&M inks Raffi to U.S. distribution deal

A&M Records Canada has announced a U.S. distribution agreement for the Shoreline label - known in Canada as Troubadour, the successful Canadian record label owned and operated by Canadian children's recording artist Raffi.

A&M will distribute and market all product on the Shoreline label beginning with the release of Singable Songs For The Very Young - a record which has sold more than 250,000 copies in Canada.

Raffi's label was founded in 1976, with a \$3,000 bank loan and Raffi's living room as the warehouse, and has since gone on to sell close to a million LPs in Canada.

Certifications to date include 1 double platinum award, 3 platinum citations, and 2 gold certifications.

New McCartney LP features top names

Beatle fans will find a star-studded cast of names on the latest Paul McCartney project, Give My Regards To Broad Street.

CBS has already released, No More Lonely Nights, as the first single. A 12" extended version is also being released, which features a colourful custom jacket. The 20th Century film, reportedly carrying a production tag of \$8 million, will open across Canada on Oct. 26.

There are 14 songs in the soundtrack, including new titles as well as old favourites such as Eleanor Rigby, Good Day Sunshine, Band On The Run, and So Bad.

Guesting on the session were John Paul Jones of Led Zeppelin, Jeff Porcaro and Steve Lukather of Toto, Eric Stewart of 10CC, Louis Johnson of the Johnson Brothers, to name just a few.

Joining McCartney in the film are his wife Linda, Ringo Starr and his wife Barbara Bach, Tracey Ullman, Ralph Richardson, Bryan Brown, and George Martin, the latter, of course, the producer of the Beatle classics.

The musical is based on an international pop star, who after working on a new LP for a year, discovers that the master tapes have been stolen.

McCartney apparently came upon the idea for the film after reading a story about the British punk band, The Sex Pistols. The master tapes of their first album disappeared mysteriously.

Morrison on release with Gaye tribute

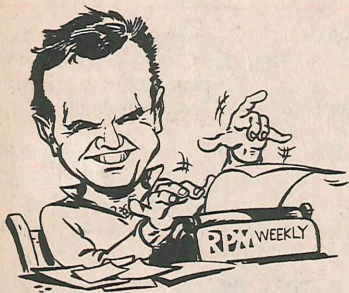
Musician/producer Rick Morrison is on release with a single paying homage to the late Marvin Gaye. Entitled Marvin's Magic, the single includes bits of Heard It Through The Grapevine, Let's Get It On, and Sexual Healing, and is released on the Tembo label.

The single was produced by Morrison, with the aid of computers in his own studio. He hopes to gain dance club action on both sides (the flip is titled Mind Drive). "This R&B compilation is right up my alley," says Morrison, "considering the work I've done with people such as Martha Reeves and Long John Baldry." Mind Drive is 4 parts Cancon, with Marvin's Magic 2 parts. It's also interesting to note that the Fairlight Computer was used in the session.

Another project for Morrison involves performing the theme music for CBC-TV's Parenting, hosted by Joyce Davidson. The program's executive producers saw one of Morrison's shows at Toronto's Bamboo Club, and asked him to prepare something pertaining to parenting.

Morrison is producer on the newest studio project for Long John Baldry, who took a fancy to Morrison's writing when he heard his Zombie For Your Love song. Morrison's efforts have, to date, produced an LP's worth of material. "John went through a variety of situations," Morrison explains. "and I had a few tunes in the can which he liked; I seem to be able to coax the best from him."

Video industry is wanting!!!

We are hearing a great deal about the video industry and how important it is to the record industry, which is very true. A major problem I've noticed, is a lack of real knowledgeable people to represent the video industry. I attended the Rockamerica video conference in New York, a couple of months ago and came away with the impression that the panelists and so-called leaders in the industry didn't know the territory. For the most part, they were record people, and record people first, and most of them admitted they didn't know too much about video. I have just returned from the 1st Saint-Tropez Video Festival, and the Europeans aren't much better. It appears that everything happening with videos is by accident. Fortunately, music video is on a roll and the percentage of those who have and who will luck out, will remain very high for a period of time . . . anyway.

Well . . . retail is still very hot!!!

I don't know how Junk Culture ever got by our proof reader (RPM - Oct. 13), but the really hot Culture Club single is The War Song, and just look at it bulleting up the chart. Also very very hot are Tears by John Waite, I Wanna Rock, by Twisted Sister, and a very impressive Cancon entry from Bryan Adams, titled Run To You. Albums that will score at retail are Waking Up With A House On Fire by Culture Club, Honeydrippers' Volume 1, and Barry Gibb's Now Voyager.

Mitchell firmed for Massey Hall headline

Kim Mitchell will make a return of sorts to Toronto (Nov. 16), with a headline date at Massey Hall.

The Alert recording artist's show will wrap his Ready, Willing and Able Tour, which was recently extended to include major markets throughout Western Canada.

Mitchell's Alert LP, akimbo alog, was certified gold in September, and is expected to go platinum shortly. The second single from the LP, All We Are, looks to match, if not top the success of Go For Soda, the debut single.

The remainder of the tour is now scheduled for London (Oct. 21), Vancouver (25), Calgary (27), Edmonton (28), Winnipeg (30), Regina (31), Saskatoon (Nov. 3), Ottawa (15), and the final date in Toronto.

The live show, as seen on this tour, was recently captured on camera by the Much-Music Network, and is due to air sometime in early November. Taped at the Oshawa Civic Centre, earlier this month, the simulcast will be the first undertaking of its kind by the channel.

Coinciding with the broadcast will be the premiere of Mitchell's first video release, That's A Man.

U2's Unforgettable Fire exploding at retail

U2's latest Island LP release, Unforgettable Fire, has become one of the label's hottest selling releases, surpassing the platinum mark (100,000 units sold), within 10 days of release.

On its release, the album was one of the biggest sellers reported at retail which was reflected on the RPM 100 album chart, bulleting from No. 76 to No. 55 and the following week up to No. 29 with no signs of slowing.

Island's Lee Silverside reports strong sales on a national scale. "The sales far exceeded our expectations in the quickness that buyers responded to it," he explains. "Right now, we're just making sure we don't run out of stock. We're overwhelmed with the response from the public."

Available from Island is a 28-minute documentary video of the making of the album, to be used for promotional purposes. This, is in addition to the music video of the first single, Pride (In The Name Of Love).

There is a possibility of a Toronto date for the band before Christmas. Select dates are expected for Canada in the New Year. The group is currently in the midst of their world tour and scored sold out dates in Australia.

CJBK 1290's third annual Run With A Heart, presented jointly by the station and the Heart Fund Foundation, was staged this year on Thanksgiving Day at London's Springbank Park. More than 500 runners took part, with all entrants receiving free T-shirts. Over \$20,000 was raised for research.

Worthington To FM 98

Peter Worthington, former Editor and columnist for the Toronto Sun, has joined CHFI-FM 98 as a commentator on the Chronicle newsmagazine segment. The program is heard weekdays at 12:30 pm.

Z99's Rocktober Rockoff rockin'

Z99's second annual Rocktober Rockoff, Regina's only rocking chair marathon, got underway Oct. 10. The station drew names from those registered and at 12 noon, in front of Kelly's Electronic World, the rocking began. The one who rocks the longest will win a new stereo system valued at \$999.99, plus 99 LPs from Kelly's and Z99. Last year's winner rocked for 72 hours non-stop, and has yet to recover completely. Contestants are allowed a 10 minute break every 2 hours. Says Z99's Promotion Director Jon Dacquist, "Z99's Rocktober Rockoff, Rocksoff Rocktober 10th, and continues until a winner is proclaimed . . . conscious or unconscious."

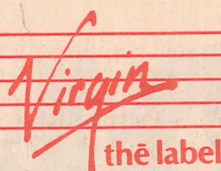
