Paul Clinch - Cancon pioneer dead at 41

The recording industry was shocked to learn of the sudden death of Paul Clinch, a pioneer in the battle to promote and preserve Canadian artists and music. Mr. Clinch, who was 41, passed away at Toronto's East General Hospital on November 8th. from a cardiac arrest brought about through complications of kidney failure.

It was during the mid-sixties when Mr. Clinch, who was managed by his father Brendan, formed the Canadian Delltones, a rock band, later named The Magic Cycle at which time his brother Kevin joined him. The group was later renamed Thecycle. Mr. Clinch's band was one of the first Canadian bands to move out across the country on a tour, introducing themselves to new markets and audiences, long before legislated radio. Radio programmers were not too hospitable towards this upstart "Eastern" Canadian band, and did much to discredit the tour. This opposition, planted firmly in his mind, was a cause celebre for the young songwriter/performer, and he became a tireless worker in the promotion of Canadian music and Canadian artists. CBS to launch 3-artist TV campaign

Following the success of last year's Christmas television campaigns for Bruce Springsteen and Michael Jackson, CBS Records Canada is set to launch similar campaigns for three more artists over November and December. The campaigns will concentrate on George Michael, Terence Trent D'Arby and Cancon artist Celine Dion.

The campaign for Michael's *Faith* album will run in all markets from November 21st through December 18th, and will be tied into such shows as *Saturday Night Live*, *Family Ties*, *The Cosby Show*, *Video Hits* and more. *Faith* has sold more than 700,000 units, and CBS hopes to top the million mark by the end of the campaign.

Both the Dion and D'Arby campaigns will cover the Quebec markets only from November 21st through December 18. D'Arby's popular album, *Introducing the Hardline* . . . is close to the 300,000 mark while Dion's *Incognito* album is just short of platinum. A plus factor for this Quebec artist is her recent sweep of the ADISQ Awards, where she won Best Female Singer, Most Popular Song (*Incognito*), Best Live Performance, and most Celebrated Artist Outside of Quebec (Eurovision Award).

Thecycle were released in the U.S. on the Buddah label. They were titled *Wait For The Miracle* and *Gimme Some Time* and both, produced by Stan Klees, experienced significant airplay.

Mr. Clinch went on to form Choya, another rock band, and became a much-in-demand session drummer as well as later following a solo career. As a solo artist he released *Don't Take The Sun Out Of My Life*, a single, on the Tamarac label. He also kept very close contact with Birmingham, England, his birthplace, although he immigrated to Canada when he was only six months old. "Paul was always interested in his roots," his father Brendan recalls, "and quite often lent a helping hand to the youngsters in our old neighborhood back home. He was so very dedicated to his music, he wanted to share it with everyone, and he was always willing to give his time to help other musicians and artists."

In most recent years, Mr. Clinch formed his own Southside label and at the time of his death, was working with Australia's Hot Waxy (formerly Wickety Wak) and Peter Foldy, a Canadian recording artist living in Los Angeles. He was also heavily involved in video production.

"A&R/Marketing is BMG focus" - Platel

It's been six weeks since Dave Platel moved from CBS to the position of Vice President of Marketing for BMG Music Canada, and he is easing in quietly, making subtle changes. "I'm making a few operational changes for the sales and marketing people," he admits. "But they have a little different orientation than I do and part of me coming here was to bring in some fresh new ideas. It wasn't my intention to walk in and make night and day changes . . . which would have just upset the applecart."

Platel isn't predicting any major thrusts for the company, even with the impending Christmas season now heating up. "We're not making any heavy moves, but we do have a couple of sales plans in place," he reveals. "However during November and December we will plot a very basic January campaign, real simple. I'm not going to try and extend ourselves to the level that we would at CBS. This company is used to doing things one way and I'm going to ease them into my strategies."

Platel continues with, "I hope by mid-spring we will be on a bit of a roll in terms of planning and marketing. We're going to try some interesting things . . . we're going to give the other majors a run for their money. I think that, given the next six to twelve months, the industry is going to see some interesting marketing ideas come out of BMG, and it won't be as a result of me doing it as much as it will be everybody here feeling that they can expand their creativity as well. I'll steer the boat . . . but ultimately it will be the entire team who will come up with new ways to position the boat."

Platel is quite optimistic about the future, as he suggests, "My position here obviously presents some real strong excite-



ment for the next five years of my life. I've always been one to want to invent new things, to pioneer new ideas, and the closer you move to the top, the easier it is to get your inventions and ideas in gear."

BMG, worldwide, has been noticeably sprucing up its image, and as Platel points out, "The whole vision of this company, as it's been portrayed to me, is one of a very credible growth period . . . in three or five years, they may not knock off the big guys, but they certainly want to be counted for. The focus for BMG around the world is A&R and Marketing. They really want to shore up their A&R activities. That's where it has to start. If you'll pardon the expression 'if it's in the grooves', but it's got to start there. If you can get out of the starting gate with that plus factor . . . the marketing of the product becomes more of a communication flow . . . when to release and when to get on to the next big item." He concludes with, "Of course, the priority will be quality . . . not quantity."





Speaking of unknowns . . . ! Although I'm not too enamored with a subsidized recording industry, I have to take my hat off to the FACTOR people, who are a very dedicated group. In spite of my, quite often, voiced opposition to their handouts, I have to admit they are creating a good feeling within the independent recording sector. FACTOR funds, as limited as they are, have added that "little" support that could have been or could continue to be "just enough" to bring an independent label into the mainstream. That's not to suggest that I've changed my mind about subsidies, but I think we may have labelled FACTOR's intentions wrongly. I wish they would do a little horn-blowing on their own. (EC: Industry-related stories are free in RPM . . . !)

Mobile telephones . . . ? If you think FAX is turning into a problem . . . take a look at the mobile telephones. I saw a driver the other day, talking on his phone, drinking a cup of coffee and moving very quickly to a rear-end. I was a witness . . . so help me. It was my rear-end! (EC: How fast where you going when you backed into him . . . ?)

Don't go away . . . ! I went to dinner with a young, very aggressive record executive the other evening. He didn't bring his kid, but he did bring his mobile telephone. "You never know when an important call will come in," he told me. During our dinner, that damned phone rang no less than 14 times, scaring the hell out of him, me and the rest of the restaurant. Six of the calls were from his babysitter, two were wrong numbers, one was an upsetting call from Los Angeles, and the

others . . . who cares! This guy's going to be a basket case before he's forty. (EC: Now, they're working on a little phone that fits into your pocket . . . !)

Freeing the trade . . . ! Might it be that if the Liberals are elected, we may have to forget a subsidized Canadian music industry? (EC: No! That's called free enterprise!) They should have left well enough alone . . . !

A Canada Medal . . . ? I heard that a very deserving Canadian producer was in Ottawa to receive the Order Of Canada. There's nothing official at press time! (EC: The last word . . . !)

Music Building on the move . . . ! Rumour has it that a fund is being started to move the now famous Music Building from the CNE to Ottawa. Seems the building has been declared "of national significance" and it should be located in Ottawa. (EC: Where it was decreed!) Lovingly referred to as "The Hall Of Flame", the building, considered by some an eyesore, might look good in Ottawa in front of the parliament buildings. (EC: Don't pay any attention to a group of country people who want it moved to Hamilton . . . !)

Another unfounded rumour . . . ! Confirm or deny that there is a concept being put together to have a yearly televised award show honouring, what else . . . award shows. 

On the road, crossing several continents, promoting herself with an unexpected sense of humour and an eloquent charm, La Toya Jackson is taking the time now to explain the split from her father's management grasp, the reasons for returning to the music industry and, of course, maintaining the family name throughout. Soft spoken and articulate, Jackson is also affirming a commitment to the anti-drug crusade and elaborates on Just Say No, a song written following her involvement in the popular international campaign last year.

Not unlike any other Jackson release, the focus of her new album, titled simply La Toya, is on dancing and having fun. That is what's happening on the street, she says. Hence, in order to rank among the best, world-renowned producers Stock Aitken Waterman, Full Force and Harold Faltermeyer were called upon to make a record worthy of the family name. However, if there was one song that had to appear on the album it was Just Say No, and this she was quite adamant about.

"Before," Jackson begins, "I wasn't able to produce the kind of music that I like to do. I was always dictated to. I didn't want

to gear this album to one distinct audience. I wanted a variety of different sounds and I wanted it to be something that everybody could listen to and enjoy at the same time. The only thing I had in mind for this particular project was Just Say No, the other songs just happened."

A concern for children and her "burning desire" to record again, undoubtedly will have an effect on the changing attitudes among youngsters today. Although historically the music industry has not provided very good role models for the unadmitted, Jackson's message will ring loudly among the young; perhaps even throughout the industry as well. It's been four years since her last album was released and that actually depends on who's defining "release", adds Jackson. So, to say the least, she is quite anxious and prepared to get the message out.

"I think it's time," she continues, "because drugs are dominating the world right now and it's going to be terrible if it keeps going. We're just going to destroy ourselves. Sometimes you sit and you think, it takes one artist to do something and then everybody joins in: Live Aid, We Are The World, Band Aid and it just keeps on going. As far as drugs are concerned, it has gotten far out of hand and as anybody can see, it's uncontrollable. So we have to do something about it now."

"Bumper crop year for WEA" - Newman

WEA Music Canada continues chalking up previously "out of reach" figures as it gears for the Christmas season. They will shortly be launching their TV campaign on INXS, Rod Stewart and the Cocktail Soundtrack, and have bought daytime TV time for the Randy Travis Gift Pack which includes all three of his albums, now over one million units total in Canada. "Amazing for a country artist," says WEA's Vice President of Sales Garry Newman.

Cancon is a priority at WEA as well. "One To One is very close to breaking wide open," continues Newman "and we're at 10,000 pieces with Ian Thomas, the first hurdle we've gotten over with him and we will be out with his second single soon." Frozen Ghost is "a stone's throw" away from a gold record and Honeymoon Suite is looking very good with their new single. "There's lots of good things happening with our Cancon

Employing the different teams of producers was another decision that was made early, well before the project was undertaken, Jackson recalls. And having decided on who would be ably suited, she was prepared to wait for each to become available. Time was certainly on her side, as her cosmetics line (Mahogany Image) and the involvement with brother Michael's videos kept her busy during this period. Patience is a virtue and the wait was worth it, including the signing of a new deal with BMG Music.


"I started in Germany with Teldec and in the States I should have automatically been with A&M, but with my sister being there, my manager made sure they went after another company and that's how BMG came into the picture. I think it's a smart move too, because at one point the entire family, except for Janet, were all on the same label. But I felt it was a smart move by her being the number one female priority at that company, especially at that particular time, and now as well."

"When I recorded this album I wanted to relate to the people on the streets," Jackson concludes, "so I figured Full Force would be the best way to go. They're out on the streets and they know what the people want to hear. That's why it's so easy for the rap artists and that's why they're constantly selling platinum albums. They're selling albums more than artists who you'd think are doing platinum, that were big years ago, like the Stones . . . but these artists are out there and it's crazy, but it's happening."

roster," says Newman, "and the enthusiasm here for our Canadian artists just gets more obvious. We're at that stage right now where I hope radio jumps in and really supports this talent, even more than what they have been doing."

Overall, however, "It's been a bumper crop year for us," boasts Newman. "Even without a fall plan our expectations were really quite low but our customers and their customers in turn, turned it around on us so, where we thought we would have a quiet fall, it's gone right through the roof." He continues with, "We're working on average three nights a week, keying orders, and add to this . . . on November 22nd we're releasing the new Crosby, Stills & Nash plus Fleetwood Mac's Greatest Hits and then to really cap this thing off, we have a new Guns 'N' Roses for December 8th, which will carry us right into the New Year."

Compact discs are becoming established as a consumer "must buy" configuration, and WEA has a fairly good market share through their Super Save Line which carries a suggested list price of \$19.98. They will be launching the third phase of this line during December with about 130 titles released by February. "I think this Christmas will be very crucial for both the CD hardware and software," Newman suggests. "I'm confident that this Christmas, the everyday consumer, who is the vinyl/cassette person, will become part of the CD market." He concludes with "Penetration of CD hardware in Canada stands at about 8 percent and I would hope that by the time we are through Christmas, it will be up to 10 percent."
