

HMV Music Stores, in conjunction with CBS Records Canada, is holding the largest contest in the retailer's history. The winner will receive a grand prize of a trip for two to London, England, a Contiki Rock Tour of London featuring Pink Floyd, The Clash, Bob Dylan and the Rolling Stones, \$500.00 spending money (Canadian), and a "Rock Race" in HMV's premiere location on Oxford Circus, the largest music store in the world. Platel's battle rap spurs on Blue Jays

Toronto's Blue Jays are currently in the thick of the American League pennant battle and record marketing veteran Dave Platel has put together a catchy rap song he hopes will spur his heroes on to win the big prize. The song has already gained points, particularly with Toronto radio.

The Blue Jays Rap, written and produced by Platel and Kevan McKenzie, has been released by CBS as a part of two-song cassette, which also features the already popular OK Blue Jays song. Platel and local Toronto singer John Mays perform the rap section, while the choral background is supplied by members of the Variety Village Orchestra. All instrumentation and programming was handled by McKenzie. The performers call themselves the Variety Club Rap Gang.

As well as a fan booster, this souvenir cassette, now available at retail, is a fund-raiser for the Variety Club. Fifty cents from the sales of each tape will be donated to the Variety Club. As Platel points out, "The association between Variety Club and the Blue Jays dates back to the inception of the team. The Blue Jays organization has been extremely cooperative in getting this project off the ground, including providing their logo without a fee . . . and with the combined support of CBS and the Blue Jays, it's hoped we will raise funds for Variety for years to come."

Jeff Healey Band's debut now double platinum

Susan Desmarais, of BMG Music Canada, reports See The Light, the debut album by The Jeff Healey Band, is now double platinum in Canada. As well, the LP has just gone gold in the U.S. reflecting sales in excess of 500,000 units. Worldwide sales are over 1.1 million. The album has enjoyed 51 weeks on the RPM 100. Another achievement is the Roadhouse soundtrack, which is now heading for platinum.

Healey and his band have just capped a tour of the U.S. with Little Feat and are now wrapping up a tour of Western Canada. After more dates in the U.S. through October, the band will begin work on their next album, scheduled for a spring release.

Basskin joins CMRRA as General Manager

David A. Basskin, B.A. LL.B has been appointed General Manager of the Canadian Musical Reproduction Rights Agency (CMRRA). Mr. Basskin is a Toronto entertainment and copyright lawyer with an extensive background in music, broadcasting and television and film production. He was educated at the University of Toronto and Osgoode Hall Law School and called to the bar in 1979. He served as a Law Clerk to the Chief Justice of the High Court of Ontario before joining CTV Television Network where he worked in a series of positions related to the Network's legal corporate and regulatory affairs culminating as CTV's Corporate Secretary and Legal Counsel.

Most recently, Mr. Basskin served as a member of the legal department of Nalvana Limited, a major Canadian producer of films and television programs. Mark Altman, President of CMRRA, in making the above announcement points out that Mr. Basskin "brings to the CMRRA a lifelong interest in music, both as a lawyer and as a musician, as well as his prior involvement and continuing interest in the reform of Canada's copyright legislation."

The CMRRA, which was founded in 1976, acts as a licensing and royalty collection agent for 15,000 corporations and individuals who own or have the right to administer the reproduction of the copyright in musical compositions. The agency primarily issues licenses to and collects royalties from the Canadian recording industry and the Canadian film, television and advertising industries, which in turn distributes to its clients in Canada and around the world.

BMG platinum and gold to RCA's Astley

During his recent promotion visit to Toronto, RCA recording artist Rick Astley was presented with both platinum and gold awards by BMG's Manager of Artists Relations, Ken Bain, Manager of National Media Relations, Susan Desmarais, and BMG/RCA Product Manager Sarah Norris.



Astley received double platinum for sales in excess of 200,000 on his album Hold Me In Your Arms, which enjoyed 33 weeks of charting on the RPM 100. He also received two gold awards for the singles Together Again and Never Gonna Give You Up. His current single, Hold Me In Your Arms, is now charting on the RPM 100 singles chart.



Wiz Bryant revives old values on new release

For fifteen years, singer/songwriter Wiz Bryant has travelled Canada, singing proudly of his country and its culture. Now he is back on vinyl with his fourth LP, Blue Collar Heroes, his first effort for Steve Thomson's Trilogy label.

"It's really a populist statement," says Bryant of his upcoming release, "an album that I wanted to do for all the hard-working people, whether they're truckers or fishermen or waitresses . . . some of them are making good money; some of them aren't; but they're all working very hard."

"We create this image of lifestyles of the rich and the famous," he continues. "If you're middle management or if you're [blue collar] . . . it's hard on your self-esteem because a lot of people in white-collar don't realize that if everybody in blue-collar stopped tomorrow, the country would be [stopped]. If you don't have a road to drive on or a car to drive or someone to fix your phone, then who the hell are you?" he asks. "I figured a statement was needed for these people because they don't get the celebration that they deserve."

"My Canadian songs will always be a big part of what I do," Bryant assures, "[but] I'm writing more philosophical stuff now . . . with more of a universal scope because I'm becoming very aware of who we all are with sort of a spiritual force: our oneness with God, our oneness with each other, our oneness with the earth, and that's becoming very important to me, more important than nationalism."

If talk of "oneness" harkens back to the sixties, it is with good reason as Bryan confides he was once a dedicated hippie. "I think there's an awareness that happened with the Woodstock generation, the summer of love and the whole bit," he suggests. "There's a sense of we've had time to think over the essence of it all, to get through the confusion and the despair and get through the 'me' period in the seventies and now, as people are hitting their forties, we're looking at what we're giving to our kids and there's a sense again of the awareness of the message basically and the feeling that we had about loving each other as brothers."

"That kind of awareness," he continues, "that kind of truth is becoming relevant to people again . . . it's coming around to that part of the circle again, but in a more powerful way, and very personal, but I think it's going to become very public again."

"We lost it for a while; a lot of us got caught up in the same thing," he stresses, "because we had to live through the seventies

too. And a lot of them said, 'Hey, it was great having those feelings and those ideals and bucking the system and being poor and broke and feeling good about our emotions, feeling good about what we were doing . . . but Jesus, man, we've got to get back and play the game.' And I think a lot of us did, and I count myself in that too."

"It's really easy because so many of those values are going around and those are the messages being communicated," he relates, "that you focus on all the success, on the material goals, power, status, achievement, competition. And I lived through it and eventually bottomed out, and I was going, 'This is just ashes in my hand'."

"The focus has been put on external success," he asserts, "when really what you feel in here is that you want to be an internal success; and that's not material values, it's spiritual values and human values, which is really the quality of life - it's what you feel."

"That focus on external success in the marketplace is all focussed on ego and it doesn't make us happy," he elaborates. "We're both fearful; we're anxious; we're in competition with each other whereas, if we can change the focus to our unity, our brotherhood, with the earth, with each other, with the whole universe, that's a whole different ballgame."

"Okay, that's a sixties message," he admits, "but it's happening now and people are ready for it because they're tired, they're weary; the world is weary; we're weary of the conflict; we're weary of all the negative stuff."

Bringing his sixties message to the nineties may not make Bryant a rich man, but this is clearly not a priority of his. "I get paid for my time," he contends, "but the music is a gift, because you can't put a price on it."



Algonquin Park setting for A&M's national meet

Twenty years ago Gerry Lacoursiere brought A&M into Canada as a free standing independent label, the first of the many international labels in Canada to establish a full-blown operation. A native of Windsor, Ontario, Lacoursiere had already made a name for himself in the fiercely competitive U.S. recording industry. He had worked the Detroit market for several years, which armed him well for his new Canadian venture.

One of the first to join Lacoursiere in the launch of A&M Records Canada was Joe Summers, another Detroit music industry street fighter, and together they built the

Virgin, and the newly-acquired Chameleon label, presented short, detailed and entertaining segments, revealing up-and-coming new acts and releases. As well, it was announced that a recently pacted deal with Rykodisc would give A&M the powerful reissue box set of David Bowie's out-of-print RCA catalogue, which has all the earmarks of becoming a "much-in-demand" item for the Christmas season.

The A&M and distributed label product presentations were interspersed with roots-type very matter-of-fact discussions by Roblan's Jason Sniderman, Mike Shalett of New York's Street Pulse Group, well-known communications consultant Doug Pringle, MuchMusic's John Martin and Pierre Marchand of MusiquePlus.

Perhaps the most important factor for the success of the convention was the theme, "Let's Work Together", which was predicated on Leadership Secrets of Attila The Hun, a powerful, modern-day treatise on this notorious barbarian, and his leadership qualities, written by Wess Roberts, Ph.d. This book was discovered by Joe Summers, and throughout the four day convention, A&M personnel, dressed as Huns, would introduce Attila, who would read short pieces from the book, with each reading having a

Canadian operation into a tough, tight, closely-knit family with emphasis on team spirit. This team spirit was revealed at A&M's national convention which was held at Arowhon Pines in Ontario's Algonquin Park from September 5th through 8th. This was the first time the trades (Luc Martel of Radio Activite, The Record's David Farrell and RPM's Stan Klees and Walt Grealis) had been invited to sit in on A&M's internal workshops. This was an opportunity for the trade press to view, and to take part in, the well-planned seminars, which allowed for a better understanding of how a major independent label goes about structuring its marketing, sales and promotion campaigns.

Also of major importance for the A&M operation is the success of their distributed labels, and it was only fitting that product presentations from some of these labels were a priority for the convention. Attic and

direct application to the record business.

On the final evening of the convention, A&M personnel and guests were recruited as tribespeople and Chieftains. The purpose was to play The Desert Kings, a business-oriented game, the results of which could also be applied to the record business.

Gil Friesen, President of A&M Records Inc., capped the convention with a fitting tribute to Gerry Lacoursiere and his twenty years of "dedication" to the label. "It was an emotional high for me," commented Lacoursiere. "We've been successful because we have a tendency to attract people who believe in the music and believe in the artists



and that's still very key with us. That's where we start from and if we don't have that, we don't have anything." He concludes with "We've worked hard to create a family atmosphere with a team spirit . . . and that spirit is very much alive and we still have the fire . . . we still believe very much in the music and the artists."

A&M holds their national convention once every two years. "There's no way we could do a meeting every year, with the same intensity we demand," says Summers, . "We started planning this meeting last January at the national level and, right up to the final week of the meeting, we were still fine-tuning and changing various aspects of it. We go into each meeting with some kind of theme or some kind of game . . . a sense of purpose, which is why we can't do it every year. It would take too much energy, and I don't think we could achieve that same high every year."

As Summers points out, "Using the Attila The Hun theme . . . we not only got the business message across, but we had some fun. I think it was a tribute to some of the veterans who got dressed up in outlandish

costumes and spent many extra hours in putting together their presentations. Music was obviously the primary focus, with marketing secondary, but I think we can also enjoy ourselves." He concludes with, "We're not curing cancer . . . we're still in a product line that is fun to everyone who buys records, so why shouldn't we have some fun in the course of taking this product to the marketplace."


820 CHAM and James receive nod from CMA


