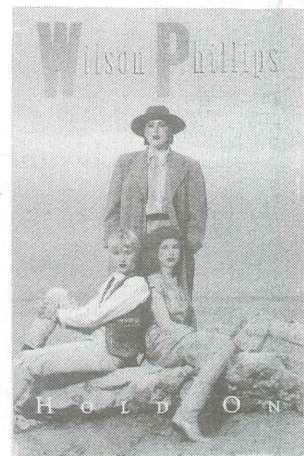

19th Juno production hosted by Rick Moranis

Rick Moranis, of The Mackenzie Brothers fame and more recently, praised for his lead roles in various feature films, played host at the 19th annual Juno Awards production on Sunday March 18th, 1990. Once again the setting was Toronto's O'Keefe Centre and Moranis had the audience on their toes throughout the entire program.

Aside from a brilliant host, the show had a creative and stunning background, an interesting and talented array of performers and some very well known presenters. The first performance of the night Still Got This Thing For You by Alannah Myles, who walked away with three Juno's, while Christopher Ward and David Tyson won Composer of the Year for their work on the Alannah Myles album, was excellent and set the pace for the acts to follow. With dynamic performances by Maestro Fresh-Wes, The Cowboy Junkies (with Lyle Lovett on the 2nd number), Kim Mitchell, The Jeff Healey Band with Tom Cochran helping with some guitar and vocal work and Sass Jordan lending a hand with the vocals. Not to forget our guest performers Rod Stewart with Downtown Train and Milli Vanilli with Blame It On The Rain, whose performances didn't show up our domestic talent but just enhanced the program.

Even the presenters were carefully selected, what a pretty picture, our most suc-

cessful record producer standing beside one of the most successful producers today, but Foster and Quincy Jones weren't the only attention getters. Anne Murray was on hand to make a presentation as were Steve Tyler and Joe Perry of Aerosmith. David Wilcox and Tom Cochran, The Jeff Healey Band and even Bryan Adams presented awards.

Some of the most interesting parts of the show were surprises like George Fox's acceptance speech where he admitted that "two years ago, taking the cow to the vet was a big deal to me." K.D. Lang's acceptance comments were short but to the point, letting the industry know that all these awards aren't her main interest, "I just love to sing." Stewart seemed amusing and put on a little bit of a show for those who were sitting close enough to see his facial expressions while presenting Kim Mitchell with his award. Finally words to live by from Milli Vanilli "First we'd like to say thank you to our fans. Thank-you."

New Kids lead second CRIA video certifications

For the second month, the Canadian Recording Industry Association (CRIA) has issued certifications for music videos. In all 19 certifications were awarded for the month of February, 1990.

The New Kids were certified Six Times Platinum (sales in excess of 60,000 units), for both their Hangin' Tough and Hangin' Tough Live; Triple Platinum (sales in excess of 30,000 units) went to Def Leppard's Historia; Bruce Springsteen's Video Anthology 1978-88 reached Double Platinum (sales in excess of 20,000) units and Platinum (sales in excess of 10,000) went to Bon Jovi for Slippery When Wet and Kiss' Exposed.

Gold certifications (5,000) went to: The Cult/Electric Love, Bon Jovi/New Jersey, Cinderella/Night Songs, Def Leppard/In The Round, In Your Face, Andrew Lloyd Webber/Video Quartet, The Who/Who's Better, Who's Best and Rush/A Show Of Hands.

Major moves at CityTV/MuchMusic

After seven years of service, Dennis Fitz-Gerald will step down from responsibilities as Vice President and General Manager of CityTV/MuchMusic. Fitz-Gerald's career has encompassed Vice Presidencies at both All-Canada Radio and Television Ltd. (a division of Selkirk) and CTV Television Network and, in 1983, he found himself becoming part of the CityTV team. Fitz-Gerald, is described as "a guiding force at the station," was instrumental in initiating MuchMusic, Musique Plus, and the extension of CityTV into Southwestern Ontario. Fitz-Gerald, whose presence at the station will be missed, says, "I'm leaving the best job - the most dynamic group of broadcasters in Canada."

Taking over for Fitz-Gerald will be Ron Waters, currently Vice-President and General Manager of CKVR in Barrie and Station Manager of MuchMusic. Waters has been involved with CHUM since 1978 and from there moved to CityTV. He was an interregal part of MuchMusic's early days as Director of Marketing and went on to become Station Manager. Waters will assume his new responsibilities as of September 1, 1990.

Effective immediately though, is the major promotion of Jay Switzer to Vice President. Switzer, who worked at CityTV as a student, wound up back there in 1983 as Programming Manager, following a partnership at Cablecasting. He was soon promoted to Program Director of both CityTV and MuchMusic. Switzer will now add Vice President to his present title Station Manager - CityTV; Director of Programming - CityTV/MuchMusic.

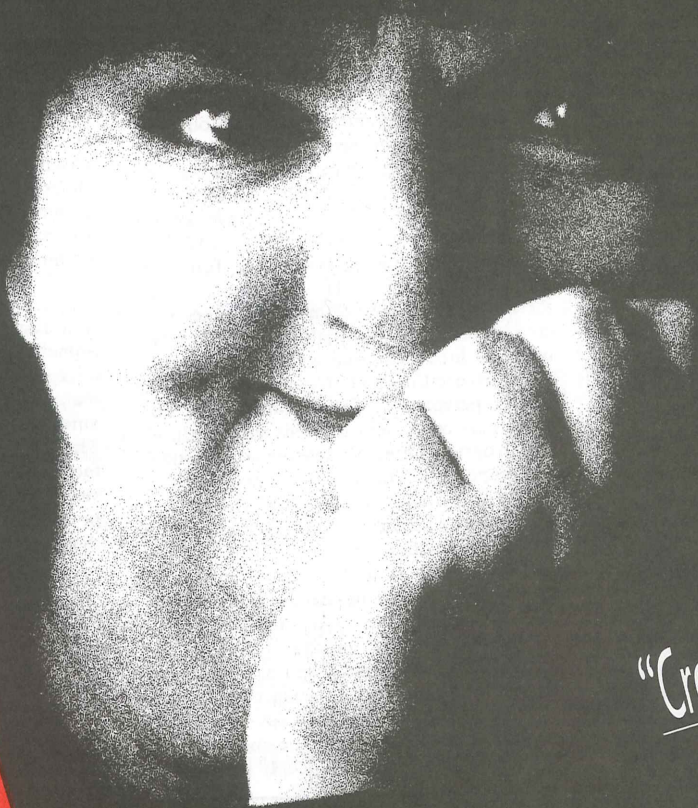
BMG's Junkies ship gold with Caution Horses

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"The Fox is a personality" -Johnson

Vancouver's 99.3 The Fox is one of the more aggressive of Canada's rock 'n' roll stations. Jim Johnston, Director of Programming, is a dedicated programmer whose priority is "the most visibility possible" for his station.

As to questions of "What is The Fox", Johnston explains that CFOX carries the mantle of being "Canada's first FM rock radio station; the first community radio station; the first responsible to Vancouver community since its inception in the '60s, and the first evolved from all A.O.R." He also boasts that the station "today continues to be market leader in Vancouver significantly over others."

In answer to why does The Fox do so well and why do people endear themselves to the station and why the success, Johnston does a little chest-thumping with his answers to these questions, as follows.

The Fox is a personality and like a good personality, The Fox has many sides - The Fox is fun and exciting and has a full understanding of the responsibility to the community. Wherever we can help out, we do. We go out of our way to help out. We can't please all the people all the time, but nobody tries harder than The Fox. A big part of The Fox's success is, even though we are the market leader and we could say we are number one, our motto is still, "We try harder". One side is fun, more fun than anyone else with a flair for doing things differently, unconventional approaches that create fun and draw attention. The Fox seeks new and innovative fun ways of having fun which is exciting and draws attention. The Fox is personality. For instance, The Fox Christmas cards sent out this year featured the Program Director wearing a Christmas tree standing beside The Fox - just trying to cut through that Christmas card clutter.

The Fox is committed to the community. With the inception of The CFOX Kids Park in 1986, which is a water park created at Lumberman's Arch in Stanley Park for the use of both able and disabled-bodied children, The Fox endears itself to the community. Every year, The Fox contributes hundreds of thousands of dollars to the park to increase upon the already numerous activities that are available for children.

The Fox has become deeply involved in

The Green Report, a non-preaching feature on the environment.

the environmental issue. Approximately eight months ago, The Fox invented "The Green Report", which is a ninety-second, non-preaching feature on the environment. This feature has now gone nationwide and soon will be worldwide. This feature focuses on environmental issues and is educational. As a long standing member of the community, CFOX has a responsibility to the community. The environmental issues being the single most important worry to people these days, it's a very positive step for The Fox to focus on these concerns and in fact, since pioneering this issue, everyone else has gotten

into the act.

A Night for the Environment - CFOX, along with local promoter Bruce Allen and Bryan Adams put on a musical benefit, raising thousands of dollars for environmental agencies.

SantaFox Food Bank. CFOX, in conjunction with the Vancouver Food Bank, promoted the year in and around the greater Vancouver region. We try to be everywhere, and have incredible visibility to our audience. In the winter we focus our energies on our Ski Team, and the Deacon Blue Hockey Team. We participate in charity ski events, as well as promoting skiing throughout B.C. in general. We keep our listeners informed as to the up-to-date ski conditions locally and provincially and let them know what events the mountains are offering and where they can go to ski with the CFOX SkiFox Team. We sponsor the SkiFox Express, charter bus trips accompanied by CFOX personalities to the interior mountains. The Deacon Blues hockey team plays pick-up hockey games to benefit minor hockey, local charities as well as the CFOX Kid's Park. We also have a baseball team, the CFOX Summertime Blues, who play throughout the summer. Our community cruiser travels all over Vancouver promoting events throughout the community.

In terms of the community too, CFOX is a rock 'n' roll station. We play R&R. Sometimes, people say we're too heavy, but once they are at an event and they see our Fox mascot come bouncing by, the edge is automatically shaved off in people's minds. The Fox is warm and fuzzy. Our marketing tactics are street tactics . . . very close to the street, very involved musically. Our Fox can be seen everywhere. There are a couple of them out every day, eight hours a day.

Getting back to the musical aspects, The Fox presents almost every show that comes into town and a number of artists. A significant portion of the Cancon records that we play on our radio station are West Coast artists.

The Fox is an aggressive radio station and is a market leader because it acts like a market leader. In other words, we don't look at ourselves competing against other radio stations. We look at ourselves as competing for radio audience. Therefore we strike our own path and force others to follow. The Fox is full of people who are very good at their jobs and are reaching their potential. These people have come to terms with who they are and what they are and once you come to terms with that, you can then strike forward and reach your own potential. These people are happy, excited and proud. There is a predictable unpredictability about CFOX that has an allure to listeners. Predictable enough that it is comfortable and unpredictable enough that routine goes out the window.

Then there's the matter of Larry and

Kenny MacLean launches solo career

Kenny MacLean is best known as the bassist for erstwhile teen heartthrobs Platinum Blonde, but his career in music spans nearly two decades and has included stints with several bands, including Toronto cult group The Deserters, since he moved to Canada from his native Scotland in the mid-1970s.

Platinum Blonde has had its share of ups and downs since its first two albums, *Standing In The Dark* and *Alien Shores*, sold hundreds of thousands of copies in Canada in the mid-1980s. Now MacLean hopes to start a new chapter in his career and make a name for himself with his first solo album, *Don't Look Back*.

The first single, also called *Don't Look Back*, is moving briskly up the RPM singles chart, and all signs are positive for the album's release. MacLean says *Don't Look Back* "is the most important project of my life. I feel very excited. The single is doing really well and I'm proud of the album. It's not the greatest of productions or anything, but it's me."

MacLean wants the album to be seen as an expression of himself and his musical vision, even though a few of the people behind it are colleagues from Platinum Blonde days. *Don't Look Back* is the first album produced by Justin Entertainment, a label started by Jeff Burns, the man who signed Platinum Blonde to CBS, and fellow Blonde Sergio Galli helps out on a few tracks. But MacLean says he tried hard to make this his own record. "I didn't really want to work with Platinum Blonde members. Just because I didn't want it to be Platinum Blonde. I tried to keep it to a minimum just so it wouldn't be an offshoot of Platinum Blonde, like *Acadia* to Duran Duran. I didn't want it to be like that, I just wanted it to be Kenny MacLean."

MacLean is encouraged by the single's success, especially since the song *Don't Look*

Back holds personal significance for him. "I wrote the music and the lyrics were written by Paul Henderson, and the string arrangement was done by Claude Desjardins," he explains. "We all worked on the writing of it; it's a combination of three artists."

"I started the song. I came in with the music and I just couldn't write lyrics, so I approached my friend Paul. We both had a relationship that kind of went sour on us around the same time. Paul's my best friend, I've known him since I came to Canada 15 years ago, and we both had the same sort of situation happening. And he wrote these lyrics and I went 'wow, man', it was just too close to home. So for me to sing that song is an emotional thing."

As well as being a personal statement, the new album also means that MacLean will be able to do what he loves best: play live. "Right now we're looking at setting up a tour," he says. "I've got my own band together, it's been together over the last year. I finished recording this album last year, I started rehearsing a band in March or April [1989], and I plan to get the band out now that I've got a record." MacLean knows from experience that it's not easy to build a career on a reputation, however strong. "I couldn't get arrested without a product. It was like pulling teeth, nobody wanted to do anything. It was like 'this has-been from Platinum Blonde'. So it was a pretty hard year." But now he thinks he has turned the corner. "Now the record's out...I understand, you need a product. That's the business. Otherwise it's like opening up a shop without any goods in it."

Kenny MacLean has had some rocky times in the past, but now a new album, a hot single and his own band stand as signs that the lean days are over. His schedule for the next little while looks more than busy.

"After the tour, I really want to start working on my second album," he says. "I've already written stuff for the second album. Also, Platinum Blonde's got a new album coming out, so it's going to get pretty hectic, because I will tour with Platinum Blonde too if we have a single that does well. If we don't I obviously wouldn't tour, because I'd rather just work on my own thing."

Kenny MacLean must feel glad to have all the options. The future is looking bright, and he's not looking back.

Fringe makes headway in "obscenity" suit

Fringe Product and The Record Peddler have won a partial victory in their legal battle against obscenity charges.

The Fringe Product label and its distributor, The Record Peddler, were charged in August of 1988 with "distribution and possession for the purpose of distribution of obscene material." The charges relate to *Here Today, Guano Tomorrow*, an album by Victoria band Dayglo Abortions on the Fringe Product label.

At preliminary hearings in November 1989, Fringe Product's lawyer, Marlys Edwardh, argued that the obscenity sections of the Criminal Code are in conflict with the Canadian Charter of Rights. The court ruled that section 161 (the obscenity provisions) did stand in contradiction of the Charter, but decided the charges against Fringe Product should remain, as part of the process of defining some legal guidelines for obscene material. However, according to Fringe's manager Angus MacKay, the onus is now on the prosecution to demonstrate the material is obscene, rather than on the defence to prove it is not. A trial date has been set for May.

MacKay points out that the prosecution was hesitant to reveal which parts of the recording it considered obscene. He says the album is satirical, and the nature of the content is clear from the packaging. "We don't package something misleadingly . . . The buyer would have to be quite unaware to go home and then say, 'Oh my God, this is obscene'."

MacKay says fighting a court battle is a trying process. "My God, it takes a long time. And it's expensive. But we don't believe what we're selling is obscene. It's freedom of expression."

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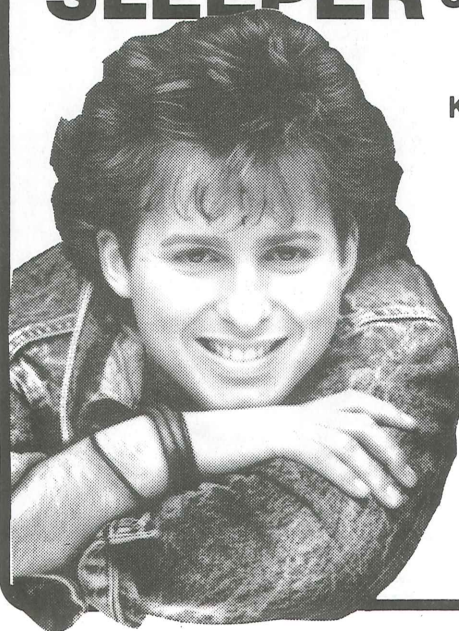

Q: What are the Big Country Awards?

A: An annual banquet, held on Sunday evening, at which time the award winners are revealed and awards presented. This evening event is not to be confused with the Variety Club Luncheon saluting the Big Country Awards, which will take place on the Friday prior to the actual Big Country Awards presentation.

Q: How are the nominees picked?

A: Nominations are based on chart action in RPM over the previous year. The ballots are mailed to all RPM subscribers. This gives us a very good mix of voters and makes it impossible for blocks and pockets to control the voting. The winners will be known only when the envelopes are opened onstage at the actual awards banquet.

Q: Will the awards feature musical performances?

A: No. The dinner will be followed by the awards ceremony at which time the presenters will open the envelopes and announce the winners. The whole event is designed to be an industry get together and it is a unique opportunity for the heavyweights in the industry to get to know one another and possibly do a deal. One night set aside for the industry. It's very unique.

Q: How many categories are there?

A: Exactly one dozen (12). The Big Country Awards are very coveted awards and are not given out in large numbers. They carry a great deal of prestige for the industry.

Q: Will there be meetings and conferences tied into this event?

A: No. We believe there is much going on now, and there's no further need for additional conferences.

Q: Isn't \$100 per person a little too expensive for a banquet?

A: Actually it isn't. That price is all inclusive. Once you pay the \$100, you have paid it all. There are no other charges: for parking, drinks, coat checking or dinner wine. Everything is included. The evening will be a very posh affair in a very elegant setting, designed to bring prestige to the Canadian country music industry. It's an event for the industry. Once a year we get together for a very special industry evening. Your payment will be confirmed to you by telephone and FAX and your table arrangements will be handed to you at the door. Cocktails are at 7 pm and dinner is at 8 pm. Dress elegantly but not black tie.

Q: Is it possible to reserve a table?

A: Yes. Tables of 8, 9 or 10 can be reserved ahead, if you get a group together and arrange that they all pay prior to 4 pm May 25. Mail all the payments in the same envelope. We must have all the names in advance.

Q: Will it be possible to pay at the door?

A: Definitely not! For an event of this kind, advance planning makes it impossible to arrange any additional meals. You must be confirmed at least four days prior to the banquet.

MCA's Big Bam Boo plan unique recording

Simon and Shark, group partners of MCA recording duo, are currently on two continents looking at potential studio locations. Simon will take three weeks to scout studios in England, Italy and France, while Shark, a Canadian, is in Toronto for five days to check out studios and confer with MCA President Ross Reynolds, prior to in-person discussions with studio people in New York and Los Angeles.

When Simon completes his search of studios in Europe, the pair will meet in New York with MCA's A&R representative Mark Dean. It's expected that recording will begin in April.

"We plan to split locations for recording on this album," says Shark. "We've been impressed with different studios in a couple of cities." He continues with, "This would work out well as Simon is British, I'm Canadian, and we do much of our work in the U.S."

As for videos, Big Bam Boo have, to date, filmed in the shipyards of London for Shooting From My Heart, the California desert for If You Could See Me Now, and the Nashville area for Fell Off A Mountain. As Shark explains, "I want to film our next Big Bam Boo video in Canada... but that will be a decision to be made with Simon and MCA's Mark Dean."

The initial signing of Big Bam Boo came about through an in-person audition for Dean in February of 1988 at Dean's London office. Simon and Shark continue to work closely with Dean on material for their second album. Shark is obviously impressed with MCA's strong interest. "Mark flew over to England (he is now based in New York),"

says Shark, "and has demo tapes of sixteen new tracks that we have finished for the new album."

The group's first album, *Fun, Faith And Fairplay*, was an impressive door-opener, bolstered by a first-time ever tour of Hard Rock Cafes in the U.S. They played dates in San Francisco, New Orleans, Chicago, Houston and Los Angeles. As well, they did a short Southwestern U.S. tour ending up in Los Angeles as the opening act for Jerry Lee Lewis at the Great Balls Of Fire movie premiere at the reputable Palace. It was this activity that landed them a 31-city tour of the U.S. with Todd Rundgren. "We had a big sound," Shark enthuses about the Rundgren tour, "with two acoustic guitars and a beat box, and we took everyone by surprise. It was a great experience and the Rundgren people were great to us." He concludes with, "We'll be back in the U.S. this year for more dates."

The group will be playing their first Canadian dates this fall in support of their second album release.

Wingwalker release for Temple/High Lonesome

Pat Temple and The High Lonesome Players, a Toronto "hillbilly jazz" band, has released a cassette titled *Stone Boat*, on the Wingwalker label. Temple, former frontman for Kingston, Ontario-based "psycho-folk" band Prufrock, is a veteran of the Toronto folk scene.

The High Lonesome Players is a grouping of veteran Canadian folk, R&B, classical, country and rockabilly musicians. Included in the lineup are Reno Jack (formerly of the Handsome Neds), John McMurchie, tenor sax and clarinet stalwart at Lulu's Roadhouse, and veteran country/pop songwriter/performer Willie P. Bennett.

High Lonesome was founded in 1988 and won the Kingston Buskers Festival in 1989. One Tree Island, an independent cassette, was released in early 1989.

Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles ship gold

'Cowbunga!' The original motion picture soundtrack to the eagerly anticipated film the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles shipped gold March 22 - a week before the film opens.

The TMNT soundtrack, consists of dance and dance-rap tracks, with the likes of M.C. Hammer, Johnny Kemp and Canadian duo Spunkadelic. The first single *Spin That Wheel* (Turtles Get Real) by HI TEK 3 features Ya Kid K, who is best known for her work with Technotronic, singing their dance hits *Pump Up The Jam* and *Get Up*.

This information and the soundtrack were delivered to RPM by one of the Ninja Turtles named Donatello and for those of you who are TMNT fans, the cassette comes in four different colours each one representing your favourite turtle. The colours match the Turtles distinctive headband and knee and elbow pads: Raphael (Red), Leonardo (Blue), Michaelangelo (Orange) and Donatello (Purple).

CBS to introduce video cassette single

CBS is set to launch Snapshots, a line of video cassette singles. The video will come in two formats: around 10 minutes and between 15 to 20 minutes in length.

According to CBS Video chief Don Lorusso, Snapshots will consist of "very, very current product, released almost immediately alongside the record." While Lorusso says he is "not absolutely sure" of the retail price, the longer form video should sell for under \$14.

The first titles in the series, to be released in April, are by Alice Cooper and Michael Bolton. Lorusso thinks the configuration has great potential. "We're seeing that the music video market as a whole is a very serious business. Snapshots is our answer to the cassette single. It's very current and priced to be an impulse item. There's no reason it shouldn't be successful."

CBS is also watching the potential of the new 12" laser disc, which is said to combine compact disc sound quality with the image resolution of high definition television. "It's definitely something we're interested in and keeping an eye on," concludes Lorusso.

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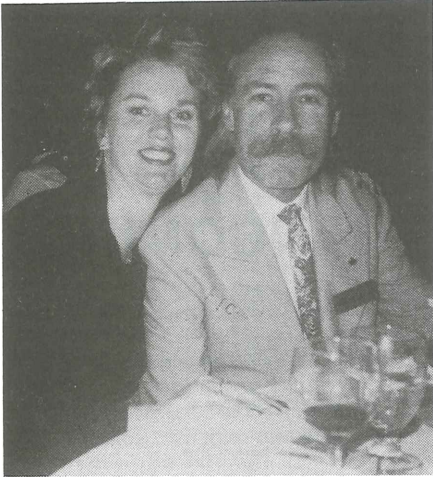

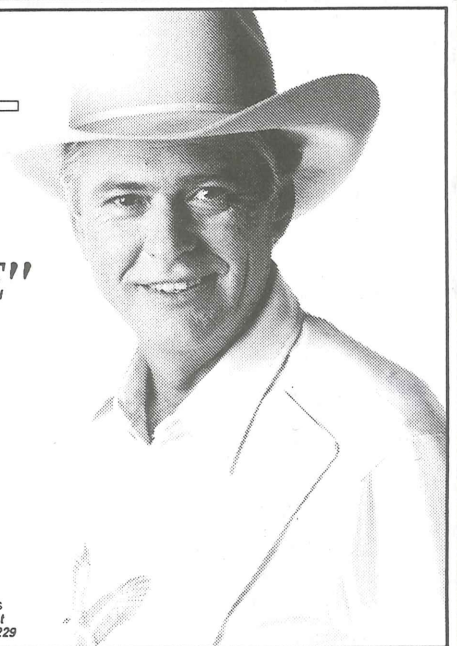

Willy . . . two guys we uncovered from Thunder Bay, Ontario. As Bruce Allen put it when they first got here, they sounded like "Homer and Jethro". Through hard work, CFOX managed to position this morning team as the underdogs which got the audience on their side. This brought them time to get it

together and now they are one of the most exciting, fresh, invigorating morning shows today. They are real people and don't take themselves too seriously - a big downfall of most radio announcers. In the last rating service Larry & Willy were No. 1 in 18-24, 25-34, 18-34, 18-49 and tied for No. 1 with Frosty Forrest, the all-time perennial leader in Vancouver from CKNW. They tied in the 18-54 bracket for audience share, that is with a 12 share each, however, L&W had a higher audience come and quarter hour average. Larry and Willy, 25 and 29 years old respectively, have many years of great broadcasting ahead of them.

CFOX has an open door policy. We encourage people to come by, artists to come by and perform live on the radio. We've been doing that for the last couple of years, something that rock 'n' roll radio got away from for some reason. Artists are always dropping by to say "Hi", and we've always got time for them. It's an open door policy; we're very honest and we're very fair with people. With those two elements we garner respect.

CFOX promotion philosophy - creative and fun. We don't try to do things in the conventional way. For instance, giving away Who tickets. As the presenting station, we found ourselves with all kinds of tickets, so we went with "What would you do for the Who contest?" Our winner actually set himself on fire and jumped off a building for 25 Who tickets.

The Fox is the first station in Canada to start the "homespun" advertising contest. Advertise The Fox and win ten thousand dollars. We ran this contest twice and I estimate that we derived over a million dollars in free advertising. Following the success of our contest, many other Canadian radio stations utilized this idea.

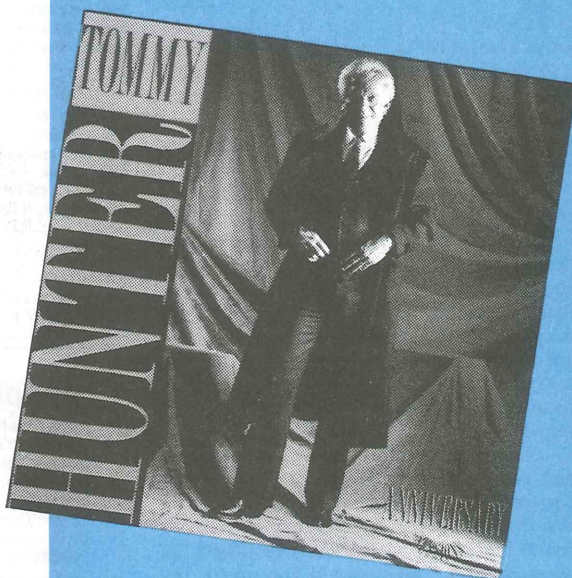
