Roy to head up new MIDEM organization

Xavier Roy has taken over his new post of President-Director-General (chief executive) of MIDEM organization, S.A. He was previously MIDEM's Joint Managing Director and was appointed to his new post by Reed Exhibition Companies, part of Reed International PLC. As head of the MIDEM organization, Roy will be responsible for its continuing and future activities, which, in addition to MIP-TV and MIPCOM, for the television industry and MIDEM for the music business, will now include MIPIM, the world's first international property market, which will take place in Cannes, France from March 10 to 13 next year.

Bob Bingham, who was Joint Managing Director of MIDEM with Roy, has now become Managing Director of Button Group, the London-based exhibition services and

PolyGram acquires A&M's record operations

PolyGram has announced (Oct. 11/89) that it has acquired all A&M's record operations as well as its music video interests. Included in the deal are A&M's Los Angeles offices, including the former Charlie Chaplin film studios and A&M's recording studio. The acquisition does not include A&M's music publishing interests.

Commenting on recent acquisitions, PolyGram recently purchased Island Records as well (RPM, Aug. 12/89) PolyGram's President David Fine said, "We are not seeing the demise of the independent record company, rather the emergence of a new breed of independent," continuing with, "an independent with all its musical creativity, all its culture and all its street credibility, but with the resources and marketing infrastructure of a major worldwide group." He concludes with, "The acquisition of A&M further increases PolyGram's strength in the important United States market and in particular on the West Coast."

Gerry Lacoursiere, President of A&M Records Canada, commented, "I think this purchase will open up a lot of opportunities for our people . . . as well as the PolyGram people."

design company which was also acquired by Reed International as part of its agreement with TVS. Bingham will take charge of an expanded Button Group, comprising Button Design Company, specializing in graphics creation, and Button Ventures, a new stand and design management company. He will also act as a consultant to the Midem organization, producing concerts during the MIDEM music market next January and will take charge of the production and distribution of the concerts for television.

The purchase of Midem Organization, the Button Group and other exhibition and publishing operations by Reed International

from TVS Entertainment, was finalized on July 31st of this year after approval by the French government. Reed Exhibition Companies (REC) worldwide has 29 offices in 23 countries and is regarded as the world's largest exhibition organizer.

Reed International is the UK's largest publishing and information company. Over half the company's interests are in business-to-business publishing through magazines, exhibitions, reference books, databases and electronic publications. Books for the professions, education and for consumers reportedly account for a quarter of the business with the balance in consumer publishing with magazines and regional newspapers.

Axe eases into computer royalty program

Music industry veteran Greg Hambleton has parlayed his experience in songwriting and publishing into a successful new venture, Axe Music Software. Tagging his entry into the computer field, The Publisher's Royalty Program, Hambleton explains the program was designed to provide "the small music publisher with an easy-to-use, fast, accurate computer program, to be used on IBM compatible computers."

He goes on to explain that he developed the program, "because of the great difficulty in finding a computer royalty program for desk-top computers that were specifically created for the music publishing industry at a reasonable price."

The program features an easy-to-read royalty statement for the publisher's writers and co-publishers showing earnings for the current period, plus a summary of their balance from last period and advance deductions if any.

When Hambleton hit the market with his program there was an encouraging response from the industry generally. "Most of the

interest in the program," Hambleton points out, "has been from group managers, lawyers and medium sized label publishing divisions." He continues with, "I found that what most publishers want is an easy to operate means of entering royalties from the mechanical statements they receive and producing a clear, readable, professional looking statement for their writers and co-publishers."

The Publisher's Royalty Program was written using DBase IV, which automatically sorts and keeps track of more than 9,999 song titles and 9,999 writers and publishers or to the limit of hard disk space. "Most publishers have nowhere near that many song titles or payees," says Hambleton, "and this program operates most comfortably containing up to 3,000 titles."

In conclusion, Hambleton reveals that he has already written a royalty program for small record labels, "and I have other ideas in the works."

The program carries a price tag of \$579.00 (US\$499).

Segato lends talent to Auto worker's video

Lorraine Segato, former leader and co-founder of The Parachute Club, has moved into the world of video with the debut of *Good Medicine*, a first-time collaboration between Segato and the Canadian Auto Workers Union. The music video is described as "complementing" the union's educational campaign on alcohol and drug abuse." Segato wrote, directed and performs on the video which tells the story of an alcoholic's acceptance of the disease and how he labours toward recovery. Along with David Nerman of the T'N'T television series and Rebecca Jenkins, star of the newly-released feature film *Bye Bye Blues*, Segato heads up a worldclass production team including cinematographer Rene Ohashi.

Segato apparently worked closely with CAW members in the development of the script and even invited members of the union to work as extras during the filming. "Good Medicine is a reflection of a very common situation," says Segato, "It's not accusing or judgmental because most people hate to be hit over the head with messages, especially on personal issues like the ones we're facing here."

Segato concludes with, "The idea behind

Good Medicine was to create a piece of music that would be inspirational or empowering to people in the process of recovering from alcohol or drug abuse."

As CAW President Bob White points out the union's substance abuse campaign "goes beyond the conventional 'just say no' approach."

Let's have a party . . . ! Hey, I've finally had the opportunity to read the *Last Of The Good Time Boys* by Ronnie Hawkins and Peter Goddard. Whoever's doing the distributing is doing a great job. I see the book everywhere. Some of the critics weren't too kind . . . but they gave a lot of space to being unkind . . . and you measure the crucifixion, you don't wear it. On the whole, the book ain't bad . . . in fact, I'll probably read it again. I remember, not too long ago, when a hotshot Nashvillian (EC: *NashVILLIAN! Is that a Freudian slip?*) spent a lot of time with Ronnie, clandestinely writing down all his Arkansian witty sayings, and he used most of them in one of his movies . . . but no thank yous to Ronnie. I recall one time . . . a long time ago, when a pretty young "thang" was auditioning for the Hawk, he told her, "Stick with me good lookin', and I'll have you fartin' through silk in two years." (EC: *He really is a legend . . . !*)

Problems with the sound system? There have been complaints about the sound system at Toronto's SkyDome from the time of the Rod Stewart date, the first concert staged in that massive, sometimes open, most times closed "tent" as they like it referred to. However, spokespeople denied from the beginning that there was a problem, but now, after a healthy scolding from the dailies, they are admitting that the sound isn't what it should be . . . and they're going to fix it. In the meantime, they'll be booking in big ticket acts . . . to experiment. Someone asked if there would be a reduction in ticket prices during that experimental stage . . . but why bother, we know the answer. 'Why ruin a good thing'. (EC: *This golden goose is so big, nothing will kill it . . . !*)

Connie and K.D. . . . ? What a coupling, Connie Chung will be interviewing K.D. Lang on her Saturday Night interview show, next Saturday . . . and that will be worth watching. Chung seems to bring out the best and . . . the worst in the people she talks to, so we might just see some fireworks. (EC: *I think I'll tape this one . . . !*)

Island's Cash to Toronto for Innu benefit

Andrew Cash lends his talent in support of the Innu of Nitassianan and their fight against low level test flying over their land. He will play a benefit show at Toronto's Diamond Club on Oct. 15th.

Cash and his band The Ambassadors have been touring the U.S. with The Rainmakers. He has also played dates with Jeff Healey and The Stray Cats.

On the completion of shows in Ottawa (19), Hamilton (20) and Montreal (22), Cash is off to Europe as a special guest to labelmate Melissa Etheridge. He will play thirty dates in fourteen countries. The tour begins in Norway (Nov. 4), and finishes up in Dublin (Dec. 16).

The word spread very quickly about Cash's Toronto date, and the demand for tickets necessitated a second show to be staged the following evening (17). Winnipeg's Monuments Galore will open both nights.





Cowboy Junkies - three tours covering England, the U.S. and Europe in support of their platinum plus LP *Trinity Session*.


Kaeding to Elektra N.Y. as Director International



Savannah recording artist Gary Fjellgaard, currently on release with *Heart Of A Dream*, his fifth album, recently received major recognition from the industry for his achievements. Last month the British Columbia singer won Canadian Country Music Association awards for both Duo of the Year, with Linda Hunt for *The Moon Is Out To Get Me*, and Male Vocalist of the Year.

Although no stranger to awards, Fjellgaard credits much of his recent success to a higher profile gained through frequent appearances. "I think a lot of it has to do with the fact that I've been touring a little bit more and being a little more visible," he suggests. "I was part of the Canada Day celebrations on Parliament Hill . . . [which] gave me a little more exposure in this area and, breaking down the membership of the CCMA, I think that 52 percent live in Ontario, so maybe that has something to do with it."

"And there's hanging in there for a lot of years and doing what I do," he adds. "I think if you stick with something long enough and believe in something strongly long enough, eventually it starts to pay off."

For Fjellgaard, doing his own thing does not include pandering to the whims of

the all-powerful Nashville country music scene, finding fine success despite the fact that none of his albums has been released in the United States. "I guess I've never had a burning desire to go down and make my mark in Nashville like so many of us want to do," he confides. "I'd like to make a move down there, but only with the songwriting. I think as far as going down there to play and releasing records down there . . . it's sort of like starting all over again and I don't know if there's enough time in a lifetime to do all I want to do."

"In the long run, it's the songwriting that's going to be what keeps me going after my career is over so far as travelling around," hopes Fjellgaard. "I would like to get more covers done of my songs by American artists. Really that's one of the things I want to do with my material."

While Fjellgaard informs that technological advances have improved the quality of recordings coming out of Nashville, he maintains that they tend to sound far too generic. "When you hear all the music on the radio, in some ways they all sound the same and the only things that make them different are the artist, the singer, and the song," he comments, "but you'd think that they were all using the same studio musicians because they're all starting to sound similar, which seems to be fairly successful."

"I think that a lot of the artists who go to Nashville from Canada who record like

that are achieving a certain amount of success," he affirms, "but no matter how you slice it they're going to come off as maybe second best because the Americans have been doing this a lot longer than us."

"I think that to remain an individual, you should probably record in a more comfortable, unpressurelike situation and try to be a little more individual with your music," he advises. "So there's two things to do: go to Nashville and sound like everybody else or stay in Canada and do your own thing."

"It is happening in country music. The innovators are starting to come out of the woodwork," he observes. While "the mass of music is still the tried and true Nashville thing and the moneymaking stuff . . . once in a while somebody will come out and prove them all wrong by just being an individual and an innovator and I think that's the beautiful part about country music . . . there is room for these people."

"Before there wouldn't have been," he contends. "But now there's room on radio because country music radio is becoming broader and broader."

"So many times I've seen artists try to be something they're not, including me years ago," Fjellgaard recalls. "I only started to be comfortable in this business when I finally just started being me."

"You've got to be yourself and hope that you're being accepted for it," he concludes. "Somewhere there's a market for you and it doesn't matter what you're doing. Somewhere you can find your people and they can find you in all that confusion."

Fjellgaard has proven his case by slugging it out on his own for close to fifteen years to finally find, particularly within the last five years, his own audience. For Savannah, his recent career represents an investment that paid off. For Fjellgaard, it means not having to conform, no compromises and, most importantly, no regrets.




