HALL & OATES - ROCK & SOUL FUSION

On May 23, Daryl Hall and John Oates performed at the Apollo Theatre's re-opening gala. They were chosen for their unique ability to blend black and white musical influences. Appearing with the duo were ex-Temptation members David Ruffin and Eddie Kendrick - the Temptations providing Hall & Oates early inspiration. This performance was recorded and *A Nite At The Apollo Live* is now charting. Proceeds from the single are benefitting the United Negro College Fund and Live Aid's African Relief project

Hall & Oates' ability to blend black with white music has led to Canadian platinum LP's, 5 gold LP's, 5 gold singles, and a Grammy nomination for the 1981 single *Private Eyes*. As Hall says, "The coming together of black and white musical forms is what makes pop music happen." In the U.S. Hall & Oates are one of only 3 white acts to have ever hit the top of the R&B charts, and according to RIAS figures, they are rock's all-time best-selling duo with over 40 million records sold.

Hall & Oates come from similar Pennsylvania backgrounds. In the '60s while Oates was performing in Philadelphia with The Masters, immersing themselves in R&B, Hall was spending time playing with the Delfonics, The Three Degrees, and Tommy Bell before forming his own group, The Temptones. It was Hall who invited Oates to play with the Temptones in a New York showcase. They went on to share a bill, in Philadelphia with Smokey Robinson, Marvin Gaye and James Brown.

However suggests Hall, "we were not influenced that much by black music. We were influenced by early rock 'n' roll and soul music - which was not black; it was integrated music." To which Oates adds: "Especially in Philadelphia - there were a lot of white musicians playing with black musicians."

1970 saw Hall & Oates leave the Philadelphia music scene because, as Hall explains, "Black artists became more concerned with their identity - their roots. They began to write about their own experiences in

the ghetto, and to concentrate on the black experience....that's when Philadelphia music threw all the white guys out. But now it's back to where it use to be." In 1973 Hall & Oates were signed to the Atlantic label and, after cutting their first LP, *Whole Oates* they opened for David Bowie on his first U.S.



tour. Later that year they recorded *Abandoned Luncheonette* and toured with the Bee Gees.

In 1974, *She's Gone* was released which became their first charted single, followed by *War Babies* and in this same year, Tavares covered *She's Gone* which went to No.1 on the R&B charts in the U.S. Over the next few years, commercial success seemed to elude Hall & Oates, even after signing to the RCA

ATV highly successful at time of purchase

Sept. 6, 1985 was the closing date for the sale of the ATV Music Group of companies worldwide. This sale included the assets of the Canadian operation which has undoubtedly become one of the most successful publisher/producers of Canadian artists and writers in Canada to date.

In a recent announcement it was revealed that the offices of ATV Music Group, Canada (which was founded in June 1978 and for which a sale agreement was reached in August - along with all of its worldwide affiliates - between ACC in the U.K., ATV's ultimate parent company and Michael Jackson for a reported \$47½ million U.S.) will be shut down and the staff dismissed over a staggered period beginning Sept. 10 and ending the end of October 1985. A similar situation exists for ATV's other offices worldwide, many of which have already been closed.

Vicki Walters, a 15-year veteran of the record/publishing business, the last 3 with ATV, reports that "As a 'swan song' to ATV's accomplishments, I would like to indicate that the Group in Canada was in the midst of what is potentially by far the most successful year in its history."

Says Walters, "The '85/'86 fiscal year for the ATV Group in Canada had all the earmarks of a major year for the Canadian operation."

Walters went on to explain that "What makes the current international and Canadian successes of ATV's Canadian operation all the more noteworthy is that it has all been accomplished from a Canadian base and by a relatively small staff. Key members of the staff, headed by Frank Davies (President) include: Martha Smith (Royalties Manager), Michael McCarty (Creative Manager) Nancy

Yu (Creative Promotion Assistant), and myself as Assistant to the President."

Walters points out that "Like all Canadian publishers, ATV Canada has long been under the financial restraints of the Western World's lowest mechanical royalty rate and the shrinking local market for 'covers', traditionally a standard publisher's mainstay," continuing with "In the face of this supposed drought, ATV Canada has continued securing more and more meaningful 'covers' by Canadian artists like Doug And The Slugs, Holly Woods, Veronique Beliveau, Honey-moon Suite, Helix, April Wine, Darkroom and others in the last 12 months alone, and has expanded its area of activities by securing from Toronto, many major international 'covers' for its Canadian signed writers and their songs; together with a multitude of film and television soundtrack synchronization placements, commercial/jingle usages and numerous other 'permissions' involving ATV's copyrights - music and/or lyrics." To this end, Walters revealed that agreements covering the first "major" advertising use of Lennon/McCartney copyrights in Canada have been completed over the last few days. These uses involve rights fees reportedly well into the 6 figure area.

ATV is probably best known for housing approximately 260 immortal copyrights of Lennon/McCartney, but is also the owner of countless pop, rock and country classics. These include Lucille (Kenny Rogers, Little Richard), Jump and He's So Shy (Pointer Sisters), You Could Have Been With Me (Sheena Easton), Money Changes Everything (Cyndi Lauper), When We Make Love (Alabama), and Fool Hearted Memory (George Strait) to name just a few.

Of much concern, of course, with the closing of ATV's Toronto office, is the future position of the many Canadian artists and writers currently signed to ATV. It's assumed there will be an official announcement by Michael Jackson or his representatives on the disposition of the company in view of the major role ATV played in bringing international recognition to Canadian writers and artists.

CBS backs 8 titles for internal promotion

CBS Records Canada is supporting 8 of their current album titles in a national campaign designed and aimed at CBS people in the field. The campaign has been dubbed The World Series Of Rock.

The company branch that displays the most aggressive work in the areas of sales, displays and promotion stand to win tickets to this year's baseball World Series.

There are also cash prizes for second and third place branches.

The promotion, which runs through September, involves 4 Cancon albums: Loverboy, Platinum Blonde, Gowan and Orphan, as well as LPs by international acts: John Cafferty, Dead Or Alive, Hooters, and Cock Robin.

Point-of-purchase material being utilized in the campaign includes mobiles and header cards.

Hambleton appointed to Vice Pres CHUM Quebec

Lee Hambleton has been appointed Vice President and General Manager of CHUM Quebec. The appointment, made by Allan Waters, President of CHUM Limited, coincides with CHUM's acquisition of Montreal radio stations, CKGM and CHOM-FM.

Mr. Hambleton, a well-known Canadian broadcaster, has been active in both English and French-language broadcasting in Montreal and Quebec for the past 17 years.

CHUM Limited is considered Canada's foremost public broadcasting company, and now, with radio and television station interests in 9 provinces, the CHUM Group is reportedly the largest public broadcasting company in the world.

In commenting on Mr. Hambleton's appointment, Mr. Waters stated that "Mr. Hambleton's appointment will insure the continued growth and development of CKGM and CHOM-FM, long recognized as 2 of Canada's most innovative radio stations." He continues with "It has been CHUM's objective for many years to enter the important Quebec market, thus making CHUM Limited's commitment to Canadian broadcasting truly national in scope."

Idol, Benatar, Hardcastle set pace for Chrysalis

Fall releases from Chrysalis will be led by label heavies like Billy Idol, Pat Benatar and Paul Hardcastle. There will also be releases from ex-Interferon's Simon F, ex-Ultravox member Midge Ure, and The Divinyls.

Following their highly successful summer singles will be Pat Benatar's Seven The Hard Way LP, and Hardcastle's (yet to be titled) new album.

Idol's Whiplash Smile has been scheduled for a November release, which should coincide with a North American tour. Idol's guitarist and co-writer, Steve Stephens, co-produced Simon F's new single, I Want You Back.

The Divinyls have been scheduled for the release of Pleasure And Pain, which "should create excitement at the radio level," says Chrysalis Product Manager Steve Tennant.

Theatre magazine unveiled for Toronto

Fashioned after the highly successful Playbill, that services New York City's theatregoers, Tableau, a new digest targeted at Toronto's growing theatre market, was unveiled (Sept. 17). The launch, orchestrated by publicist Gino Empry, attracted an impressive gathering of theatre VIP's including Ed Mirvish and his son David, plus media personalities, which included the Sun's Sylvia Train; Harry Felton from the Limelight Theatre, Brett Halliday, Malcolm Black from Theatre Plus, and David Lewis, President of the Continental Bank.

Tableau publisher Stephen Shawn presented Ed Mirvish with an original drawing of the Royal Alexandra Theatre as well as a framed cover of the first edition of Tableau which featured the production of Seven Brides For Seven Brothers.

Tableau will service Toronto audiences at The Royal Alexandra, Crest, Limelight Dinner Theatre, and The Second City Dinner Theatre. Publisher Shawn is hopeful of servicing all theatre locations across Canada in the near future.

Besides being a program, Tableau will carry articles on Canadian theatre in general as well as personality profiles, record and book reviews and fashion features.

One of the few writers who did report on the death of Mr. Joseph was Eric McLean in the Aug. 31st edition of the Montreal Gazette.

First Simple Minds dates firmed to support new LP

Virgin Records Canada has scheduled Oct. 21 as the release date for *Once Upon A Time*, the new album from Simple Minds.

The Scottish new music group have been pencilled in for 3 major Canadian dates, Montreal (Nov. 7), Toronto (8), and Vancouver (18). They will return to Canada in February for an extensive coast-to-coast tour.

Produced by Jimmy Iovine and Bob Clearmountain, the album will be preceded by the single, *Alive And Kicking*, which will ship to radio Oct. 2 and to retail Oct. 7. A video of this track is also expected, along with an extended 12" single mix.

Virgin is planning extensive p.o.p. material to support the album and single, as

well as retail and radio promotions to surround tour dates.

"Once Upon A Time is the band's most dynamic and mature LP to date," said Merck Mercuriadis, Product and A&R Manager for Virgin Records Canada. "And where Simple Minds were once seen as a developing act among names like Tears For Fears, U2, Big Country, and Echo & The Bunnymen, all these comparisons are now left behind. Simple Minds are out in front on their own."

With the single, *Alive And Kicking*, Mercuriadis says Simple Minds have come up with their "most powerful and moving" single to date. "The texture and chemistry shines through with the sound that is perfect for radio and 1985," he said. "Where we

were once pulling album tracks like *Waterfront* and *Spread Your Love To Me*, as singles, *Once Upon A Time* has real singles on it, plus album tracks to follow the singles, which are equally if not more impressive than *Waterfront*."

Once Upon A Time represents the band's seventh album. Their last LP, *Sparkle In The Rain*, was released in February of 1984.

label and the subsequent release of their self-titled album and the rediscovery of Sarah Smile in 1976.

It wasn't until the release of *Bigger Than Both Of Us* (1977), with the single *Rich Girl* that recognition was achieved but this effort would not be repeated to 1979. "In 1979, the age of song was wane," says Hall, "the best records were dance records, the most advanced compositional themes and structures were disco. The most accurate recollection of the world back then was beat music."

Hence in 1979, they made a few changes after trying for years to "marry" black and white music, when AOR was shunning anything black, after all; this was the "disco sucks" era. Hall & Oates began to use their own band in the studio instead of studio musicians. They felt this was an important step in the development of a new sound. And they switched from Los Angeles to the New York studios. As Oates says about *X-Static*, "It was the album that prepared us for taking charge of ourselves."

He continued with "We featured our own voices, we changed our whole approach to harmony...this was when we figured out how to put rock and soul together."

Following the release of *X-Static*, Hall & Oates recorded *Voices* and released *Kiss On My List* - both went gold in the summer of 1981. That summer, they released *Private Eyes* which hit the platinum mark some point in 1982. With the platinum certification for *Private Eyes*, they released *H2O* which surpassed the success of their previous LP making it to triple platinum status in the summer of 1983. Following the *H2O* LP was *Big Bam Boom* hitting the double platinum mark this past march.

Twins LP set for September

Here's *To Future Days*, the forthcoming Arista album from the Thompson Twins, has been tentatively scheduled for a Sept. 19, release date. Produced by Tom Bailey and Nile Rodgers, the LP is expected to be preceded by the single, *Lay Your Hands On Me*, to come in both 7" and 12" formats. A major coast-to-coast Canadian tour is in the works to support the LP which will also have a concept for marketing and packaging. Recorded in Paris, the album contains guest guitarist Steve Stevens, who plays guitar for Billy Idol. Nile Rodgers also contributes some guitar work towards the album.

New Triumph set readied

Following quickly on the heels of their successful 74-city North American tour, Triumph has slated Sept. 26 as the release date for their new MCA LP, *Stages*. The tour, which included 16 Canadian dates, was sponsored by Pepsi-Cola. The new LP is a live compilation and will feature 2 new studio tracks, *Mind Games*, and *Empty Inside*, both of which were produced at their Metal Works Studio in Toronto. *Mind Games* has been taken as the first single from the LP. Their last album, *Thunder Seven*, was certified platinum in Canada last month and achieved gold status in the U.S. this past May.

MuchMusic signs with CanCom

Dennis Fitz-Gerald, Vice President and General Manager of MuchMusic, announced that an agreement had been finalized with Canadian Satellite Communications Inc. (CanCom) for the sale of MuchMusic service to cable systems across Canada. "The sale of MuchMusic will be limited to 'B' class cable systems not already affiliated to the MuchMusic service," explains Fitz-Gerald. Numbers of MuchMusic subscribers should

increase by 175,000 as CanCom has been involved, since 1982, in developing small cable systems in undeserved communities across Canada. "Now MuchMusic, can look forward to reaching a number of markets which are presently not served," concludes Fitz-Gerald.

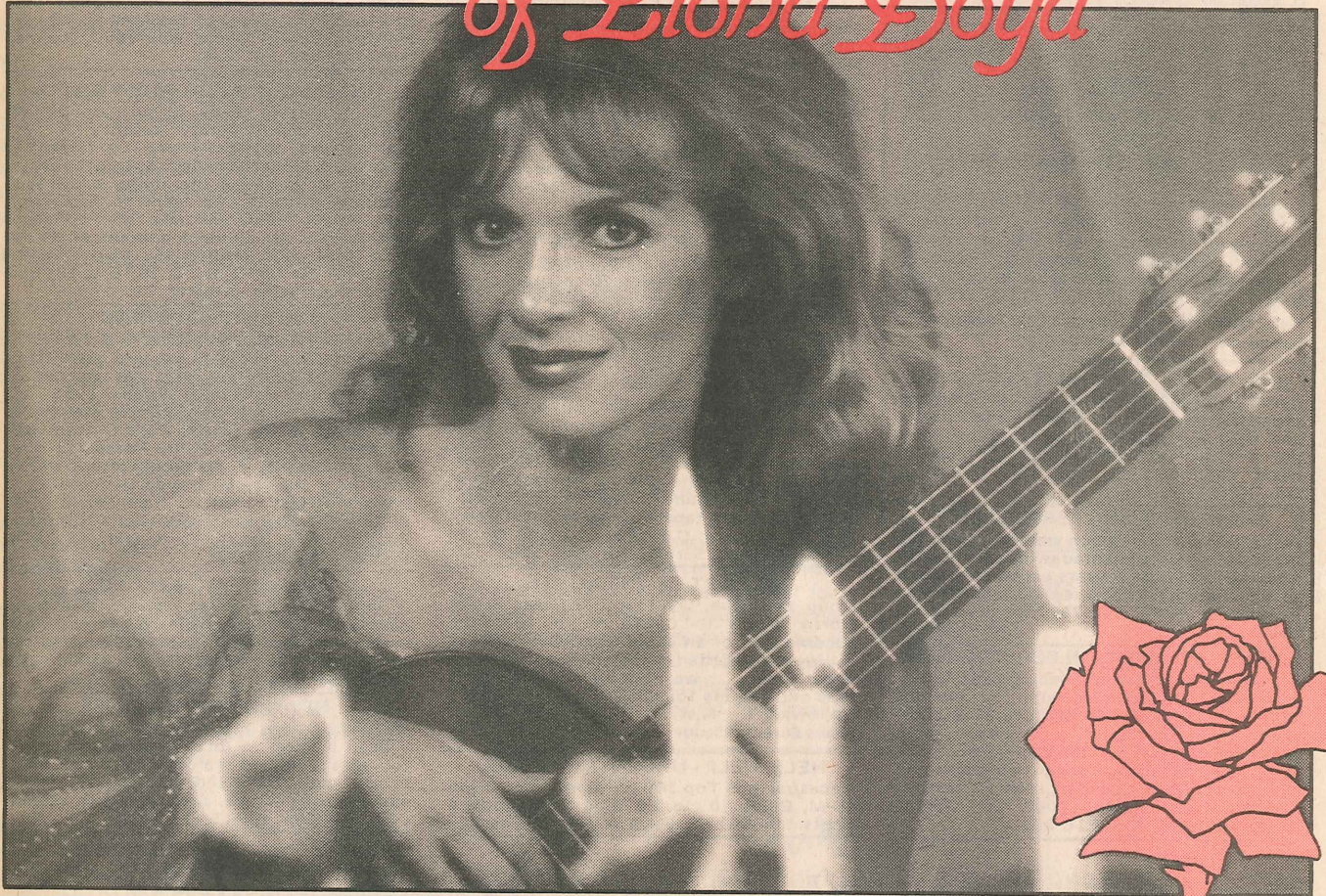
