Jackson's release to hit retail November 25

Michael Jackson's new Epic album, *Dangerous*, the follow-up to the eight-times platinum *Bad*, will be available at retail outlets around the world on November 25. From all indications, it would appear this long-awaited release will be supported by an unprecedented advertising and marketing campaign.

Black Or White, the first single taken from the album, features Guns N' Roses' guitarist Slash. The song was penned by Jackson, who was credited with writing or co-writing 13 of the 14 tracks. The single was expected to be aired simultaneously via Broadcast News' SNAP on November 6th, but was leaked in New York during the weekend (Nov. 2), resulting in the official service to radio upped one day (5). Don Oates, Senior Vice President, Sony Music Canada explains, "the initial response to the single is very positive, the retailers who have already ordered copies of the album, feel more comfortable with the numbers now that they have heard the single."

Black Or White will be supported by a video that will premiere on November 14 at approximately 8:25 pm, immediately following the Simpsons, on Global TV in Canada. John Landis, who directed the film *An American Werewolf In London*, and directed Jackson's *Thriller* video, took on similar chores for the new 11-minute short film. It is not known at time of writing whether Slash appears in the video, but it has been revealed that it does include appearances from Bart Simpson, Macaulay Culkin (*Home Alone*) and George Wendt (*Cheers*).

In addition to the elaborate video release, there is also a 30 second animated television spot which was directed by David Lynch. The

spot is currently running in 200 Cineplex-Odeon theatres across Canada and is expected to be aired on television 10 days prior to the release of the album.

Dangerous, produced by Jackson and his long-time engineer Bruce Swedien, will be available on cassette, CD and as a two-record set. Oates explains, "Obviously we're not going to release the CD and cassette simultaneously with the vinyl on the 25th, we're going to wait and see what the demand for vinyl will be at retail, and then go ahead. However, *Dangerous* will definitely be available on vinyl as a 2-record set to accommodate record collectors." Also available at retail will be a specially packaged, limited edition 9" x 9" pop-up CD. An estimated 10,000 copies will be available in Canada.

There are no predictions for sales as yet, but the out-of-the-box numbers have been growing increasingly since the single shipped to radio. Taking into consideration the economy, the initial shipment was purposely held down to a conservative 200,000. However, with the added excitement over the airing of the single and the confidence from the retailers, it's expected this figure will be closer to the 300,000 mark. Oates wasn't ready to supply official figures, leaving it at "we'll be shipping multi-platinum."

Certifications up almost 50 percent over last year

What could be an indicator of the recording industry recovering from the recession are the latest statistics from the Canadian Recording Industry Association (CRIA), revealing an increase of almost 50 percent over last October. There were 57 certifications, including one diamond, for October '91, up from 30 last October. It was also encouraging to see the certifications surpass last month's 41.

Leading the pack with a diamond award was George Michael's *Faith* album. The album entered the RPM 100 at No. 62 on Nov. 28, 1987 and topped the chart on Jan. 23, 1988, continuing a run of 70 weeks through April 17, 1989. Sony also certified the album for nine times platinum and Michael's *Listen Without Prejudice Volume I* as double platinum.

Certifying as triple platinum were R.E.M. (*Out Of Time*) and Metallica's self-titled album. Both albums were also certified as double, solo platinum and gold. Also certified as double platinum were *Crash Test Dummies* (*The Ghosts That Haunt Me*), Dire Straits (*On Every Street*) and Natalie Cole (*Unforgettable*).

Solo platinum certifications were made for Skid Row (*Slave To The Grind*), Van Halen (*For Unlawful Carnal Knowledge*), Lenny Kravitz (*Mama Said*), Cher (*Love Hurts*), John Mellencamp (*Whenever We Wanted*), The KLF (*The White Room*), Clint Black (*Put Yourself In My Shoes*), Tom Cochrane (*Mad Mad World*), The Original Broadway Cast of *Les Misérables*, Ricky Van Shelton (*Wild-Eyed Dream*), Bob Seger (*The Fire Inside*), Hammer (*Too Legit To Quit*), and Amy Grant (*Heart In Motion*).

Skid Row, Van Halen, Cher, John Mellencamp, The KLF, Tom Cochrane, Ricky Van Shelton and Hammer also certified for gold

Jackson is slated to appear on the MTV Tenth Anniversary Special on November 10. Only four acts have been confirmed for the show to date, George Michael, Madonna, Aerosmith and Jackson.

Charitable contributions honour Barney Samuels

The name Barnett "Barney" Jule Samuels will long be remembered in the Canadian music industry. Mr. Samuels, who passed away in Toronto on Oct. 19, was the founder and Chairman of the Board of the Winnipeg-based National Record Distributors Ltd. and Music City Stores.

Born and raised in Winnipeg, Mr. Samuels cultured many friendships in the business when he launched his much-needed distribution company. His chain of Music City retail stores became an important part of Western Canada and Northern Ontario's record industry. The chain now numbers over 70 stores.

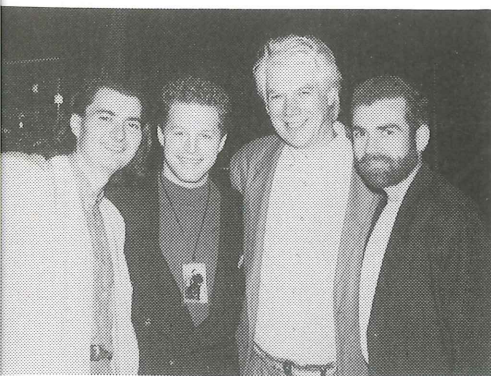
A highly respected retail marketer, Mr. Samuels moved to Toronto in 1970 where he operated the Dr. Denton children's wear operation and the business needs of National.

His new office is the old vault of the bank. Is there a hidden message there? If Sam gives the kid a little more muscle room, he can sit back and not worry about the competition. Take it easy Sam. Your empire's in good hands. (EC: *What's that line about the Emperor's closet . . . ?*)

Just in the nick of time . . . ! I understand the 5th Annual People's Choice Juno Award (sponsored by Molson Breweries) has announced the following nominees: Bryan Adams, Blue Rodeo, Celine Dion, Colin James and The Tragically Hip. Representatives of Canada's entertainment media came up with this short list. Now, the brewery and CARAS will make ballots available where young record fans can find them. (EC: *Now that we've been threatened by the Juno people . . . I guess I have nothing to add . . . !*)

More money from the trough . . . ! Watch for a government-sponsored songwriting contest to honour Canada's 150th birthday. The big prize is estimated to be \$50,000. One question. Will that be in English or French . . . the winning song, I mean. (EC: *We may only have English when that birthday comes around . . . ?*)

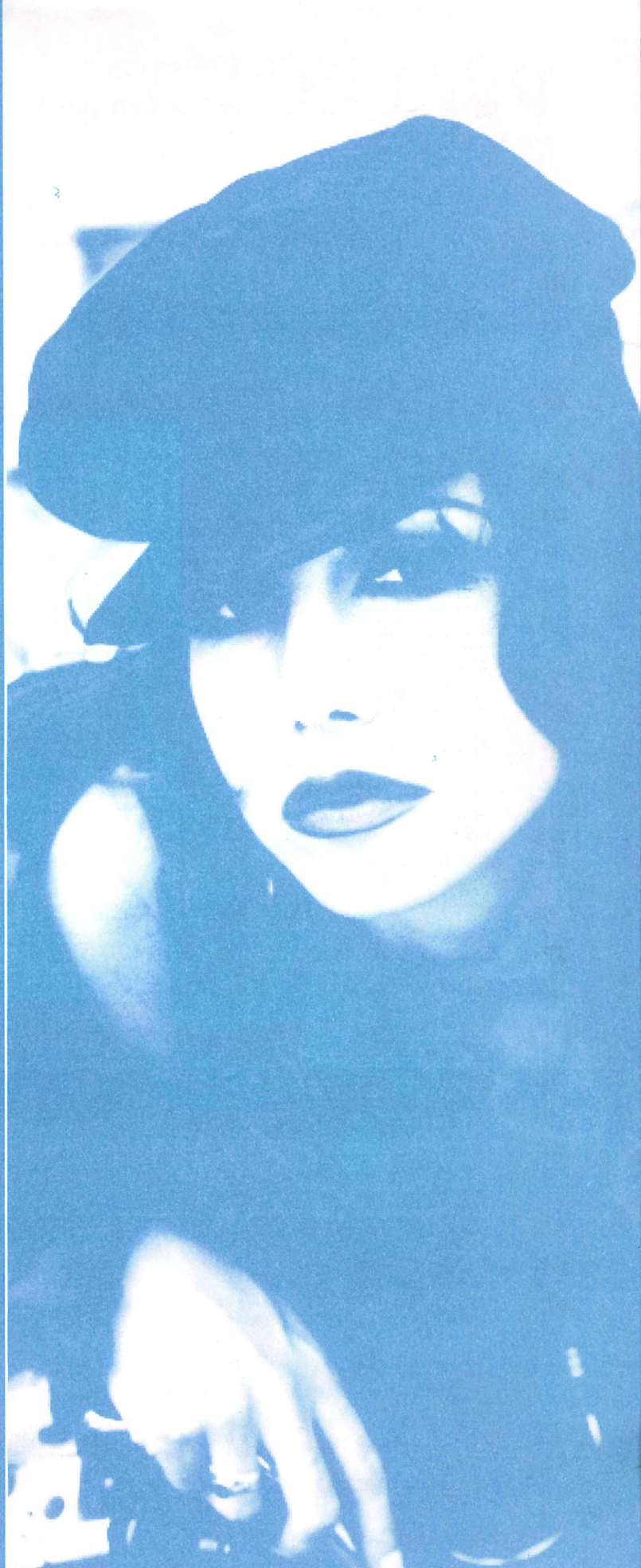

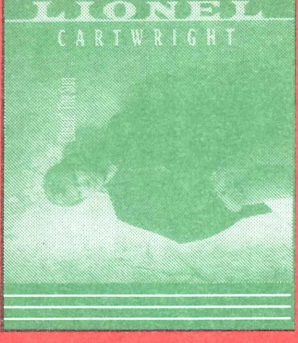

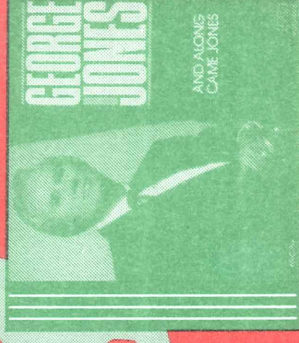

Jazz is a "King size" passion for piano player

There was probably no one more disappointed than Bill King when the CRTC no longer required radio broadcasters to program specialized music formats under the Promise of Performance commitment.

King, a Toronto writer, performer and on-air personality watched with dismay as his syndicated show, *The Jazz Report*, was in his own words, "killed right across the board."

But his love of jazz remains undiminished as he and his partner, Greg Sutherland, continue to publish a quarterly entitled *The Jazz Report* and a compilation of his recordings called *The Night Passage Years* has just been released on Justin Time Records.

"In the years between '84 and '86 I recorded three albums, *Ice*, *Avenue B* and *City of Dreams*. The masters had been put away for several years until Jim West of Justin Time Records decided to help me preserve them on CD."

Featuring a stellar cast of musicians, including saxophonist, Pat LaBarbera, bassist Dave Young and drummer Joe LaBarbera, King further enhances his collection with the vocal talents of Liberty Silver. The chanteuse can be

heard on *Sugar*, *God Bless The Child* and *Loverman*.

Born in Jeffersonville, Indiana, King won scholarships to Boston's Berklee College of Music and Oscar Peterson's Advanced School of Contemporary Studies in Toronto. Through the '60s and '70s most of his work was in the world of rock. He backed people like Freddie Cannon, The Shangri Las, Chuck Berry and The Raelettes, as well being Musical Director and

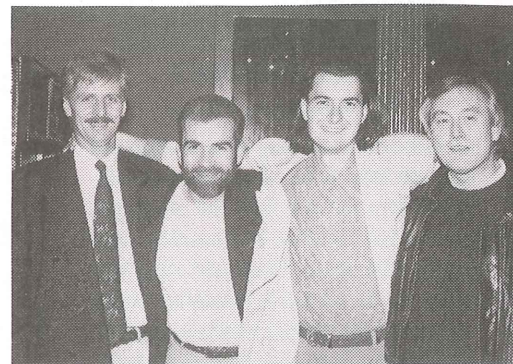

After seven dates in B.C., Cochrane performed in Alberta at Calgary's Jubilee Theatre, Nov. 12, the Centrum in Red Deer, Nov. 13 and the Convention Centre in Edmonton, Nov. 15. Saskatchewan saw him perform at Regina's Centre of the Arts, Nov. 16 and Saskatoon's Centennial Auditorium on Nov. 17.

Cochrane's Manitoba appearances were limited to a two-night stand at Winnipeg's Walker Theatre on Nov. 19 and 20. Cochrane concludes his tour with dates at Thunder Bay's Community Auditorium on Nov. 22, Montreal's St. Denis on Nov. 25 and finally a two-night stand at Toronto's Massey Hall Nov. 27/28.

Dropping the Red Rider name hasn't affected album sales for Cochrane as his *Mad Mad World* album has climbed to the number two position on RPM's top 100 album chart after only six weeks. Cochrane says after the departure of guitarist Ken Greer, a name change was inevitable. "I tend to put a lot of emphasis on integrity and with Kenny gone, he was the last original member, I just didn't feel it was fair to call it Red Rider anymore."

Headbangers and rockers make mark at MuchMusic

A cursory glance at RPM's top 100 albums chart the last few months would reveal the continued popularity of heavy metal and hard rock. Never one to ignore trends, combined with a desire to keep on the cutting edge of musical tastes, MuchMusic has made some recent programming changes to reflect Canada's more hard rocking tastes.

"The Power Hour was always one of our most popular shows, so it made sense to go with a nightly show, so we came up with the Power 30, which plays the top 30 of metal," explained John Martin, MuchMusic's Director of Music Programming.

And for people who like to rock out but not bang their head, a new weekend show has been created entitled *Start Me Up*, where for three hours each Saturday and Sunday, tunes by groups like the Black Crowes and Rolling Stones will be featured.

In keeping with MuchMusic's philosophy of interactive street programming, the network recently had Bruce Cockburn in for a live 90-minute broadcast where viewers could ask questions by either video via satellite, phone or fax to Cockburn right across the country.

"The concept is new, but it worked well with the Cockburn show, so hopefully we can do the same for some more bands in the near future."

In terms of new VJ's, Martin said that Simon Evans, a producer at MuchMusic for the last seven years, will be one of the new VJ's, with an "anti-VJ attitude."

For the future, Martin said that MuchMusic has no plans to expand its eight hours of original broadcasting a day, but promises those eight hours will continue to be the most original and entertaining hours of music video on the continent.

Fred LaRose of the Stereotype label, also reports the finishing touches being made on the Vinson/Martineau album to be titled Rise Like A Phoenix. A video grant has been secured and work is now being done on a video of the title track. Vinson and Martineau made a good impression at the recent COCA conference at Winnipeg and a solid slate of bookings at colleges is expected for next year.

Gerry King's Heartwreck is beginning to take hold. The single is being given a promotion push by Saddlestone Records of Surrey, B.C. King has been nominated as Male Vocalist in the Country category for this year's West Coast tribute awards (Nov. 10). He has also been nominated for Nashville's International Independent Country Music Awards set for Feb. 6 through 9, where he has also been asked to perform three songs from his Boots & Jeans album. King has just finished up an engagement at the Overlander Inn, Williams Lake, B.C., and is currently working Prince George's Yellowhead Inn (Nov. 4 through 16, followed by the Flamingo Hotel in Surrey, B.C. The scene is the same on the Albums chart, with Adams and Cochrane one-two.

Queensryche could be next . . . With the recent visit to Canada by Chuck and Di, and then by Fergie, Royalty has been abundant. In honour of their visits, name the artists with royal-sounding names who have had a No. 1 song. Hint: there are five but the KINGbees and Patty DUKE aren't on the list.

The third so far. Bryan Adams becomes the third artist this year to have two No. 1 songs (Rod Stewart and Mariah Carey are the others). Last year, only Wilson Phillips and Phil Collins managed to accomplish that (although Phil Collins did it twice with four No. 1s).
