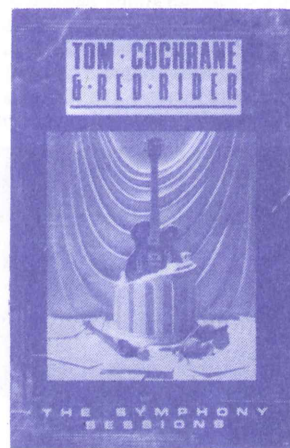

CBS turnaround obvious with chart happeners

It has been a long dry spell for CBS Records, but, over the past few weeks there has been an obvious turnaround as Columbia, Epic and associated CBS label acts have indicated hefty chart moves and solid sales.

On the Columbia side, Shan Kelley, Manager National Press & Publicity, reports that Loverboy is one of the top priorities. "Reaction to the new album has been very good," says Kelley, "We have almost all the AOR's that can play those kinds of tracks and we got those right off the bat . . . and Top 40's are filling in very quickly, starting on the West Coast where we have both the Vancouver Top 40's, and it built very quickly through to the opposite coast."

New to CBS is the Anthem label which provided more than a shot of adrenalin to the operation with the release of Rush's new album, *Presto*. The album scores a No. 21 first week on the RPM 100 this week, the first time a Canadian album has entered the chart at such a high number. The CBS strategy with the Rush release, paid off with excellent re-orders which followed a healthy Cancon shipment of close to 50,000. "We wanted to make sure the record was well represented in

the marketplace," says Kelley, "without filling up any warehouses."

As the Christmas season gets closer, Kelley is jubilant over the fact the acts that are happening represent both the old and the new. "The old veterans are still turning over healthy sales figures," boasts Kelley, "proving a lot of the prophets wrong. We've got the Stones, Billy Joel, Rush, Loverboy, Bob Dylan, Alice Cooper, Jeff Beck and even Bad English, a band made up of former members of The Babies, Journey and Santana. On top of that we have new acts that no one had heard of a year ago, like New Kids On The Block, Warrant, Martika, Bros,

Jive Bunny goes gold in first week of release

Jive Bunny And The Mastermixers have gone gold with their *Swing The Mood* single the first week of release, a rare accomplishment for a black vinyl single these days. "Retail reports across Canada are incredible," says Kim Cooke, WEA Music Canada's Vice President of National Promotion and Special Projects, continuing with, "Sam The Record Man in Toronto (Yonge Street) reported 60 requests for the 12" single in one day, while rack jobber, The Handleman Company, weighed in with an order for 30,000 cassette singles and Saturn Distributors debut *Swing The Mood* at No. 1 on its single chart.

The album is scheduled for release mid-December and, taking advance orders into consideration, Cooke is expecting to ship 75,000 of the album which has already sold more than one million copies in the UK. A second single, *That's What I Like*, is now being readied, and, says Cooke, "It promises to be another astounding success."

New Rush LP making blockbuster debut

Rush's newest LP, *Presto*, enters the market with extremely strong support and good tidings from Anthem's distributors Atlantic in the U.S. and CBS here in Canada. This marks the first project that either major has worked on Anthem's behalf since the national distribution deal was signed several months ago. Prior to this fall, Capitol Records and Polygram Records handled the product in Canada and the U.S., respectively.

There is clearly a strong wind of excitement over gaining this supergroup and other Canadian talents such as Gowan, The Spoons, and Clean Slate. CBS seems determined to breathe even more life into Rush's career, already one of the worlds most successful rock & roll bands.

If *Presto*'s debut in the U.S. is an indication, with an initial retail shipment of 800,000 units and lead track *Show Don't Tell* boasting the position of number 1 most added at AOR with 97 percent of major stations, they seem to be on their way to another remarkable success. *Presto* debuts at number 21 on RPM 100 Albums with a CHR mix and a retail cassette single to follow in mid-December. Myles' debut album hits triple platinum in Canada

Although signed to Atlantic Records in the U.S., Canadian Alannah Myles is having most of her success in Canada. Her self-titled debut for the label, released in the spring of this year, has now passed the 300,000 units sold mark, certifying for triple platinum.

The success of the album was fueled by the release of the first single, *Love Is*, followed by *Black Velvet*, and the success pattern continues with the release of a third single, *Still Got This Thing*. Also in the works is a video.

Myles has just completed a mini-tour with Kim Mitchell and was the subject of a *MuchMusic* Big Ticket Special with special guest Mavis Staples which was shot in Toronto on Halloween.

New Collins' album ships quarter million on release

The last Phil Collins album to be released, *No Jacket Required*, was on February 19, 1985 and that album has sold one million three hundred thousand copies in Canada alone. Now, Collins is back with a new album, *But Seriously*, and, says WEA's Vice President National Sales and Special Projects, Kim Cooke, "It's another tremendous album . . . another great record, side to side."

Advance orders for the album have been coming into WEA for several weeks, and on the day of release, more than quarter of a million copies were shipped. As Cooke modestly points out, "I don't like predicting million sellers . . . it smacks of vanity, and it's a very very difficult thing to do, to sell a million records, so let's just say that *But Seriously* is another tremendous Phil Collins record and we expect it to be extremely successful."

Cooke is also excited with the action on the first single, *Another Day In Paradise*. "It's exploding," he enthuses, "and we think it's a three-format number one record."

Onrot to Manager O'Keefe Centre

Martin Onrot has been appointed General Manager of Toronto's O'Keefe Centre. The appointment becomes effective January 1st, 1990. Mr. Onrot joined the O'Keefe Centre as Programming Manager in 1984. He was well suited for his new challenge, having built a highly respected career in the entertainment field as diverse as opening one of Toronto's first coffee houses, *The Fifth Peg*, that staged the big names of the coffee house circuit of that day including Bill Cosby, to heading up Infinity Records, a powerful American independent label that he used to launch the career of several Canadian recording acts.

Mr. Onrot was appointed Senior Manager Programming and Marketing for the O'Keefe Centre in 1987, a position he held until this new appointment.

Mr. Onrot succeeds Charles Cutts, who resigned his post of General Manager (Oct. 27/89). Mr. Cutts is credited with having been instrumental in the theatre's financial and administrative turnaround. He moves into a new career with the Bitov Corporation as Vice President and General Manager Airport Terminal Restaurants.

McClea Place celebrates Tenth Anniversary

McClea Place celebrates its Tenth Anniversary with the staff hosting a "celebratory get-together" on Nov. 24th. The past ten years have been an uphill battle and one that should go down in Canadian business history as one of dogged determination to succeed. Chances of success, let alone survival, for the studio were pretty slim when the historic building was purchased from RCA in 1979 by Bob Richards and Phil Sheridan.

The building first came into prominence in 1948. Built for CHUM Radio by the Fullpart Building Corporation, the facility originally housed one large studio, which was used for the live radio broadcasts of the time, and one small studio in the rear of the building. CHUM moved out in 1955 and the building was purchased by RCA to house their entire administrative and production staff, and two multitrack in-house studios.

RCA's operation was getting a little too large for the Mutual Street building and, in 1979, plans were made to move to a larger location. In fact, RCA wanted to get out of the studio business and when Richards learned of the proposed move, he got together with Sheridan who was a well-known jazz recording engineer at the time, and they raised the funds to purchase the studio.

However, 1979 was the beginning of the worst slump in the history of the recording industry, not a good time to take on a recording studio venture, nor become involved in the expense of renovating and

refitting each studio. Richards persisted and rode out the stormy years. He eventually gutted the existing Studio B, and, working with Los Angeles designer Jack Edwards, has, over the last ten years, created what is described as a "technical wonderland" for each of the rooms. In fact, Edwards' designs caught the attention of the CBC, resulting in him being commissioned to design all the new audio studios being built in the new Toronto CBC Centre.

Sheridan left the company in 1985 to concentrate on Innovation, his jazz label. Filling the void was Hayward Parrott as Chief Engineer. In view of Parrott's recognized talent in the rock and pop field, it wasn't long before he changed the perception of McClea Place as a jazz-oriented studio to one that now caters to a wide variety of musical needs. The clientele changed dramatically and the list of recording acts booking time included Alannah Myles, Frank Mills, Steve Winwood, Jeff Healey, The Friendly Giant, The Canadian Brass, Rush and Pink Floyd. As well, the three rooms are kept busy with broadcast advertising clients working on national radio/TV commercial campaigns. Film score producers and composers from Los Angeles have also found that McClea Place provides the sound and ambience necessary for their work.

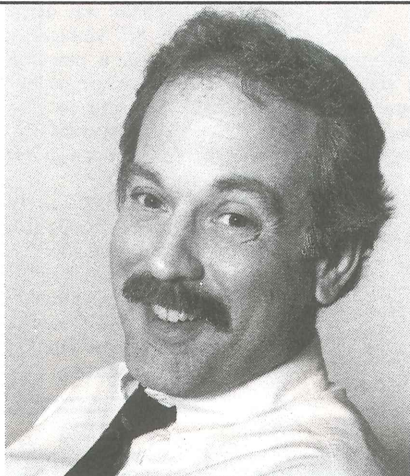
Interesting times? "McClea Place has had a few," says Studio Manager Jane Rowan. "Like the time a 60-piece marching band recorded a live album while donned in traditional kilts . . . or when we welcomed a

Japanese band to the studio for a month and discovered there was only one interpreter for all eleven of them." She continues with, "The nod for most interesting radio jingle would have to go to the client who recorded a Rubbermaid commercial using the company's products to achieve the drum and percussion tracks . . . plastic garbage cans have never sounded so good . . . and the quickest session ever was engineered by Hayward who actually finished a commercial session five minutes before it was even due to have started." Rowan continues with, "and with the changing times, technical questions are becoming more interesting . . . a few clients have called to ask if they can FAX us their 'test tones' (audio signals located at the beginning of their tape, needed to properly align the recorder before the session)," concluding with "Maybe in another few years."

After ten years, McClea Place can lay claim to being one of Canada's leading audio recording facilities. The building now features three state-of-the-art recording studios and a digital editing and CD pre-mastering suite. Peter Norman, the studio's Chief Mastering Engineers oversees what he boasts as "the best disc-mastering operation in the country."

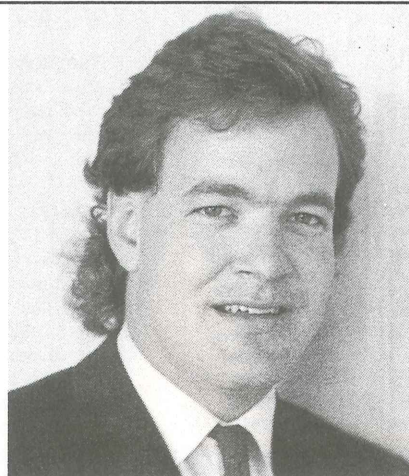

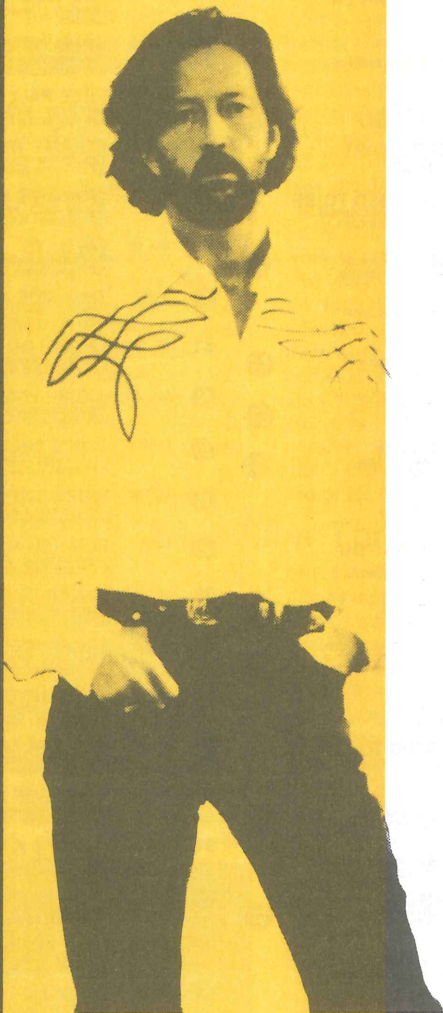

I'll have a hot Canadian band . . . with The Works

A&M recording artists The Works are currently on release with their debut album entitled *From Out Of Nowhere*. The first single *Dancing On A Wing* is charting nationally. "They're not only charting it, there playing it regularly and there's a difference, we're just happy to know that people are finding out who we are and what we're all about," comments the band's guitar player Jim Huff.

The band consists of Huff, Brian Malone (lead vocals) and Stuart Zaltz (keyboards). "Originally the three of us were signed to a publishing deal with Irving Almo, to be staff writers for A&M and we just progressed from there," asserts Huff.

"Someone from A&M sent producer Tom Allom (known for his work with Def Leppard, Judas Priest and Loverboy) some of our material and he liked it, so he came up to Toronto from Miami to hear us play in a rehearsal hall. He liked us and agreed to produce our album."

Huff believes that Allom was a natural for the job because, as he explains, "very little of our original demos changed. We got a chance to make our own record. A lot of bands don't have that opportunity with their first album. Allom is an incredible motivator and he knows how to get things on tape. That, and his ability to work within our musical tastes, made it that much easier to create something that would represent the band."

The studio of choice for Allom was

Miami's Criteria Studio (where notables like Aretha Franklin, Aerosmith, Eric Clapton and The Eagles have recorded in the past). After six weeks of pre-production and three new songs, written to add to the roster, the project was starting to take shape. "The demos were done in my home studio and when we went down to Miami to record, we just flew my studio down there so we could do a lot of the work out of Criteria. As a result the album was recorded in a little over five months," boasts Huff.

Malone, Huff and Zaltz are credited with co-writing this album and when approached on the subject of the difficulty of having three co-writers Huff explains, "The three of us are all pretty good songwriters individually, but I'm sure that collectively it just made the tracks that much stronger. One of us would come up with an idea, and we'd put it across to the others, but we'd never get past the 16th bar without somebody saying 'Hey, I know something that would work really well here.' We'd try it and usually it worked out for the better."

Huff feels the strength of the band lies in the fact that himself and Malone were not schooled musicians. Their experience was their work with Mannequin, their first band, and as Huff points out, they were really "feel guys." Whereas Zaltz, "Who is a good feel guy, is also a schooled musician, considering he came to jam with the band and personalities, not just voices on the radio. He does however, admit to being rusty

when it comes to playing live, "Considering, I haven't performed live since 1985," he play with us a couple of times and he just became a permanent member."

Local Toronto dates are pencilled in for the next few weeks to give the band a little exposure, and Huff reveals that the band is actually looking forward to getting out and making a name for themselves as musicians and personalities not just voices on the radio. However, he does admit to being a little rusty when it comes to playing live "Considering, I haven't performed live since 1985," he explains. "Sure . . . it might take a little getting used to . . . but I think it's like riding a bike, once you learn, you never forget. Although we had studio musicians playing on the album, we've got these great local guys to play our live dates. It's interesting because now we feel more like a band." The new additions for the dates are bassist Tim Harrington and drummer Scott Lucas.

Along with live dates, Huff comments that video is an excellent way to gain exposure. A video for *Dancing On A Wing* was released recently and he feels if people get to see the band and know who they are, they can present themselves as personalities through videos and that can only help the album along.

It may have taken a while to get this album together, but if the response from radio and retail is any indication, this release will surely be worth the effort. With A&M continuing their solid backing, as well as the strength of the album itself, 1990 could be a landmark year for Canadian talent.

WEA touting new Stewart boxed set

Retailers are scrambling for the Rod Stewart Storyteller boxed set. Stewart's complete anthology: 1964-1990, contains 65 selections which include virtually every hit and some non-hits from this rock superstar.

As well, there are two new songs, Tom Waits' penning of *Downtown Train*, released as a single and the Isley Brothers classic *This Old Heart Of Mine* (performed with special guest Ronald Isley).

The boxed set, available on four compact discs or four cassettes also includes a 24-page illustrated booklet containing Stewart's personal recollections of each song.

Paparazzi - a new \$4 million Toronto club

Paparazzi, a new \$4 million restaurant/nightclub complex, located in Richmond Hill, Ontario, to service the greater Toronto area, was officially opened (Nov. 10). The opening was a glittering affair with 4,500 invited guests devouring huge quantities of food, specially prepared by Executive Chef Roland Richter.

On hand for the opening were local, provincial and federal government representatives, and an impressive lineup of showbiz personalities, all "limo'd in" for the

black-tie affair, and all dutifully photographed by paparazzi James Elliott.

Of major interest is the 5,000 square foot restaurant that can be transformed, at the flick of a switch, into an 800 capacity, 10,000 square foot nightclub when giant, motorized walls ascend above the ceiling. Suspended above the dance floor is a giant, computer-controlled video display, described as "Canada's first moving videowall." The video display is comprised of sixteen high-resolution monitors connected to an Imtech digital process. The processor splits up a video image onto the screens, creating one big picture. The rig, which weighs approximately two tons, can be lowered from twenty feet above the floor, tilt and swivel to almost vertical, while keeping the video picture correct with a Fairlight Entertainer video synthesizer. The sound, light, video and laser system was designed by John Kirkpatrick with artistic assistance from Tony Deuters.

The sound is provided by Canada's first full scale EV DeltaMax club sound system, boasting a power base of over 8,000 watts provided by a QSC Series Three.

Also getting a Canadian debut at the club are gyro lights and colour sweeps from Laser Systems, the Jem heavy fog unit and Program Systems' Scorpion lighting effects, all topped off with a five watt triple scanning laser system that projects graphics and beams throughout the entire club from two sources.

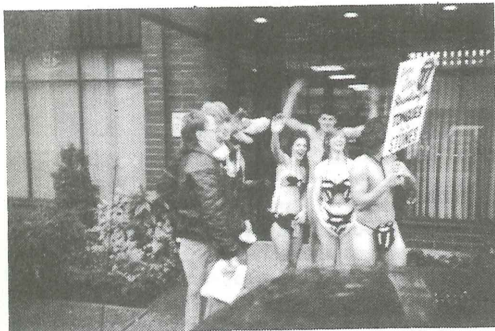

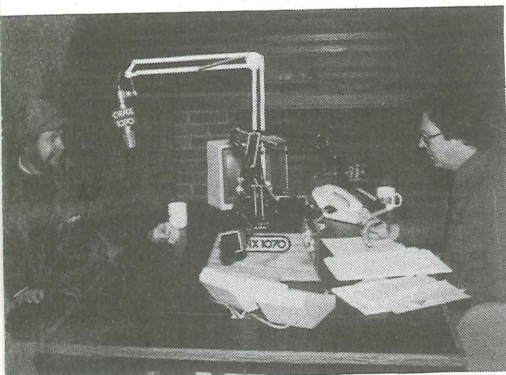

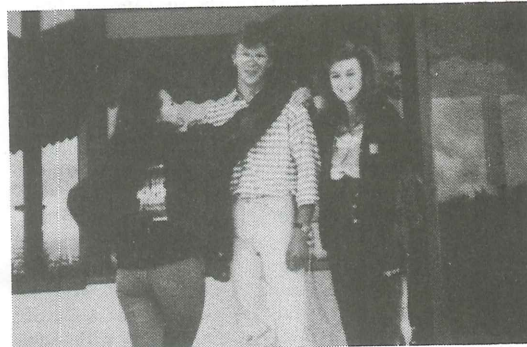

THE PSYCHEDELIC FURS - Pop
Book Of Days - Columbia - FC-45412-H
What radio currently enamoured of synthetic dance music and rock ballads, it does not seem likely that the band will be receiving a ton of airplay for this strong effort. This machine runs on guitar power and the beast with six strings meets a heavily layered approach here, often more noisy than melodic, yet sure to find a warm reception at campus and alternative outlets. The track most likely to suit commercial programmers is "House," which molds the consistent sound of the album into a more accessible and straight-ahead shape, as well as "Torch," which places the emphasis on acoustic guitar. Fans will definitely be pleased to hear that the group has not had their brief chart successes direct them toward a slicker style, rather employing the freedom such success brings to its fullest. ROY ORBISON AND FRIENDS - Pop
A Black And White Night Live Virgin - VL-2601-W
All that can be said about the incredible friends that turned out to play on this particular night is "WOW!" Any album that features T-Bone Burnett, Alex Acuna, Elvis Costello, Bruce Springsteen, Tom Waits, Jackson Browne, K.D. Lang, Bonnie Raitt and Jennifer Warnes together will be of interest to anyone remotely interested in popular music. Of course, no amount of big named talent could overshadow Orbison's own contribution: his classic guitar, trademark falsetto and an awe-inspiring string of hits. Only The Lonely, Crying, Running Scared, Blue Bayou, Ooby Dooby, It's Over and a version of Pretty Woman, that clocks in at over six minutes in length, are representative of the sixteen cuts included. A video for the last of these received some airplay earlier in 1989. The sound quality is truly amazing for a live recording and audience response is tastefully mixed.

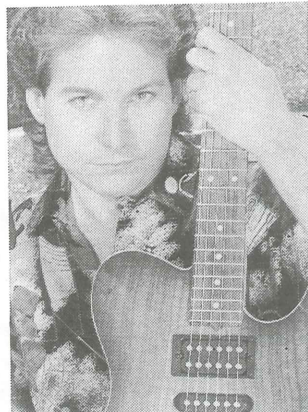

VOIVOD - Rock
Nothingface Mechanic - MCAC-6326-J
You won't be seeing this Montreal band on Video Hits. Mixing the heaviness and speed of thrash with the odd time signatures and far out lyrics of progressive rock, Voivod delivers an interesting, if not widely accessible, package that will please followers and attract new listeners. Astronomie Domine, written by founding Pink Floyd member Syd Barrett, the most subdued of the tracks, nevertheless fits well with the originals, nicely complementing the band's own weirdness. Perhaps too heavy for some jingly jangly Canadian campus stations, this project will be welcomed by metal spotlight programmers. (Cassette reviewed) - CM

WILLIAM ELLWOOD - New Age
Vista - Narada - NXD-61024-J
Don't be frightened by the tag of New Age. Narada has a handle on the acoustic instrumental market, and what is accomplished here with Hamilton keyboardist Ellwood is yet another adventure into acoustic intimacy. This is Ellwood's third album for Narada. His first two, for the most part, were solo compositions for guitar. He broadens out with this release which was produced by Billy Oskay of the group Nightnoise, which should supply a hint of what is here. Great programming material for the easy listening A/C format. Key are A Path With Heart Beside The Night, Lonestar and a beautiful reworking of Simon & Garfunkel's classic of 1966, Scarborough Fair/Canticle. Guesting on this Cancon package are keyboardist Robert O'Hearn, brother of Patrick who plays with Quarterflash, keyboardist George Mitchell, who performs with Diana Ross and veteran session percussionists Caton Lyles

and Gregg Williams. Producer Oskay adds extra colour with fiddle inserts. Cancon. Based in Milwaukee, the Narada label is distributed in Canada by MCA. (CD reviewed) - WG

THE KINKS - Pop
UK Jive - MCA - MCA-6337-J
This thoroughly disappointing efforts suggests Ray Davies is trying to write songs that sound like they belong in the '80s rather than really being in touch with today's trends. The most noteworthy tracks hark back stylistically to the '60s: War Is Over, the album's high point, highly reminiscent of earlier British Invasion material; and Loony Balloons, which is more of a bad flashback with its acid poet lyrics. The title track is upbeat and danceable, but lacks enough substance to make it a hit. - CM



PAT KELLEY - Jazz
High Heels - Denon - CY-73764
Kelley is primarily known as a session musician in the Hollywood area, although he has released a previous album. With this CD only release,

produced by Jeffrey Weber at Hollywood's Ocean Way Studios, Kelley displays a unique talent made jazz-fusion package so remarkable, the Denon people are using it to demo CD hardware. Most of music was written by Kelley, although he does get an assist on Jam Box from Jeff Boydston and Monte Byrd on Continuum and from both on Senor Si, three key tracks. Also key is Be Here With Me Tonight, where Kelley has a go at vocals, and, not bad. That's Jim Cox on keyboards. Guest appearances by Gary Herbig (saxophone), John Pattitucci (bass), David Benoit (keyboards) and Eric Marienthal (saxophone). The stuff that's in demand for A/C easy listening. (CD reviewed) - WG

Christmas With The "Phil" Attic - CAT-1268-W

There can't be enough of this type of recording available for the upcoming holiday season, particularly with the Cancon advantage. With this James Stroud production, Charlie Daniels lays it right down the middle with as much excitement in the grooves as he had with Homesick Heroes and again with the energized single, The Devil Went Down To Georgia. He is already charting with the title track, released as a single. The lyrics on this single are the stuff hit singles are made of. He's appealing to that mass audience he knows very well. Also key are Mister DJ, Was It 26, and (What This World Needs Is) A Few More Rednecks. With the proper airing, it might be safe to say, Charlie Daniels is back. - WG

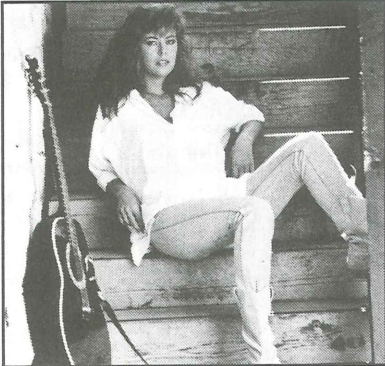

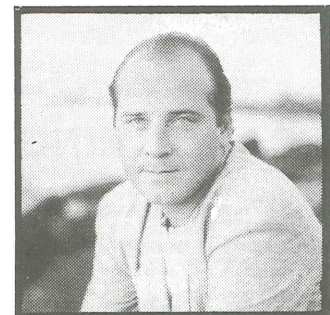
