## CD longbox cut-off date not suitable to retailers

The newly formed, as yet unnamed, association of retailers and wholesalers, faced their first hurdle, doing battle with WEA Music Canada and PolyGram. These two majors have indicated they will be eliminating CD packaging in January of 1990. However, a meeting with CRIA is apparently scheduled for further discussion. The proposed cut-off date is not suitable for the members of the new retailers and wholesalers association, which was expressed in a letter to both PolyGram and WEA. Although the members are in agreement with the elimination of CD packaging, they are asking that September 1st, 1990 be considered, as "a more acceptable date."

Apparently only PolyGram's Peter

## BMG Music Publishing scores Cross catalogue

Nick Firth, President of BMG Music Publishing Worldwide, has announced the acquisition of Pop 'N' Roll Music and Another Page, publishing companies of Grammy-winning writer/artist Christopher Cross. As well, Cross has signed a worldwide co-publishing agreement with BMG Songs (ASCAP).

The Cross catalogue includes Sailing, Ride Like The Wind, Think Of Laura, Never Be The Same, Say You'll Be Mine and Arthur's Theme, which won an Academy Award for Best Song of 1981. Currently writing songs for his next album, Cross made what is described as "the most acclaimed debuts in contemporary popular music." His self-titled 1980 LP, which sold more than four million copies worldwide, earned him five Grammys, including Record and Song of The Year for the No. 1 single, Sailing, which topped the RPM 100 singles chart on October 11, 1980. His follow-up LP, Another Page, which went platinum in the U.S., contained his hits All Right and Think Of Laura.

As Danny Strick, Vice President and General Manager of BMG Songs notes, "Classics by Christopher Cross like Ride The Wind and Sailing clearly symbolize the beginning of the '80s musically, and we feel that this addition to our company fits perfectly with our thrust toward building a dynamic and contemporary catalogue."

Erdmann has responded, but he wasn't prepared to make any comment until "the group" (CRIA) could get together.

If WEA and PolyGram do discontinue their CD packaging on the proposed date, Saturn's Leonard Kennedy says, "We (Saturn) do have a security unit that we can get in place at store level . . . but it's a matter of timing. January is a very busy month for us. It's our accounts' year end, and we're faced with many returns, pre-Christmas promotions, and stock balancing at store level."

Kennedy continues, "If, for instance, our accounts want the unit for all manufacturer CDs; MCA, BMG, CBS and Capitol, (who have not made any changes), then we are faced with extra cost at our warehouses by taking the jewel box out of the existing packaging. We would also have to change all the stock at store level with the new security unit, that in itself takes three months to do across Canada, which would be very expensive for us."

A further meeting was to be held by the association on August 15, at which time they expect to come up with a name, and to further look into the CD packaging question as well as other means of merchandising CDs.

In attendance at the first meeting of the association were: Sound Insight (A&A Records & Tapes), Group De Musique/T.C., Handleman of Canada, HMV, Millbank Music, Pindoff Record Sales, Roblan Distributors (Sam's), R.O.W. Entertainment, Saturn Distributing and Sunrise Records & Tapes. Not in attendance, but reportedly in support of the association, were A&B Sound, National Record Distributors and Total Sound.

"We have membership throughout Canada," says Kennedy "and it's a pretty strong representation of record retailers and wholesalers." He continues with, "This is the first time an association like this has been formed in Canada," stressing, "It's Canadian . . . no affiliation with NARM."

Kennedy also points out that once the membership is formed and buoyed with fees from the original members, a membership drive will be launched, "to include the mom and pop stores." He continues with, "There will be something in it for everybody . . . right

## World Music pubbery to BMG Music Worldwide

BMG Music Publishing Worldwide chalks up its sixth major publishing acquisition since the start of this year with the announcement from the organization's President Nick Firth, of the completion of negotiations to acquire World Music Publishing Group.

World Music, considered one of the leading publishers in the Benelux, maintains branches in the U.K., France and Italy. Among its large catalogue of internationally-known copyrights are Sixteen Tons, See You Later, Alligator, La Bamba, Take The A Train, Come Prima, The Petite Waltz, La Playa and Manhattan Spiritual. The catalogue also contains copyrights by Jacques Brel, Toots Thielemans and Ted Heath and also has an important Bebelux repertoire that was made famous by Will Tura, Bobbejaan, Louis Neefs and La Esterella.

## Hallmark Cards readies new Christmas album

Rachel Bolton, Marketing Media Relations Coordinator for Hallmark Cards (U.S.), reports the release of this year's album, *Carols Of Christmas*, featuring Sarah Vaughan, Samuel Ramey and the Mormon Tabernacle Choir conducted by Jerold Ottley. This is Vaughan's first album in three years and her first Christmas album in ten years. The release is available as an album and cassette for US\$2.95 and in CD for US\$7.95 with any Hallmark Christmas purchase. A video tape of the famous Salt Lake City choir making the album is available to interested parties.

A spokesperson for the Canadian operation advises that a similar promotion is being run in Canada, however, the album and cassette are tagged at \$3.95 each, with a \$10.00 purchase. There apparently is no CD product available in Canada.

Hallmark released its first Christmas collection album, which went gold in the U.S. (500,000 units sold), in 1985. Last year's album went platinum with more than 1.7 million copies sold.

World also controls several major European and American catalogues through sub-publishing deals, including French composer Michel Legrand, and manages and owns 50 percent of Editions Accuff-Rose Belgium, an affiliate of the Nashville company, Italmusic (Sugar of Italy), and Ray Ventura (containing major copyrights of Georges Brassens and Paul Misraki).

Through the agreement, BMG Ariola Belgium N.V. has acquired all of the Palette Record Label masters, many of which will be re-released on the Ariola Express label.

World Music was founded in 1932 and emerged as Belgium's leading independent music publisher under the leadership of Felix Faecq and Jacques Kluger, from 1945, and most recently, of Roland Kluger.

## MIDEM '90 already shaping success pattern

MIDEM '90, the 24th edition of the gathering for international music professionals, will take place at the Cannes Palais des Festivals from January 21 through 25 of next year, and organizers are already confident of yet another success. With still seven months to go, stand renewals are already at "a high level," and include national "umbrella" group participation from Australia, Norway, Sweden and Switzerland.

## CJRT Orchestra bows as Toronto's Philharmonic

Toronto's CJRT Orchestra will shed its name and 15-year financial link with the station and begin a new life as the Toronto Philharmonic Orchestra (TPhO). A five-concert series, beginning October 29, will serve to introduce the new orchestra under the direction of Artistic Director Paul Robinson.

The concert series, headlined as the TPhO 1989-90 Season Of Stars (Mozart Plus), will be staged at Toronto's Massey Hall. Opening the series (Oct. 29) will be internationally-acclaimed cellist Ofra Harnoy. The young Canadian is currently on release with two RCA/BMG albums, Cello Concert 1 and Ofra Harnoy Sonatas.

The second in the series will be presented Nov. 28 and will feature soprano Juliana Gondek with other soloists to be announced.

February 18th will be an exclusive Toronto date with famed Russian violinist Igor Oistrakh, who will be accompanied by his son Valery on viola.

Another well-known Canadian soloist, pianist Anton Kuerti, has been firmed for a March 18th date with Kirk Trevor as guest conductor. The last of the series will be presented on April 8th with soprano Gundula Janowitz, the leading Prima Donna of the Vienna State Opera.

The budget for the first season is expected to top \$200,000, which will hopefully come from ticket sales and corporate donations. Fund raising and marketing campaigns will be in place in the new year. It is also rumoured that a major label may be interested in recording the orchestra.


organization is already planning activity for next year's event. Group Quebec is also planning their booth activities.

Bob Bingham, joint managing director of the MIDEM organization, points out that "The music business is both strengthening and diversifying. Thanks to the compact disc in particular, certain sectors, including jazz, classical and so-called 'alternative' music are finding new life and opportunities . . . and MIDEM '90 will reflect this development."

It's expected that upwards of 35 bands with more than 200 musicians will be playing in the MIDEM rock galas, which last year were televised to 23 countries. As well, a new 4,000 seat tent will be built next to the Palm Beach Casino to house four concerts. The Hotel Martinez will be the scene once again for five artist showcases and the events at the Palais des Festivals will include jazz and blues nights. The international jazz community is now being tapped for performers.

MIDEM Classique will also continue its

policy of "attracting new, young performing talent," to its public concerts in Cannes, says Bingham. This year the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra from London will perform at a special gala under the direction of British conductor James Loughran.

## Initial shipment of 35,000 for Polydor's Stones set

The Rolling Stones' Steel Wheels tour has not only created excitement at ticket wickets across Canada and the U.S., but their album product is showing signs of doing the same at retail. Although Polydor's catalogue product of the Stones releases (London/ABKCO) have been steady sellers, the announcement of the tour has obviously created further customer interest, particularly with the August 15th release of the box set, The Rolling Stones Singles Collection - The London Years. More than 35,000 units have been initially shipped, an impressive number, considering the high ticket price on the set: a Suggested List of \$70 for the CD set and \$46 for the LP/Cassette package.

The set contains 58 recordings comprising all the Stones singles, A and B sides, released in North America and the U.K. between 1963 and 1971. Also included is

The CD contains the single version (4:00), the LP version (4:40) and producer Chris Kimsey's 12" mix (6:10).

It's called American Glace (EC: *American? That's taking Free Trade too far!*) and it's 100 percent cholesterol and fat-free, very low in sodium and suitable for all you lactose-sensitive people . . . with no artificial ANYTHING . . . and it's even kosher! I haven't tasted it yet, but I'm about to call my dear old friend, Marianne Heller at 416-962-7739, and ask her about it. She's the head honcho for American Glace Canada. Oh! By the way, if you happen to be at the CNE, you can find this frozen dessert at the Yogurt Hut. (EC: *Is there a musical theme here somewhere . . . ?*)

(EC: *To borrow a saying from radio programmes, "If it's in the grooves . . . it'll sell!"*)

**They're talking Christmas already!** Just as I was getting used to and enjoying the hot muggy days of summer . . . ZOWIE . . . it's Christmas talk once more. WEA's Garry Newman says the smart retailer will order their Christmas product now . . . and he's suggesting a baleful of the Randy Travis album, back to back, of course, with his new album, which is just being released as well. (EC: *Is that a plug . . . ?*)

**Here's another Ho! Ho! item!** Hallmark Cards, the American parent, sent me a cassette and compact disc of their new Carols Of Christmas release, which features Sarah Vaughan, Samuel Ramey and The Mormon Tabernacle Choir. They do all the old traditional Christmas stuff, and it's beautifully done. Did I hear from the Canadian operation? Funny you should ask. No, but I called them, but I guess I didn't have to be reminded that they're not in the record business. (EC: *You should have tried W.H. Smith . . . !*)

**A station with heart . . . !** Q107's Rockin' John Derringer was "Johnny-on-the-spot" (EC: *Is that a pun?*) when he picked up on a local news item in one of Toronto's dailies. A seventeen year old Toronto youth had been fined \$107 for innocently parking a drunk driver's truck . . . and being that John is a

supporter of the on-going battle against drinking and driving . . . he called the kid and offered to pay for the ticket on behalf of Q107. Obviously it was an offer that couldn't be refused and as a footnote John says, "Drinking and driving is probably the most unhip thing someone can do." (EC: *Right on . . . John!*)

**Talk about impersonal . . . !** Most people in the industry, that I know, don't really expect to get a drooly letter thanking them for lending a hand, financially or otherwise to events that happen within the industry. It's a nice touch . . . when well done, but to receive a form letter, addressed to "Dear Sponsor", and signed "The Committee", with little in between, is a little hard to take. I'd rather not be thanked. (EC: *When you're losing all that business, it's hard to remember your name!*)

**You gotta get up before dawn . . . !** to beat Sunrise. While all the talk has been going on about the soft, soft and softer retail scene, the Sunrise people have been enjoying one of their best quarters for some time. A major factor in this success is their attitude. They're promoting the hits, catalogue . . . and country! The hits are never any problem, but when you can effectively position country and the real solid catalogue product, you have an extra edge . . . and that's what the Sunrise stores have done. (EC: *You mean someone's catering to the 25 to 49 age group . . . ?*)

## Alert scores release of new Eric Andersen LP

Alert Records has announced the Canadian release of Eric Andersen's new album, *Ghosts Upon The Road*. The album, described as "a poetic ten song collection" will be available Sept. 7th. Alert is distributed in Canada by Capitol

The new LP is Andersen's first North American release in almost twelve years, and is being compared to his classic 1972 release of *Blue River*. The new album features former Roxy Music drummer Andy Newmark plus various members of Suzanne Vega's band. Steve Addabbo, producer of Vega's *Solitude Standing*, takes co-production credits. *Too Many Times (I Will Try)* will be taken as the first single, expected to ship Aug. 31.

Andersen, who now resides in Oslo, Norway, will begin a world tour the end of August to include Canadian dates to be announced.



## Seals & Crofts re-enter spotlight with Peace Tour

Ten years ago, for personal and musical reasons, the soft-rock duo of Seals & Crofts called it a day. This summer marks their return to the stage and finds them with plans underway for future studio efforts.

The Peace Concert Tour, the occasion of their reappearance, was conceived of after, eight months ago, the pair was invited by the Los Angeles Ba-hai community to present a document entitled The Promise of World Peace to the film and music industries. The primary purpose of the tour is to promote a plan for peace as outlined in this document, but, assures Jimmy Seals, each date will be, first and foremost, a musical event. "We're going to have the document there and we're going to announce the purpose of our tour," he informs, "then we're going to play music and not talk about it anymore until after the concert."

The tour itself, consisting of eight shows, interestingly will take place entirely in Canada, which Seals describes as "a spiritual Switzerland". "Canada has been responsible for so many movements and has always been able to clearly state what their position was on the issues, a little more clearly than some of the other countries," he offers in explanation.

Water Music, a new record label carrying Doug Cameron, who will be the support act for Seals & Crofts, is presenting the Peace Concert Tour. "They're trying to give some new artists a break," relates Seals, "and they're trying to do some things that contribute some kind of service to mankind."

In addition to wanting to spend more time with their families, the duo decided to stop recording because they felt that the music they were producing was not well-suited to the rapidly changing popular tastes of the late seventies. "This was along about the time that disco music had come in," Seals recalls. "We found ourselves with a borderline disco hit record called You're The Love," he elaborates, "and we went out on tour, but we found ourselves in a Club 54 kind of situation.

"There are certain kinds of songs that we just can't do," he admits, "It just doesn't sound normal for us to do it. It doesn't sound believable and it's really not from our hearts." Concluding that this was not what they wanted to do, the pair split, Seals moving to Costa Rica where he has a coffee farm, Dash Crofts settling in Nashville after living in Mexico and Australia.

Seals offers an informed outsider's overview of the changes that have taken place in popular music during his decade departure from the arena. "There's a dual process I see," he states. "One is that all of the technological advancements have put music in the hands of people who normally couldn't afford to do it."

On the negative side of the ledger, "I feel like the dynamics have been lost in records quite a lot," he suggests, and "there's a certain spirit to that [live music] that's been lost, and I think there's a meaninglessness throughout everybody's lives at this time in the world and I think that the music reflects

that."

The contemporary music scene, he feels will be much more open to his style of music than it was ten years ago. "According to what some of the record people have expressed," he states, "they're having problems with new artists: Unless they're really really dynamite, their lifespan is so short and the competition is so great . . . in order to sell records they're going back to the sixties and the seventies and trying to tap some of the oldies but goodies market because there are certain elements in those songs that are universal in their appeal."

"We're getting as much airplay in the United States now as we got when we were out promoting the records when they were fresh," he declares. "When we get our BMI statements, it reflects that that was a creative time in music that people like . . . Some of the record executives have expressed that they can sell more records with older or established artists than with new."

With this in mind, Seals & Crofts plan to re-enter the studio for another kick at the can. "We'd like to have another album out, hopefully this year," says Seals. "We, at least, have to try to give it a shot because I really feel that if you have something you want to say and there's a forum to say it, get out there and do it." With both a message and an outlet, in the form of The Peace Concert Tour, all that remains to be seen is whether the duo can find an audience that will support them as they make music geared more directly to the state of their hearts than to the state of the charts.

## What is there Behind The Green Fence?

Following is an interview by Alexander Veretennikov of the *Novosti Free Press*, with Marianna Algina, editor of *Behind The Green Fence*, a rock paper recently launched in Tallinn, Estonia.

Our publication helps Estonian rock buffs shape their own judgement on the basis of personal impressions, rather than hackneyed lamentation about some rock threat from the West.

A whole generation of musicians were driven "into basements" by the official ban on rock music . . . and yet, Estonia's best songs for 1989 were Non-Nuclear Estonia from the rock band Data, Lord Save The King from the punk outfit Vennaskond, and Hands Up, Virumaa of the heavy metal I.M.K.E.

The demanding and critical position of our rock newspaper regarding the diversity of popular music in Estonia helped young people tell the difference between genuine art and the mediocre product of rock pushers who profit from public ignorance and semi-official denunciation of rock.

With our help, rock bands now play dates at prestigious sites which they couldn't even dream of a short time ago. However, bureaucrats have done a good job at alienating rock musicians, squeezing them like lemons and then throwing them away. Most rock musicians were denied subsidies from the government after they had played dozens of exhausting tours around the country for

token renumeration. But our paper has convinced Tallin's Komsomol committee to give them financial assistance.

We are a profitable publication and we pay all our expenses. The Green Fence is a monthly with a circulation of 15,000. Our staff are not professionals, but the quality is professional.

Leningrad's Rock Club and Moscow's Rock Lab print their newspapers, but they don't have modern equipment, while ours are top-notch facilities.

The newspaper is our main tool of speaking to young people. The overwhelming majority of them listen to rock music, and their interest in heavy metal, disco, new wave, punk, and in particular, performers, acts as a character-forming factor and as a basis for friendships. Our contributors deal with it. Most of them are scholars, teachers, critics, philosophers, musicians from both this country and abroad.

In the Brezhnev era, many problems were dealt with at the expense of young people, the most energetic and cooperative segment of society. As a result, they lost conviction, their belief in the feasibility of the goals proclaimed. Today, young people are now the driving force of perestroika. But they want to live well now . . . not in some distant future. The *Behind The Green Fence* helps young people think about the world around them in quiet, letting them be what they are.





Considered by many nothing more than hype-driven chartjackets of flash in the pan genre, the Beastie Boy had a tall order to fill with their second outing, a task they have carried out admirably. An exceptionally varied effort, they employ more subtle samples and funkier grooves than other current rap artists, with the possible exception of De La Soul, and have delivered their most radio-accessible single to date in Hey Ladies. While High Plains Drifter is strongly reminiscent of earlier work, tracks like The Sounds Of Science, featuring assorted Beatles' hits, and B-Boy Bouillabaisse, an extended medley, display fine versatility within a too-often banal style. - CM




THE TRAGICALLY HIP - Pop



Quebec is the most likely place for this record to take off and with the door already opened by such international successes as Johnny Clegg and The Gipsy Kings, watch for stations there to be the first to playlist the single, Johnny (the LP's only French track), once covered by Edith Piaf. - DS



Over the last couple of years, NEO A4 have enjoyed a strong following in their home province of Alberta, but with the release of their third LP, that following may just swell to include fans from coast to coast. The rest of the LP is an interesting blend of energetic guitar rock and alternative cuts that campus radio may take an interest in. Again & Again, Calling You and in Our World are also worth a listen, and the full digital recording of this outing is a real plus. - DS

A bumper crop of quality tracks, this album bounces and sways with its endearing blend of pop, rock and country. While all songs are key, standouts include Hideaway, Girl I Almost Married and Wheels, a ballad that should be welcomed with open arms by country programmers who take the time to listen to releases that are not entirely of the format. - CM




SHAWN PHILLIPS - Pop/Rock

He makes good use of various collaborations, with Dave Stewart sharing writing credits for Algernon's Simply Awfully Good At Algebra and Jeff Beck contributing some elegant guitar, especially on Call A Wave. Throughout, the effort is slickly produced and danceable without pandering to the accepted sounds of modern disco. While the album is of consistently good quality, it accomplishes little more than proving again that, although quick to spot a trend, McLaren is no pioneer and depends on current crazes to spark expression more commercial than artistic. - CM




HOODOO GURUS - Rock
