Partisan and MCA merge in joint publishing venture

It has been announced that Canadian company Partisan Music Productions, owned by veteran music publisher Frank Davies, and MCA Music Publishing have completed a deal which will make MCA part-owner of all of Partisan's existing catalogues and those of Partisan's newly-acquired TMP (The Music Publisher). Future compositions will be owned by Joint Venture, a newly formed company created between Partisan and MCA Canada Ltd. The agreement went into effect January 1, 1991, and worldwide administration of the joint venture will be

handled by MCA's New York office.

The deal will allow Davies to seek out and finance the acquisition of music publishing rights on an ownership, administrative and sub-publishing basis.

Some of the assets that are involved in the merger are TMP's Jonico Music catalogues, including the successful Sesame Street copyright; Zaymin/Hit List, the U.S. publisher who has Celine Dion's Where Does My Heart Beat Now; Australian publishing company MMA, owned by Chris Murphy of INXS. Partisan assets include the television music of Canada's largest movie company, Alliance Communica-

tions Corp.; and copyrights by Canadian artists A Foot In Coldwater, The King Biscuit Boy and Tom Cochrane. Through Partisan, Frank Davies also manages songwriters Eddie Schwartz and David Tyson.

Partisan acquired The Music Publisher in a separate agreement secured on January 15, 1991 from Canada Publishing Corporation, obtaining all of TMP's assets as well as use of the TMP trademark. TMP was founded in 1986 by Frank Davies and Ron Besse, Chairman of the Canada Publishing Corporation, one of the country's leading book publishers.

MCA Canada beefs up publicity department

Cori Ferguson has been appointed to the newly-created position of Publicity Coordinator for MCA Records Canada, effective Feb. 25th. Ferguson will coordinate the preparing and servicing of publicity materials such as bios, photos and press releases to the media. She will also be involved in non-tour artist interview schedules and video duplication. Ferguson will report directly to Dave Watt, Director of Press & Publicity/Artist Relations.

Ferguson joins MCA from Sam The Record Man's flagship store on Yonge Street in Toronto where she was involved in buying. Prior to that she was Editor-In-Chief of The Cord Weekly (Wilfred Laurier University paper) and has gained much experience as a freelance writer for various publications.

As Watt points out, "The increased product flow with the addition of Geffen, DGC and GRP Records to MCA, necessitated the creation of this new position." As a result the publicity department will undergo some internal changes. Andrea Orlcik, Assistant Manager of Press & Publicity, will primarily be involved with tour publicity and video promotion, Kathie Gibbings, Publicity Assistant/Receptionist, will handle servicing of the country press as well as assisting in other areas, plus Ferguson's duties as outlined above.

Aquarius problems void Hart Juno nomination

"Internal misunderstanding" is being blamed for what should have been a shoo-in Juno nomination for Male Vocalist Corey Hart this year. The Aquarius recording artist scored impressive radio play with his releases this year, with his Bang! album one of the Cancon leaders on the RPM 100. The album entered the national chart at No. 28 (April 7, 1990) and enjoyed several weeks of charting. A single from the album, A Little Love, garnered much CHR action and also made impressive moves up the national chart. Consequently the album sold more than 70,000 units which would have qualified Hart for a Juno nomination in at least one category.

"I was discouraged and I felt bad for Corey when I realized we had missed out on a sure nomination," explains Aquarius president Keith Brown, who concludes with, "It was a mistake and it's no reflection on how we feel about Corey or the Juno Awards."

Wright appointed to BMG artist marketing post

Carol Wright, formerly Director of Marketing and Promotion at Island Records Canada has been appointed Director of Artist Marketing at BMG Canada. The announcement was made by Bob Jamieson, President and General Manager of BMG Music Canada.

Wright will direct all marketing activities at a national level and will take up her new post beginning March 18.


Of her appointment Wright says that she is "thrilled to work with the BMG team, I look forward to the challenges this opportunity brings."

Dion to Toronto's Winter Garden Theatre

Celine Dion has been firmed for Toronto's Winter Garden Theatre (March 15). She is currently enjoying top of the A/C chart action in both Canada and the U.S with Where Does My Heart Beat Now the third release from her Unison album. The album has now surpassed the double platinum mark in Canada.

Dion will also be performing at this year's Juno Awards (March 3) where she has been nominated in four categories (RPM Feb. 16/91): Female Vocalist, Album, Dance and Producer (David Foster). The 21-year old Columbia recording artist will also be playing Vancouver's Orpheum (5), the Jubilee in Edmonton (6), Calgary's Performing Arts Centre (9), and the Walker Auditorium in Winnipeg, prior to her Toronto date.

Added performances extend Junos by half hour

CARAS has announced that the CBC telecast has been extended to two and a half hours instead of the usual two hours. The extension was necessary to accommodate the increased number of artists available to perform on the show.

The Northern Pikes, Michelle Wright and Prairie Oyster are additional artists who have been pencilled in to make appearances on the show, joining an already stellar line up of Canadian talent featuring Alias, Celine Dion, Colin James and Blue Rodeo among others.

Lynne Harvey, producer of the Junos says that "With such a wealth of performance opportunities available, we decided to capitalize on that and extend the show to make room for even more talent."

Hosted by Paul Shaffer, the Junos will be telecast live from Vancouver on March 3, on the CBC.

I don't understand it . . . ! I think that after a long time in the industry, your instincts begin to sharpen. This Wednesday past, while having lunch, I felt that I would get this kind of a note today and guess what! (EC: *You did . . . !*) and it was one of those Stop The Presses kind of notes. Here it is in its entirety: "Due to personal considerations, I have decided against moving to Discus in Montreal and have asked Mr. Kroum Pindoff to allow me to rescind my prior resignation and remain at Pindoff Record Sales and Music World. Mr. Pindoff has graciously accepted. (signed) Jerry Wipf." Enough said? (EC: *Enough said . . . !*)

Bruce Allen takes on CARAS . . . ! It has been reported that west coaster Bruce Allen is taking issue with CARAS and its choice of talent that will appear on the Vancouver version of the Junos. Allen is asking questions about who the performers are and indicating

that if the Junos and CBC don't believe in Canadian performers, "why should the Canadian people?" He favours "giving those who have been nominated and who deserve to be honoured a fair chance to show Canada, in performance, how good they are and how far they've come. Isn't that what the Junos are all about?" The Junos are bringing in foreign rap artist M.C. Hammer at a reported cost of \$40,000 and Allen makes a very appropriate remark: "If our industry feels the show needs a heavy hitter to bring in the ratings, they should look to themselves first and ask why? If they don't think Paul Janz is important enough to warrant a performance, why should the Canadian people? Nobody is going to believe these people are important unless CARAS, the music industry and the CBC deem them to be important." This very nationalistic feeling came to light when Allen spoke at RPM's 25th Anniversary Banquet. In the past, Allen has been an ardent supporter of the Junos and received the Walt Grealis Achievement Award from CARAS (EC: *On Camera . . . !*) in 1987 and served on the CARAS board for a number of years. (EC: *Well respected in the industry and possibly one of the Top Ten managers in Canada . . . !*)

For The Record . . . ! No matter what you hear elsewhere, the Junos were televised for the first time in March of 1975 at the Queen Elizabeth Theatre at Toronto's Exhibition Place with Paul Anka as host. (EC: *RPM is not just another pretty face!*) That was a year we lost two of the Juno presentation replicas. One vanished and was last seen on a private jet and the other ended up in pieces when it was dropped by a clumsy CBC person. The retail value of those two pieces of history would be in the thousands . . . today!

Cancon artists at sea . . . ! All the artists coming back from their stint on the Regent Holiday's Pegasus are very complimentary of the food and service. A recent article in one of the dailies said that this ship scored very low in the U.S. sanitary inspection. To the artists going aboard, I can tell you that the QEII, the Norway and many of the big ships don't always pass this very rigid inspection. But recently, the Pegasus got a score of 86 which is a pass . . . and I can assure you that Captain Yiannis Papadopoulos, who I know from the Atlas, will take this ship right to the top of the list. (EC: *May I recommend the week when Liona Boyd will be aboard . . . ?*)

Terry Trojek retires . . . ? I couldn't believe it. After twenty years in the business, more than seven with Taylor Record Sales, almost three at WEA and the last ten with Saturn, Terry has decided to pack it in. He has gained a very respectable reputation over the years, and he was one of the true "hit pickers" in this country (EC: *And that's how he will be remembered . . . !*) We'll miss him. Terry is moving to Amaprior and isn't it just like him to leave without any fanfare.

How come Roch Voisine never gets a Juno nod? Roch has to be the most successful recording artist in this country. I mentioned last year how visible he was at MIDEM and Attic's Al Mair confirms that Roch "was visible all over

Cannes" in the form of giant four colour posters. In fact, he has sold over 2,000,000 albums in France, which makes him a big artist, wouldn't you say? He has sold a lot of records in this country as well. I've seen the guy perform and if the Juno people are looking for a dynamic performer, who happens to be Canadian, they should take a look at this New Brunswicker. He's a class act in both English and French. (EC: *You said that last year . . . !*)

Hey! Hey! HMV . . . ! Talk about retail PR, HMV's Paul Alofs is on a roll. Fresh from his industry ear & eye turning Don't Give Up Your Day Job awards, he is now opening his head office to promote a couple of new releases. Paul is laying on a couple of tables loaded with food and drink "and lots of surprises," he says for the launch of Glass Tiger's Simple Mission and Roxette's Joyride. The date is Feb. 26 at 5 pm. (EC: *Is that an open invitation . . . ?*)

Tribute to Catherine . . . ! If the CARAS people wanted to pay tribute to Leonard Cohen on a Canadian teevee show, they should have included Catherine McKinnon who does one Cohen composition like no one else ever has! (EC: *Look into it . . . !*)

Promotion is so basic and so easy. This past week, CHUM-FM's Roger Ashby included me once again on his "who's celebrating a birthday today." I'm not really surprised by the number of industry people who listen to Roger, because after all these years, the letters and faxes of congratulations and the nice gifts I receive is testament to his popularity. MCA's promotion guy Rick Wharton had a neat birthday cake tucked under his arm for me, complete with a Bart Simpson candle. It's the little things that count. Also visiting this week were The Debenham Brothers, complete with a box of muffins. RPM's offices are so exciting I hate to go to lunch, I might miss something. 

Voisine's Double solidifies success in Europe, Quebec

Although English Canadians may feel as though Roch Voisine came from nowhere and immediately made a dent in the international market with his smash hit, *Helene*, the voyage for this Star Records recording artist was not quite so cut and dried.

"I feel very lucky," says Voisine of his success. "But it was a lot of work, a lot of hard work."

After almost a year and a half of solid touring and writing, Voisine headed back into the studio last summer to record *Double*, a double bilingual album which is available in non-francophone countries as a single English album, which in under five months has already sold in excess of 300,000 units in France alone, and has shipped 20,000 units in Canada. Worldwide, *Double* has sold close to 500,000.

The first single, *A Fishing Day*, is also enjoying success on national charts, and figures on all four of RPM's charts, establishing it as a potent crossover success.

Voisine grew up in New Brunswick, where although his primary passion was hockey, he always kept his music close at hand since getting his first guitar at the age of 14.

"I was a shy kind of kid, I wouldn't talk about things like other people would, so I wrote them down as songs," he explains.

An injury ruled out a hockey career, and soon afterwards Voisine's manager Paul Vincent, invited him to come to Montreal to try his hand at performing.

Vincent secured various successful television spots for Voisine and shortly thereafter

Capitol targets all formats for McLauchlan release

Capitol Records has pulled all stops in the promotion of Murray McLauchlan's latest album, *The Modern Age*. This is McLauchlan's 17th album and it sees him re-united with co-producer Ken Friesen (Hard Rock Town, *On The Boulevard*).

Capitol's Ralph Alfonso stresses that McLauchlan's release "is not a country album." The label is working all three radio formats (AOR, CHR, A/C). Country programmers however, have moved quickly on the first single, a cassette single of the title track. Impressive chart and playlist action has moved the track up the RPM Country 100 where this week it jumps to No. 84 with a bullet.

Alfonso also points out that McLauchlan plays all the guitars on *The Modern Age*, "something he's never done before," says Alfonso, "revealing himself as a great underrated player in the process."

A video of *The Modern Age*, directed by award-winner John Lloyd (Holly Cole, *Mary Margaret O'Hara*) "is a visual stunner," says Alfonso, "and by placing Murray in a live band setting, puts him in the proper context for the music."

McLauchlan will be mounting a cross-country tour of Canada for April and May.

Voisine was offered a weekly series called *Top Jeunesse*, filmed in Montreal and described by Voisine as "a French version of *American Bandstand*." The show remained on the air for a year and a half during which time Voisine signed with Star Records run by Andre DiCesare, who also helped with the production of the Voisine albums. Star Records is distributed by another Quebec-based company, Select Distribution.

After the record deal was in place, Voisine came out with the album *Helene* in June of 1989 and watched the single soar to the top of international charts. With the album's success it was apparent that Voisine was going to have to leave *Top Jeunesse*, there just weren't enough hours in the day for a full-time recording career and weekly television show.

Voisine spent the next year and a half in Europe, touring and writing. Currently that first album is still selling, and is closing in on the 1.5 million mark for worldwide units sold. Voisine kept on working the album until his return to the studio in the summer of 1990 when he recorded *Double*.

As to whether Voisine feels that the *Double* material is different from that of *Helene*, Voisine says that he hopes it is: "Things have changed. I have grown older and I see things differently. I think this album has more of a classical feel to it, there is a lot of strings in many of the songs and hopefully it will appeal to a wider audience."

Hoskins' debut sports innovative CD cover

True North Records has tapped the creative field for "new ways to bring the fun back to album graphics," says the label's Jehanne Languedoc. She goes on to point out that "In the main however, there continues a mundane sameness, given the small surface of the CD booklet."

True North harnessed the creative talent of well known album designer Bart Schoales and together they have come up with what Languedoc tags "a unique" new CD package for Gregory Hoskins and the Stickpeople's debut release *Moon Come Up*.

Languedoc explains that the cover features Hoskins and the band standing in front of a full moon. The photo was done at Digital Magic House incorporating a front projection special effects system.

The photo was then placed on the front of the booklet with the moon, which is about the size of a loonie, die-cut out of the booklet and then printed on the CD disc itself. "When the booklet and the CD are placed back into the jewel box," says Languedoc, "the effect is that of a 3-D moon. You can then, by turning the CD disc, create your own version of the cover by simply moving the moon. Presto!" she concludes, "You can now have a quarter, half or full moon."

Moon Come Up, Hoskins' first album was released Feb. 25.

The *Double* tour will be kicking off at the Bercy in Paris on March 26, Voisine's birthday. It is a coincidence that has the singer a little nervous.

"We didn't plan it that way, but it was the only date we could get. I don't know what they've got planned," he laughs.

The tour will include 11 musicians and in Paris there will be a thirty piece string section as well. After the entourage finishes touring the francophone European territories it returns home for Canadian dates in the fall of 1991. All dates will be between 6,000 and 17,000 spectators.

Voisine is enthusiastic about the upcoming tour, stating that he wants to give people "more than a show."

Roch Voisine is settling in to his relatively new whirlwind schedule these days. He acknowledges that at first things "were a little rough," but that now he is "Getting into the pace of things, and really enjoying it."

T for timing . . . Already a big hit in the U.S., Timmy T's One More Try is quickly becoming one here. It is the biggest mover this week, up 35 spots to No. 63.

Who? Some unusual names top the entries this week. The five highest entries come from Londonbeat, The Rembrands, Murray McLaughlan, The Fixx, and Tracie Spencer. Londonbeat, The Rembrands, and Spencer have never had a Top ten hit in Canada, The Fixx had one in 1983, and Murray McLaughlan's last Top ten hit was in 1974.

Remember way back when . . . It was October of last year when Celine Dion's Where Does My Heart Beat Now entered the Hit Tracks chart. CHR was quick to react, then AC picked up on it, then the U.S. picked up on it. All of this has helped the song stay on the chart for 20 weeks. The last song to stay on the chart longer was Elton John's Sacrifice, which stayed on for 21 weeks ending in April of last year.

Geography quiz. The four other acts with a U.S. city in the name to have hit No. 1 are: Chicago, Boston, John Denver, and The Brooklyn Bridge.
