## Dick Maloney to launch Easy Listening Awards

Dick Maloney, well-known on-air personality at CFMO Ottawa and a popular easy listening recording artist and supper club entertainer, has founded the Academy of Easy Listening Music. The Academy is described as "an organization of people involved in easy listening music, whose aim is to promote and give recognition to this category of music."

## Telemedia & Q107 host Juno Countdown

Countdown To The Junos will be a national phone-in show, allowing the general public to ask questions and talk with various Juno nominees. Hosting the show, for the second consecutive year, is Q107's Bob Mackowicz from the station's Toronto studios.

Receiving the "satellite transmitted and delivered" signal will be CHEZ Ottawa, CKPT Peterborough, 94FM Thunder Bay, CFCN North Bay, CITI Winnipeg, 99FM Prince Albert, K97 Edmonton, CKIK Calgary, CFMI Vancouver, CKTK Kitimat, CHTK Prince Rupert, CHIM Kelowna, and CJKL Kirkland Lake.

Telemedia's Doug Thompson, who is producing the show, reports that "Unfortunately, the biggest problem we had was the time zone. The stations in the east would have received our signal at 1 or 2 am."

The Countdown will be broadcast Nov. 2 from 10 pm to 12 pm. Appearing live at the studio will be Kim Mitchell, Honeymoon Suite, and Platinum Blonde. Phoners will be conducted with Gowan, Glass Tiger, and Loverboy's Mike Reno. David Foster is also a tentative interviewee.

## Switchback looking to replace Thompson

Shawn Thompson, who hosts Switchback, a Toronto 5 (CBC-TV) production, is leaving the show, to "give all his energy to his role on CBS' Guiding Light." Producer Doug Syrota is now looking for Thompson's replacement.

Says Program Director, Alex Frame, "Shawn has been terrific for Switchback. He's been part of a team that has made the show one of the most creative and talked about in this market, and I look forward to working together on other projects."

In exiting the show, Thompson explains, "My hectic schedule simply became too much, but Switchback has been great. It's produced some of the most original television that's been done in this city in a long time."

Thompson's last show will be Sunday, Nov. 30.

Priority for the new Academy is the staging of a yearly awards show to be officially known as the Easy Listening Music Awards Show. The show will be produced by the Ottawa-based Rosewood Productions, of which Gloria McRae is President. Maloney will be host/entertainer for the awards evening.

Membership to the Academy of Easy Listening Music (ELA) is open to performers, musicians, songwriters, broadcasters, theatrical agents and managers, authors, and "anyone who supports easy listening music within the industry," says McRae, who continues with "The objectives of ELA is to promote communication and develop a higher profile for Canadian easy listening music in Canada and abroad - and to provide a unified voice for the Canadian easy listening music industry." ELA is also building towards organizing an annual Canadian and American easy listening music week convention to be held in Ottawa in conjunction with the awards show.

Categories for the proposed awards show have been classified under the heading of Records: Singer (Male/Female), Instrumentalist, Group, Songwriter, Song of The Year, Music Comedy (1 performer), Easy Listening Radio Station, and Easy Listening Radio Personality; Clubs: Male/Female Singer (Cassettes or Videos); Instrumentalist (not on records, in clubs or lounges), and Group (not on records, in clubs or lounges).

Also being considered are Entertainer of The Year and Hall of Fame awards.

The Academy is currently putting together a Selection Committee of experts in the field of easy listening music. The

members of this committee will review the nominees, and pick a winner from each category. The names of the committee members will be announced at a later date, along with further details on the proposed awards show.

## RCA supports Aretha LP with its first cass-single

RCA/Ariola Canada are testing the waters with the release of their first ever cassette-single for the current Aretha Franklin release, Jumpin' Jack Flash. The single was taken from her new Arista album titled Aretha.

The cassette single, like the 12" release, carries 5 different versions of the song: an album mix, street mix, street mix-radio edit, master dub mix, and beat dub mix.

The single was produced by Keith Richards, who also guests, along with Ron Wood, on guitar. The majority of the album was produced by Narada Michael Walden. Franklin produced 2 tracks: I Knew You Were Waiting (For Me), a duet with George Michael, and If You Need My Love Tonight, a duet with Larry Graham, formerly with Sly & The Family Stone.

It's interesting to note that the album jacket art work is by Andy Warhol. The poster to support the album will also carry Warhol's signature.

Franklin's previous LP release, Who's Zoomin Who, is now well over the platinum mark in Canada. While Jumpin Jack Flash continues to climb the RPM 100 Singles Chart, the new album makes its debut onto the RPM chart this week at No. 94.

## Radio promotions create national buzz for Junos

Warren Cosford, Director of Special Projects for the CHUM Group, reports the Dream Trip To The Junos contest, currently underway at 7 major market radio stations, was conceived and originated "to bring the excitement of the Junos to somewhere other than Toronto." The contest, co-sponsored by The Bay, offers the winners an all expense paid trip to the Juno Awards, and a special luncheon with Honeymoon Suite atop the CN Tower.

### High-powered promotion launches Parallel One

Combining an extensive advertising and publicity campaign, Canada's newest independent record label, Vancouver's Parallel One have embarked on an ambitious plan to catapult Body Electric and JATO into national prominence.

Heading the company are Scott Andrews and Gordon Sinclair, who have hired LDA-The Music Brokers, and Promotionally Yours . . . Martin/Kierens, both based in Toronto, to handle promotion and publicity respectively.

Andrews has a Master's Degree in Music and has taught at New York's Juilliard School of Music. Previous to co-managing Anne Mortifee with Valerie Hennell King, which drew him "closer to the popular music scene," he was a founding Director of both the B.C. Touring Council and the B.C. Choral Federation.

Sinclair's background is in the areas of hospitality, the import and sales of artwork and antiques, and real estate.

Andrews and Sinclair met in 1985 while the latter was accompanying JATO to Victoria from Edmonton - and a year later the pair formed Parallel One Productions - signing Body Electric and JATO to their label.

Both have acknowledged the need for independent labels "to enhance each of its different faculties in order to give young Canadian talent the voice to be heard."

With regard to their music policy, Andrews reveals that both he and Sinclair "have similar musical tastes. If we're turned onto it - we'll sign it." He concludes with "It's a risk-taking commitment to quality that keeps the numbers down and the quality high."

A record/video launch party for Body Electric's new single, *Strangers In Love*, will be held at Toronto's Plan 9 (formerly The West Side Grill) on Nov. 8.

cheon with Honeymoon Suite atop the CN Tower.

The participating stations are Edmonton's K-Lite, Winnipeg's CFRW, Windsor's OM-FM, Kingston's CKLC, Montreal's CHOM FM, C-100 of Halifax, and Ottawa's CFGO. Cosford points out that being a CHUM affiliate was not a prerequisite and he had hoped to enlist stations in Peterborough and St. John's as well, but there weren't Bay stores in those cities.

CFGQ's Program Director Trudy Chamberlain says, "We were ecstatic," when asked the station's reaction when initially approached by Cosford. "It's such an expensive endeavour," she continues, "and except for the airfare, it's not costing us anything. What a coup."

Ian Davies, OM-FM's Program Director points out that quite possibly one of their winners may be an American. "One of our qualifiers is from Dearborn (Michigan), and he is just as excited as any Canadian at the chance of eating with Bryan Adams or Gordon Lightfoot - as well as travelling in limos and attending the luncheon with Honeymoon Suite."

Both Davies and Chamberlain express the degree of organization is unprecedented. "I can't believe how well organized the contest is," remarks Chamberlain. "We're not used to this." Cosford has supplied each station with artist voicer liners (from Corey Hart to Platinum Blonde), mailing stickers and press releases.

"With the saturation we have from the U.S., contests that have high appeal are key in this market," explains Davies. "The liners those artists did, gave the contest that much more credibility, and we're very thankful for their cooperation." Accompanying OM-FM's contest winners will be Andy Stuart - the station's morning personality.

Cosford maintains this is the only contest to feature an "official" photographer and an "official" dessert. Renowned Toronto photographer Raj Rama has been commissioned to document each station's Dream Trip To The Junos, and the CN Tower's Executive Chef, Nigel Shute, has created a Honeymoon Sweet for the luncheon.

Next year, Cosford also hopes many U.S. border stations will run coincidental Juno promotions, as several actually approached him this year. "It's logical," says Cosford, "Bryan Adams, Anne Murray,

Gordon Lightfoot, and Loverboy are international stars - why wouldn't they want to get involved?"

### CARAS B.C. Chapter holds membership brunch

The B.C. Chapter of the Canadian Academy of Recording Arts & Sciences (CARAS) held their First Annual Membership Brunch in Vancouver (Sept. 30). "I think we got a better cross-section of the industry and related businesses than anyone expected," said Membership Chairman Michael Godin. "We had about 200 people - lots of radio and studio people, along with musicians and management company people."

I remember when I first called on CHYM in Kitchener, Ontario and was greeted by a gracious and charming young lady who introduced herself as Molly Zakrewski. She had such a cultured English accent, it took me by surprise. Turned out she had married a Polish man. That was almost 30 years ago . . . and now Molly is retiring . . . and Randy Sharrard of WEA tells me she was quite emotional at the little going away party, when he presented her with a gold record. This was the first gold record Molly had received in all those years of programming this important station. We hate to see you go Molly . . . all the best.

## Don't count albums out yet!!

John Donabie, 'RB's Music Director reports that the single adds "a nice touch to our sound."

Anita Perris & Tim Taylor's debut 45 for Savannah may be Heading In The Wrong Direction, but this is one husband and wife team who are definitely on the right track!

Flush from Anita's Top 10 solo success with Heads You Win (Tails I Lose), Canada's reigning Country Duo of The Year travel east in November for Atlantic Canada concerts with Mickey Gilley and then out to Regina to tape a segment of the CBC television show Country West.

Out Of Hand Out Of Control, Terry Sumson's new 45 from the Midnight Invitation LP, is indeed racing out of control at radio with over 80 stations already on the case. Meanwhile, Our Lovin' Place, the Savannah album that successfully launched Terry's career here in Canada, is working it's magic once again, this time in Britain for the independent Silver Dollar label. British critical and fan response has been so warm, plans are now being finalized for a 30-date concert tour of England and Scotland next

spring.

Back on this side of the pond, Gary Fjellgaard, the pride of Gabriola Island and British Columbia's favourite country son, has gained the greatest national exposure of his career with coast to coast airplay on his current single, No Time To Lose. Released on October 15, this title-track 45 pulled from Gary's Savannah debut has already won play on most country radio stations and shows every indication of crossing over to adult contemporary radio as well.

As for Canada's favourite country rocker, Juno nominee Matt Minglewood (Country Male Vocalist), is currently scoring strong airplay with Far Side Of Town, single number 4 from Me And The Boys. Matt's promotional activity for the new 45 will intensify immediately after the Junos when he sets off on his annual fall concert tour, an excursion which will take him from Cape Breton Island to the shores of the Pacific before Dec. 25.

### The Georgia Satellites: back to the basics is best

Unlike many recent Elektra releases, the Georgia Satellites' debut album is "pure" rock 'n' roll. Certainly, neither Howard Jones nor Benjamin Orr are likely to suggest their influences were Jerry Lee Lewis or even The Sex Pistols. However, the label's latest signing from south of the Mason-Dixon are proud of their rock 'n' roll roots.

Lead singer and main songwriter, Dan Baird, agrees that a band breaking out of "the bible belt" is unusual, but "in particular a rock 'n' roll band that's not oriented towards that specific REM, Lets Active, pretty stuff," he says. "If you're a bunch of yahoos out there beating the hell out of your guitars, screaming and complaining about something - it's just really hard."

Among the many and varied comparisons being directed at the band, which include (as per the biography): Bob Dylan, Bad Company, The Rolling Stones, ZZ Top, Lynyrd Skynyrd, Aerosmith, and The Faces, Baird says "it's all true." The one common denominator being the raw power of guitarist Rick Richards.

"He plays so damn strong," relates Baird, "You don't hear people play like that anymore - and if they do - they play too many notes. But his sound is much bigger. It reminds me of Mick Ralphs, or the first 3 records of Billy Gibbons, and then it sounds like Angus Young. Then, at the same time, it reminds me of Paul Burleson back in the '50s. He studies his Chuck Berry, his John Lennon - all the big boys - all the way through, and here he is with the basics."

The fact the band was signed at all is "perplexing" to Baird and his fellow band-members. After all, once they had recorded their Keep The Faith EP, the band broke up, due to a lack of interest from any record label. Adding to this confusion, Baird can't understand why the band was signed, when radio formats have softened so much lately, and furthermore, why Elektra are even releasing a single.

"It's real strange," says Baird. "We're one of those bands that can basically only do

what we do. We couldn't tailor make anything to 'fit' the current trend or the new 'pop sensibilities' or anything like that. All that, to us, is just a bunch of weird phrases, invented by someone who is chasing after something."

Baird also maintains that with the single, the label will be "testing the water to see how Top 40 likes us, which to me," he continues "is cuckoo. I mean . . . I don't understand, a tune that was on the original EP 3 years ago that everybody passed on. But it makes you thankful for certain people, finally showing up in your life."

When Keep The Faith generated some sales and positive reviews in the U.K., Baird and Richards hooked up again, and signed to Praxis Entertainment, a management firm that brought the band to the attention of Elektra's Kevin Patrick, who subsequently signed them to a deal.

After 8 weeks of recording this past summer at Atlanta's Axis and Cheshire studios, Baird points out the label didn't get excited until the final mixes were completed. "Then they were saying, 'My God, they sound like a regular rock 'n' roll band!'

Harkening back to those comparisons, Baird contends his band has "that sort of thing where it could fall apart at any minute. That sheer blind rush forward that Jerry Lee Lewis had, that the Pistols had, and Lou Reed, in his prime time, had, and Dylan on Highway 61. That rush forward - that's the stuff I admire. You've got a cross between that and liking old Aerosmith, Lynyrd Skynyrd - bands that were just good rock 'n' roll bands."

Finally, there is the Stones' comparison, and Baird offers, "I think the biggest thing they had was what is now the Keith and Ronnie - what used to be Keith and Brian - the 2 rhythm guitars - the one guitar played by 4 bands approach just make it so powerful and thick. And it always ended up such a huge thing that it was just undeniable, and that's what I think Rick and I learned from the Stones - more than anything else."

The single, released on the Globe label and distributed by RCA, was produced by Jack Richardson, and is getting the added promotion boost from Music Box Dancer, publishers of the song.


"We've been working on this single for quite some time," says Kevin Shea, Ontario promo rep for RCA/Ariola, "and we are beginning to catch on at several A/C and middle of the road stations."

Music Box Dancer's John Loweth points out that he believed strongly "in the 'hit potential' of this catchy melody and decided that with an investment into the production of a couple of lead sax lines and a more dynamic percussion track, the tune just might have that extra something to make it go the distance."

When not tinkling with the piano, or writing material such as *Good Times*, Captain Eric G. McKay is busy at National Defense Headquarters in Ottawa, directing the maintenance of a fleet of aircraft.

Key tracks include 'I Knew You Were Waiting (For Me)' a duet with George Michael and 'He'll Come Along', the latter she produced.

SHARKS IN ITALY - Pop

A definite success if she doesn't get cut off at the knees with "her lyrical content is not suitable for radio."

THE VENETIANS - Pop/Rock  
Calling In The Lions - Chrysalis - CHS-41555-J  
Unfortunately, this LP is going to be overshadowed by the label's "other" hot albums, but it's not a bad recording and deserves a listen anyway. Several key tracks - nothing for today's radio however. Check out 'One From The Heart'.



SURVIVOR - Pop  
When Seconds Count - Scott Bros - FZ-40457-H  
Tracks with some promise include 'Is This Love', 'Rebel Son', 'Oceans', and 'Can't Let You Go'. The label hopes this package will offer multi-format hits and Ron Nevin's production skills certainly add weight to those chances. Nevin shares production credits with Frankie Sullivan.

## BENJAMIN ORR

The Lace - Elektra - 86 04601-P  
First solo effort for ex-Car member Orr. Produced by Orr, Mike Shipley and Larry Klein. All tracks co-written by Orr and Dianne Grey Page. It almost seems like there has been 2 LP's released by the Cars within 2 months. Should appeal to radio while the Cars fans should keep it moving at retail. If distinctiveness and originality don't count - all tracks are key.



BERLIN - Pop

Count Three & Pray - Geffen - XGHS 24121-P  
Includes the hit single, 'Take My Breath Away (Love Theme From Top Gun)', which held a No. 2 position on the RPM 100 singles chart September 27. The LP was produced by Bob Ezrin with Andy Richards and Berlin. With the exception of 'Take My Breath Away' which was produced by Giorgio Moroder, key tracks are 'Like Flames', 'Pink And Velvet' and 'Will I Ever Understand You'.



BAD COMPANY - Rock

Fame And Fortune - Atlantic - 78-16841-P  
Whether it's Keith Olsen's production or not, Mick Ralphs just doesn't cut it anymore (with perhaps the title track as an exception). As well, new lead singer Brian Howe doesn't leave quite the impression as did Paul Rodgers. Executive producer credits to Mick Jones, which is probably why this record sounds more like Foreigner than Bad Company. This Love is label priority for radio play.

## SHRIEKBACK

Big Night Music - Island - ISL-1110-J  
What a follow-up to 'Oil And Gold'. From the opening bars of 'Black Light Trap', this set romps (and romps) through 'Gunning For The Buddha' to 'Running On The Rocks', and if those tracks aren't diverse or stimulating enough, then on 'Shriekback' march through 'The Shining Path' ending the first side with 'Pretty Little Things', which have all only served as an introduction to the second side. This is the band's fifth LP, and intelligence, combined with a brooding intense maturity are keenly on display. Will be a hot item in the weeks to come.

DARREN WALTERS - Country/Instrumental In Session - The Walters Family - 1-4561  
Perfect for intro's, extro's or feature play. Very rare and well-produced country instrumentals. This 16-yr. old multi-talented musician produced, arranged, mixed and reveals his musicianship on 9 instruments: fiddle, sax, drums, steel guitar, bass guitar, mandolin, piano, rhythm and lead guitars - quite an accomplishment. He also wrote Darren's 'Ride' and does an incredible job on 'Cotton-Eyed Joe', which he arranged, as well as 'Ward Allen's 'Back-Up And Push'. An excellent showpiece for this extraordinary family from Bright, Ont.

## WILLIE NELSON

Partners - Columbia - FC-39894-H  
What can be said about this veteran of the charts and country music in general. Produced by Chips Moman, who co-wrote the first single, 'Partners After All', with keyboardist Bobby Emmons. Also key is a Neil Young penning of 'Heart Of Gold', which should qualify as 'Cancon' (ML).



THE O'KANES - Country/Pop

Self-Titled - Columbia - FC-40459-H  
Powerful country here from this pseudo-bluegrass team - Kieran Kane and Jamie O'Hara. Lots of down-home fiddle, hot mandolin, and even hotter banjo. Watch this pair chart very quickly. They are already doing it with their first single, 'Oh Darlin', now moving up the RPM Country 60. Also key are 'Gonna Walk That Line', and 'Bluegrass Blues'. Most of the material co-written by the pair, but give a listen to Arthur Crudup's 'That's All Right Mama' - should be a single.




