


## BMG Canada schedules release of Cancon acts

BMG Canada is readying a full roster of domestic releases expected to ease the company into the nineties with a great deal of confidence. The A&R Department under David Bendeth is now ready to launch a marketing, sales and promotion blitz designed to bring their domestic acts to the attention of radio and retail.

"This year marks my 10th anniversary with BMG/RCA," says Don Kollar, President and General Manager of BMG Music Canada, "and certainly the most fulfilling year in terms of A&R development. David (Bendeth) has put together an exciting and diverse artist roster in which BMG is fully committed."

Among the first of the new releases is a self-titled debut album from Sheree. The first single, *Woman's Work*, described as "a powerful tribute to working women," is scheduled for release to radio on Oct. 6. The album, produced by Fred Zarr (of Debbie Gibson fame), Lou Pomanti and Bendeth, is set for an Oct. 16th release.

Regatta will be off with their self-titled debut album in January. A single, *Wherever You Run*, will be released about the same time. The band's album was produced by Bendeth and engineered by Steve Rinkoff (Tom Cochrane, George Harrison) and Ed Thacker (XTC and Glass Tiger).

Island Records Canada has added to and promoted within its marketing and promotion departments over the last couple of weeks.

Carol Wright has been upped to Director of Marketing and Promotion. She has been with the company for almost five years, serving in numerous capacities, most recently as National Promotion Manager. Her promotion is effective immediately.

East Coast radio programmer Doug Caldwell joins the Island organization as Radio Promotion Manager. He has been associated with the broadcasting sector for almost ten years, his most recent position being that of Music Director at Q104 Halifax. His appointment is effective Oct. 1st.

and BMG, Toronto's Picture Comes To Life has had their self-titled debut album completely remastered. The band is described as having an "immense talent as songwriters, performers, artists and video directors."

Prairie Oyster was signed in a joint agreement by both BMG Canada and RCA Nashville. The band is now in production with Steve Berlin (of Los Lobos fame) at the Grant Avenue Studios located in Hamilton, Ontario. Their debut album on BMG/RCA is scheduled for March of next year.

No stranger to the charts, country's popular Family Brown are now charting with their latest single, *Pioneers*, which features a guest appearance by Hank Snow. Their album, *Life And Times*, features two new tracks, including *Pioneers*.

The Cowboy Junkies have already scored platinum success in Canada and gold in the U.S. with their *Trinity Session* album. After they return from their current tour of Japan, the band is scheduled to return to Toronto's Eastern Sound to finish recording their second album, expected to be released the first quarter of next year.

## Montreal's Cinema V wins Rock Showdown '89

Cinema V, a Montreal band that won this year's Rock Showdown competition, will represent Canada at Yamaha's International Music Festival, *Band Explosion*. Finalists from seventeen countries will compete in the world's largest rock competition to be staged at Tokyo's Budokon on Oct. 29th.

The band will also be the first featured on the Rock Showdown compilation album with their single *Love Will Find A Way*, distributed by CBS. There were close to three thousand tape entries from all across Canada competing for the Canadian title.

## Capitol takes new releases on national road show


The top executives of Capitol Records - EMI of Canada were so enthusiastic over their success so far this year and their upcoming releases, they organized a road show that hit several major markets including Vancouver, Calgary, Edmonton, Winnipeg, Montreal and Toronto. With local branches looking after securing suitable theatre-type locations, and inviting radio, retail and press people, head office marketing, sales, promotion, and A&R executives played to audiences that averaged over 100 of the key players in their individual endeavours.

"The real reason we did this," explains Ron Michael-Scott, Director of Marketing for Capitol Records - EMI of Canada, "was as a replacement for our own national convention. Rather than put on this presentation for our field people, we decided to share it with the music industry at large. We also had a spectacular spring and summer and we feel the fall is going to be just as strong, which is a good reason to go out across the country."

As evidenced by the Toronto showing, retail was heavily involved, as was the case in all the other cities affirms Scott, who points out, "We wanted to make sure we got a good

representation from radio and the press and particularly retail. We wanted to focus on retail because they're on the front lines and we wanted to share our excitement and product with the people who are really going to help to create many of the hits for us."

Scott continues with, "We have a very healthy market share (16 percent) and we want to ensure we keep the lion's share going into the critical Christmas season."

It was obvious that Capitol's field representatives were as enthused over the upcoming product and success of the company as was the head office delegation headed by the President, Deane Cameron.

"The bottom line is that we've got tremendous support in the street," Scott stresses, continuing with, "We have a lot of support from retail and radio and I daresay, it is this momentum that's carrying us through . . . so it's easy for us to be enthused, but when you see that much support, it's very encouraging."

In terms of sales, Scott points out, "our billing for August is up 48 percent over the same month last year," concluding with, "Yes, we're having a very very healthy year."

## PROCAN chalks up another glittering event

PROCAN's 21st Annual Awards Presentation, held (Sept. 20) at Toronto's Four Seasons Hotel, was another triumph for the performing rights organization. The black-tie affair attracted a glittering, and enthusiastic crowd of songwriters, publishers, and record industry executives to what was jokingly referred to as "the last supper." It's expected that over the next few months, PROCAN and CAPAC will merge as one performing rights organization.

In all, 26 composers and 14 music publishers, including multiple award-winning companies BMG Dunbar Music Canada, PolyGram Songs of Montreal, EMI Blackwood Music of Canada and A&M Record's publishing arm Irving Music of Canada, were honoured.

Emceeing once again was Denise Donlon of CITY-TV and MuchMusic, who cleverly tied-in the presenters with the winners, while David Warrack provided a unique musical

bridge between presentations.

The highlight of the evening was the presentation of the Wm. Harold Moon Award to Burton Cummings, in recognition of his international achievements. He joins the list of Moon Award winners that includes Leonard Cohen, Bryan Adams, Bruce Cockburn, Hagood Hardy, Frank Mills and Burton's partner in The Guess Who, Randy Bachman.


Songwriter Eddie Schwartz was among the big winners. He co-wrote three of the top ten most-performed Canadian songs licensed by PROCAN last year. He supplied hits for Pat Benatar, Robert Palmer and the Doobie Brothers. He was presented with an award for *Don't Shed A Tear*, which was recorded by Paul Carrack. Schwartz and co-writer David Tyson received awards for Joe Cocker's hit *All Our Tomorrows* and the two songwriters were then joined by Errol Starr, whose song, *Angel*, was penned by all three Toronto songwriters.

Vancouver's Jim Vallance was on hand to pick up his 19th PROCAN pop music award for *Diamond Sun*, the Glass Tiger hit. He was first honoured in 1978. Vancouverite, former opera singer Paul Janz was honoured with an award for his song *Believe In Me*.

Jean-Pierre Brie, Luc Papineau, Guy Pisapia and Jean-Marc, writers for The Box of Montreal, won a pop music award for *Crying Out Loud For Love*. Fellow Montrealer, Ivan Doroschuk, lead singer and songwriter for Men Without Hats, was honoured in the same category for the international hit *Pop Goes The World*.

Rita MacNeil, of Big Pond (Cape Breton), received a pop music award for *Flying On Your Own*, the title track of her Virgin album. This is the second year in a row that MacNeil was honoured for this song.

A first-time collaboration gained awards for Ken Horvat and Steve Sexton, both Toronto area songwriters, for Tu's recording

### of Stay With Me.

In the country field, former Cedar Creek member Ken Harnden, co-wrote two of the three most-performed country songs of 1988. *Leeanna* and *She Knows I Can't Say No*, were the first songs Harnden released as a solo artist. Also sharing country honours was Family Brown's Randall Prescott, who co-wrote the band's hit, *Town Of Tears*.

Awards for French-language songs went to the writers of three songs: *Au coeur du desert*, co-written by Jean-Alain Roussel, Jean-Vincent Fournier and Martine St-Clair, who performed the song; *Doux*, co-written by Jean Millaire and performer Marjolene Morin (Mario); and *Vivre avec celui qu'on aime*, co-written by Christian Peloquin and performer Francine Raymond.

PROCAN's most performed song in 1988 was the George Harrison hit, *I've Got My Mind Set On You*. Rudy Clark of Los Angeles was presented with an award for writing this song.

## Capitol's Zurba struts new classical releases

Capitol's recent cross-country product presentation road show (see separate item), was somewhat unique in that it allowed the gentle integration of classical music releases into a heavy program of rock and pop. This was a rare opportunity for Capitol's Director of Classical and Jazz Marketing, Maurice Zurba, to boast his wares. "This was a very important presentation for the classical music side of the company," Zurba explains. "The settings were perfect for this type of presentation and the people who showed up were respectful of classical music, even though the bulk of the presentation was aimed at people interested in rock and pop."

This wasn't a heavy classical music trip however, as Zurba points out, "Our Angel presentation was very well done in that it showed a lot of the crossover material, like *Opera Goes To The Movies*, *Great Themes From The Movies* and *Madison Avenue Goes To The Movies*." There was also an electrifying video by young violinist Nadja, "who is one of those passionate individuals you rarely, if ever, see," trumpets Zurba.

Classical recordings continue to be big sellers, although relegated to almost

obscurity, in favour of rock, pop and country recordings. "In the last two years," boasts Zurba, we have increased our business by more than 200 percent." He continues with, "The marvelous thing for us is that when you look at our particular company right now, really . . . there isn't another company that has the resources that we have on recorded sound. Now, I'm talking about EMI Classics, one particular company. It has the largest resource of any for a single company."

Zurba is also proud of the fact that percentage-wise, the Canadian operation does much better, per capita, than its counterpart in the U.S.

The increase in sales of classical music has obviously come about through the popularity of compact discs. "Albums?" bristles Zurba, "We don't even discuss albums . . . because albums are nowhere! It's compact discs that are important to classical music and I think compact discs were made for our company . . . the saving, the quality, the performance, the accessibility . . . that's EMI Classics, and we are very well known in the field."

## U4EA's debut single picks up A/C action

U4EA, a Toronto (Scarborough) trio, have made impressive gains with their debut single, *Don't Take It Away*, released on the Padger label. The band comprises Patrick Canavan, who supplies lead vocals, bass and keyboards and writes most of the material for the band, Blair Waddell on guitar, and drummer Steve Charlton.

The trio are veterans in the business, having performed for the past ten years as Epsilon. With the name change, the band booked time at Number 9 Sound, and with Canavan producing and Jim Zolis on the board, recorded their debut for the label, utilizing the talent of Cecile Pastor for background vocals. The flip, *Give Me A Call*, was co-written by Canavan and Waddell. A video of *Don't Take It Away* is also being readied for release along with *Contender*, their debut album.

The band is somewhat unique, using original works of art in combination with their music. The cover art on their single sleeve is the original artwork of Adrian Derooy.



## T'Pau's Carol Decker spreading her charm

With only one truly penetrating single off their debut LP, T'Pau managed to wrench quite a reaction from the North American market. Heart & Soul brought a sudden, albeit short, success that remarkably still lingers in the public memory. Unfortunately, this armour-piercing track was the only musical tidbit to capture our attention - at least on this side of the pond.

In their native UK the band made a steady and substantial climb to number five with Heart & Soul, and to number one with the follow up, China In Your Hand. Prior to recording their second LP Rage, T'Pau toured across Europe in support of Nik Kershaw and Bryan Adams, quickly attaining a status as one of Britain's biggest live acts.

Another memory not quick to fizzle was that of lead singer Carol Decker. This infectiously energetic redhead quickly became T'Pau's identity; the perfect package to sell their material, and a refreshingly talented live performer. This solo-esque image does not sit badly with Decker or her partners. "I do like the attention. I like the fact that the band has established itself as a good live act. I like the fact that I'm known for that energy and that drive. They don't envy me. They're just like, 'Ha-Ha we can stay in bed and you have to get up and talk.' Occasionally it's peeved Dean. We did a show in Germany and all the guys in the audience were just shouting at me like, 'come on, get your tits out!' and all this sort of stuff. Dean was saying, 'I'm a musician in a band. I don't need all this bimbo stuff.' They felt they were irrelevant and everybody wanted to look up my skirt."

Decker's on stage persona, although occupying a niche of its own, draws partly from self-admitted inspiration, Chrissie Hynde. "I loved it - the set up. A tomboy at the front. I also like Tina Turner, Cyndi

Lauper, and Neneh Cherry - I think she's cool. I suppose I like the strong women."

The clearly feminine playfulness that no-doubt mounts a great deal of T'Pau's attraction certainly never strays into the overt use of sexuality. "I'm not sexy at all. I'm fun and I'm flirtatious, and I'm coquettish, but it's all very overblown. I don't sort of strut and pout. I've been criticized by the serious press for wearing short skirts, but I always say that I'm no more indiscreetly dressed than an ice skater. I always wear very thick tights so you can't see anything, and I've got neat little skirts. It's not all low cleavage stuff. I'm sort of a tease but it's very tomboyish too." This most common marketing tool has refreshingly not been exploited to the extent of many female performers.

The characterization of refreshing extends even further when you discover how clearly the band approaches the very complicated artistic trade-offs of recording. "You often have an uneasy marriage with your record company where they want to sell it but feel that an edit is necessary to make it more commercial. Sometimes you feel yes, you're right, but it would break my heart to do this to my song. But you want to sell it! It's no good sitting at home on tape because I want everybody to hear it. There will always be that compromise - it will never go away. I do have more of a work attitude. This is what I do and I'm the luckiest person on the face of the earth to be travelling the world making my living doing this. There's a bit of art in there but I'm not eclectic or snobbish about it. I'm selling it to people." Some very healthy words, all too rare among most so-called pros.

Of course, breaking out in the UK to play such venues as Wembley arena and the like is quite an accomplishment in any circle,

especially considering the current trend on both sides of the Atlantic away from non-dance oriented music. Decker's frustration was evident. "I was shocked by the music I've heard over here, like Soul II Soul, Paula Abdul, Neneh Cherry and the like. I thought getting away from the UK at least I would hear some different bloody music - but it's all the same! I really hate all the phases like, this is what's happening, now everybody do it. Of course it's great for the label, but the rock artists are having a tough time pushing our noses through."

The U.S. market has completely ignored their particular brand of music. South of the border, Virgin has refused to release any of T'Pau's new songs. "They don't think there is a single, which I think is a load of shit!" inserts Decker. At the start I was told, 'You just write and sing the songs and don't you worry your little head about this stuff.' In a way that is good advice because it's no good me hanging up the phone after a day of good or bad business deals and them going out to entertain people with my head full of that stuff. However, I have since learned that there are some things that I should have been more involved in, and will be in the future."

T'Pau's complaints are few but warranted, and admirable splashes of professionalism abound. They may not have sold a million records in North America, but they continue to make their living quite well, writing and performing to capacity crowds anywhere from clubs to giant arenas. Decker concludes by adding, "I've always looked at life like a bed of roses with some big areas that need repair. I'll just start attending to those areas." T'Pau have certainly left a strong first impression, and although they would like the approval of all, they don't necessarily need it.



With the success of last year's Toronto Music Awards, organizers have expanded this year's show to include both radio and television plus the club scene.



Each cut is lushly arranged, richly produced masterpiece of mellow, reminiscent at times of Sade. While no other song approaches the anemic appeal of Sowing The Seeds Of Love, or sounds as much like the Beatles, Year Of The Knife stands out as a likely second single. Fans will definitely be listening to this album until the next one arrives. - CM



## PAUL KELLY &amp; THE MESSENGERS - Pop

Somewhat disappointing when compared to 1988's *Under The Sun*, the release is nonetheless solid. Kelly's nasal voice is in great form, especially on the ballad *South Of Germany*, and the songs are uniformly well-written and lyrically interesting. However, with one exception, the cuts lack the spark that made the last album so charming. That exception is *Careless*, a compellingly somber, Latin-influenced song that has multi-format written all over it. Overall, an earthy and well-constructed piece of work. - CM

## BONHAM - Pop/Rock

The Disregard Of Timekeeping

While the album is not thoroughly engaging, most of the time it manages to fall into the pop/rock category without losing the heaviness in favour of slickness. Unfortunately, the use of cliche synth pads and soaking wet big harmonies results in Bonham sounding like Foreigner or Glass Tiger in several spots. Vocalist Daniel McMaster pulls off a better than average Robert Plant

impression on *Wait For You* and *Bringing Me Down*, the most Zeppelin-sounding tunes (circa *Presence*, *In Through The Out Door*) on the package, and also the most likely to meet immediate acceptance at AOR, although the shrinkwrap sticker targets *Wait For You*, *Guilty* and *Dreams*. Look for fairly strong initial retail action on this promising, although patchy, effort. - CM

## ALIEN - Rock



Bound By The Beauty - Duke Street - DSR-3058-J


From start to finish, *Bound By The Beauty* is a thoroughly warm and engaging package which will more

Love And War - MCA - MCA-6301-J



What was once a ska band, this Winnipeg quintet have now opted for a more hard-edged rock sound, and their first LP is actually a compilation of demos that were recorded over a year ago. Mitch Easter (R.E.M., Let's Active), was behind the board for this one, but the distant vocals and garage-like quality of the recording suggest that Easter wasn't paying too much attention to the action in the studio at the time. This is likely to result in most AORs passing on this one, but that's not to say that campus radio won't try it. *Always On My Mind* and *Six Nights Past* are the best shots. - DS



## MIKE OLDFIELD - Pop

Earth Moving - Virgin - VL-2610-W

A bit of a departure for Oldfield in that all ten tracks on this release feature vocals. Among the guest vocalists are Adrian Belew, Maggie Reilly and Anita Hegeler, who sings lead on the first emphasis cut, *Innocent*. Oldfield seems to be aiming for an A/C market with this outing, and the cuts would sound more at home on that format than AOR. The recording quality is excellent, but the material lacks bite, and Oldfield sounds as if he's just going through the motions on this one. - DS

## STEVEN WAYNE HORTON - Country

Steven Wayne Horton - Capitol - C4-19183-F

Horton's music is described as "lean, stripped-down rockabilly", which is quite apropos, considering the manner in which he has eased himself into the country spotlight with this debut, produced by Jack Holder. The Memphis influence is very up-front, particularly with the first single, *Roll Over* written by blues legend Steve Cropper, now moving up the RPM 100 country chart. Horton's vocals have a bit of a rock edge, and key here are the convincing job his does on rockabilly classics, *Endless Sleep* and *John Hiatt's Tennessee Plates*. Also key are *Oh Susie* and *Nothin' Shakin'*. - WG

## CCMA elects directors and executive committee



Hawley was fast gaining popularity as a sultry vocalist with an extraordinary talent on


